- GATB-CORE:** This stage processes the reads into three main components:
  - API
  - Library
  - Binaries
- Graph (HDF5):** The components from GATB-CORE are used to construct a graph, represented as a network of nodes and edges.
- GATB-TOOLS:** The graph is analyzed using three tools:
  - Tool 1
  - Tool 2
  - Tool 3
