A few errors were found in the equations of the original paper.<sup>1</sup> Therefore in Eqs. (1), (5), (6), (8), and (9), the multiplicative number 2 (not the dividing ones) should be replaced by 4.

In Eq. (11), the number 1 should be replaced by (i.e.,  $\pi/5$ ).

These errors affect the Fig. 2, which should be replaced by the corrected one given here. The shape of the curves appearing in this figure is slightly affected by these errors. In particular in the paragraph following Fig. 2, the number 3.5 should be replaced by 2.5.

However, the general qualitative conclusions of this paper remain unchanged.

Corrected Fig. 2 caption:

Output-signal intensities as a function of  $kd$ .

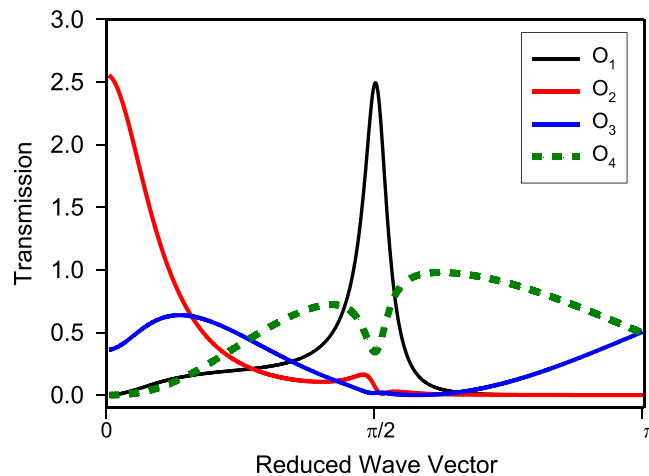
