# Characterization of Rare-Earth Aluminum Oxynitrides Synthesized by Carboreduction and Nitridation

## Background

Over the recent years, a great interest has been shown for multinary oxynitrides containing main group elements especially in the fields of phosphors or visible-light driven photocatalysts. However if a tremendous work has been done on nitridosilicates and nitridoalumonisilicates based materials, very little is know about multinary (oxy)nitride systems based on aluminum ( $\mathrm{R}_{2} \mathrm{AlO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}, \mathrm{RAl}_{11} \mathrm{O}_{12} \mathrm{~N}$ ), gallium ( $\mathrm{La} \mathrm{a}_{2} \mathrm{GaN}_{3}$ ) or phosphorous $\left(\mathrm{Zn}_{2} \mathrm{PO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}\right)$. A large part of our research is then devoted to the preparation of new materials among those systems by exploring less-common synthesis routes than the usual solid state reaction or the ammonia flow-based nitridation. As a first step of the present work, we have successfully reinvestigated the preparation of the $\mathrm{R}_{2} \mathrm{AlO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}$ oxynitrides $(\mathrm{R}=\mathrm{Nd}$ and Sm$)$ using the carboreduction and nitridation process (CRN).

## Synthesis routes...

Previous synthesis : mixture of $\mathrm{Nd}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}$ or $\mathrm{Sm}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}$ and AIN sealed under $\mathrm{N}_{2}$ in nickel tubing and fired at $1350^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ with repeated heating.

Long reaction process ( $\mathbf{6 \times 2 4 h}$ )
Very difficult to obtain pure samples $\rightarrow \mathrm{RAIO}_{3}$ and $\mathrm{R}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}$ minor phases
Carboreduction \& nitridation (CRN):
$2 \mathrm{Sm}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}+\mathrm{Al}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}+3 \mathrm{C}+\mathrm{N}_{2} \rightarrow 2 \mathrm{Sm}_{2} \mathrm{AlO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}+3 \mathrm{CO} \quad \mathrm{T}=1250^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$

Regular apparatus


## X-Ray Diffraction...

$\Rightarrow \mathrm{Sm}_{2} \mathrm{AlO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}$ can be obtained as a nearly pure sample after only 3 heating at $1250^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$
$\Rightarrow$ In the same conditions, a $\mathrm{Nd}_{2} \mathrm{O}_{3}$ impurity phase still be present along with $\mathrm{Nd}_{2} \mathrm{AlO}_{3} \mathrm{~N}$
little oxidation remains


## Conclusion...

- Carboreduction \& Nitridation (CRN) is a convenient way to prepare aluminum based oxynitrides with interesting optical properties and good thermal stability under air.
- Apparatus will be upgraded with a nitrogen gas purification system (moisture and oxygen traps, hot titanium wire) to avoid reoxidation of the samples.
- Other systems are under investigation such as $A_{2-x} R_{x} \mathrm{AlO}_{4-x} \mathrm{~N}_{x}$ solid solution with $\mathrm{A}=$ Alkaline earth and $R=$ Rare earth.
