## Web Appendix A

## NMF gradient descent algorithm : technical details

Let consider the following constrained optimization problem:

$$
\begin{aligned}
D_{K}(V,(W, H)) & =\|V-W H\|^{2} \\
& =\sum_{n=1}^{N} \sum_{f=1}^{F}\left(v_{f n}-\sum_{k=1}^{K} W_{f k} H_{k n}\right)^{2}
\end{aligned}
$$

subject to the constraints that $W_{f k} \geq 0, H_{k n} \geq 0$ and $\sum_{f=1}^{F} W_{f k}=1$.
The standard gradient descent approach consists at each step in assigning to each component $W_{f k}$ of $W$ the value

$$
W_{f k} \leftarrow W_{f k}-\eta_{f k} \frac{\partial D_{K}(V,(W, H))}{\partial W_{f k}}
$$

that is

$$
W_{f k} \leftarrow W_{f k}+2 \eta_{f k}\left[\sum_{n=1}^{N} V_{f n} H_{k n}-\sum_{n=1}^{N} \sum_{k^{\prime}=1}^{K} W_{f k^{\prime}} H_{k^{\prime} n} H_{k n}\right]
$$

with $\eta_{f k}$ a small positive real number. To assure the positivity of $W_{f k}$ let put

$$
\eta_{f k}=W_{f k}\left[V H^{t}\right]_{f k}
$$

that implies the multiplicative update rule for $W_{f k}$

$$
W_{f k} \leftarrow W_{f k} \frac{\left[V H^{t}\right]_{f k}}{\left[W H H^{t}\right]_{f k}}
$$

Notice that the choice of $\eta_{f k}$ is not necessarily small that not assures directly the algorithm convergence.
