
Scheme of the MALS setup


a = 15 mm

b = 87 mm


c = 78 mm

d = 30 mm



Stages (by Newport)

Double-Row Steel Linear Ball Bearing Stages M-UMR5.16 (two for the collimator and two for the beam stop), Platform Optical Mount P 100 M by Newport (for the collimator).

Alternative lenses (the first two lenses are aspherical), by Melles Griot:

In this alternative configuration, the three pairs of lenses $L_{1a}+L_{1b}$, $L_{1a}+L_{1b}$, and $L_{1a}+L_{1b}$ are replaced by single lenses, either aspherical or spherical biconvex. The two aspherical lenses should be placed with their flat side facing each other.
