Assuming that you are currently using LaTeX to convert your paper into the NDJFL stylefile: Download [ndjflart.cls](#) and [dupart.cls](#) into the same directory as your file. The guide to our LaTeX style file can be found at [typesetting](#) in LaTeX. So download the style guide into the same directory and latex it to make sure everything works. Now change your paper to use ndjflart. If you need help converting your paper read the tex code of the guide style and/or look at the standard LaTeX books and how-tos. The NDJFL style guide itself is a guide to visual style of the final typeset version of your paper and how we achieve this. It's not a guide on how to convert your paper. If you read the guide you will not be surprised when you proof the final typeset version of your paper. The NDJFL uses LaTeX not TeX. So if you are using TeX first convert to LaTeX.
