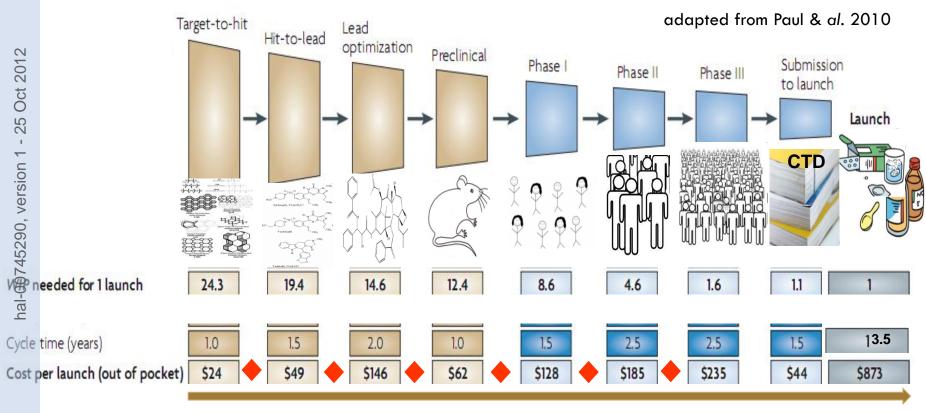

Decision milestones in R&D projects

Go/No Go decisions' caracteristics:

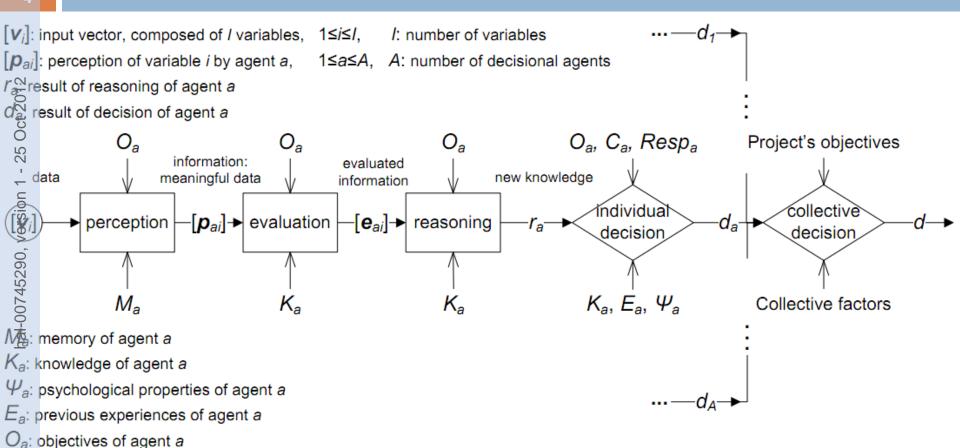
- collective decision-making: steering committee,
- a high degree of uncertainty: innovation in product development process,
- non-emergency situations: risk in the future.

In this context, some delays result from:

- indecision: to do not decide,
- invalidation: to decide and to invalidate the made decisions.

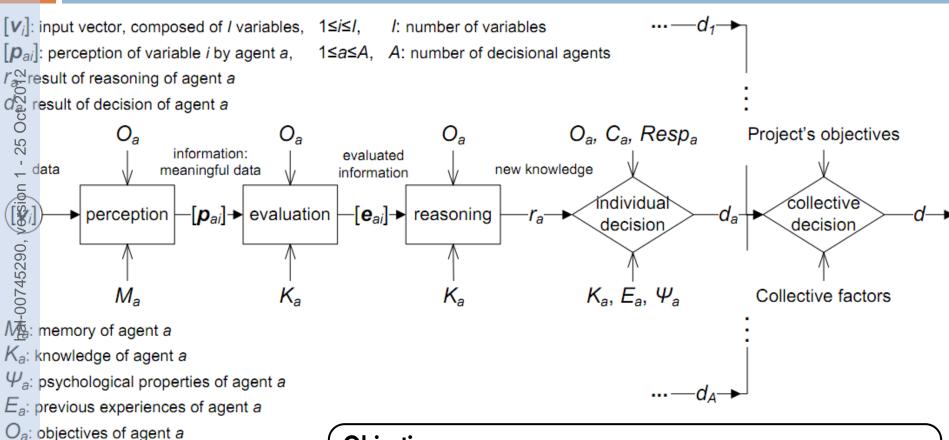
Ca: consequences of decision for agent a

Ca: consequences of decision for agent a

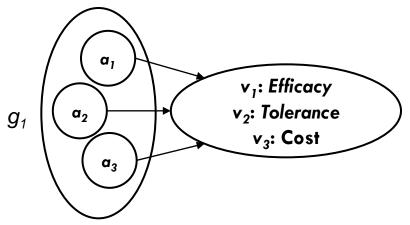

Conclusions and prospects

- The framework helps explicit inference rules used by the agents to decide in order to:
 - analyze their different behaviors in the group,
 - anticipate the risk of invalidation of a decision by measuring the dissatisfaction of the agents.
- In a new version of the framework the limitations could be improved, taking into account:
 - the interdependencies between the variables,
 - iterative aspect of decision and the interactions between agents.
