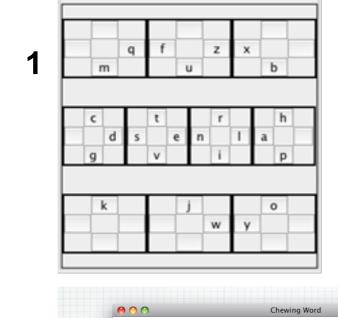

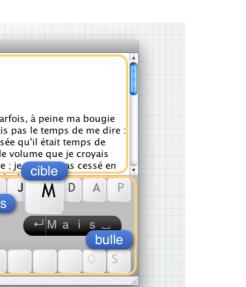
Objectives

- □Create a new system of communication for people with cerebral palsy (CP) with athetoid problems (gestural and speech difficulties)
- ☐Mixed entry method: predictive virtual keyboard + pictograms (to speed up the input)
- □Context sensitive support system (location awareness, semantic awareness)

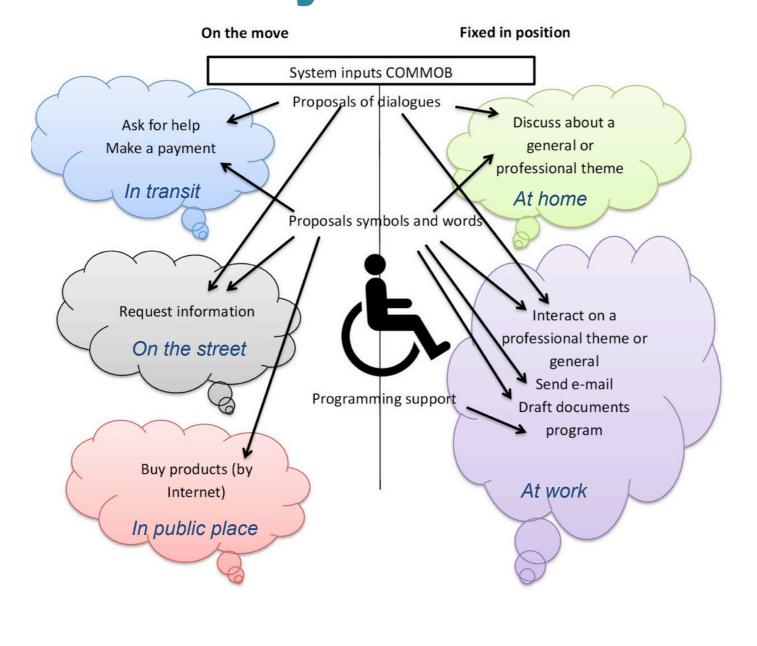




Too limited according with the real needs of the people concerned

COMMOB (*COMmunication in* **MOBility**) system specification

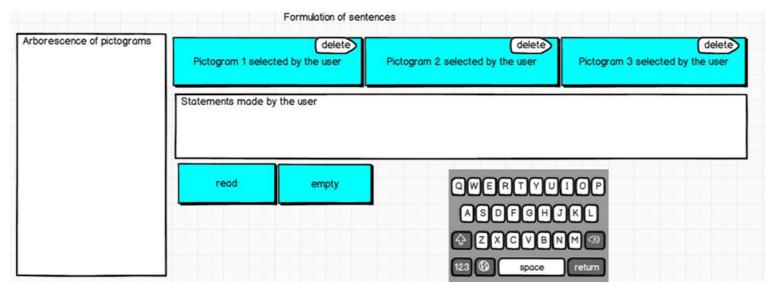
- ☐ Used at home, at work and on the move
