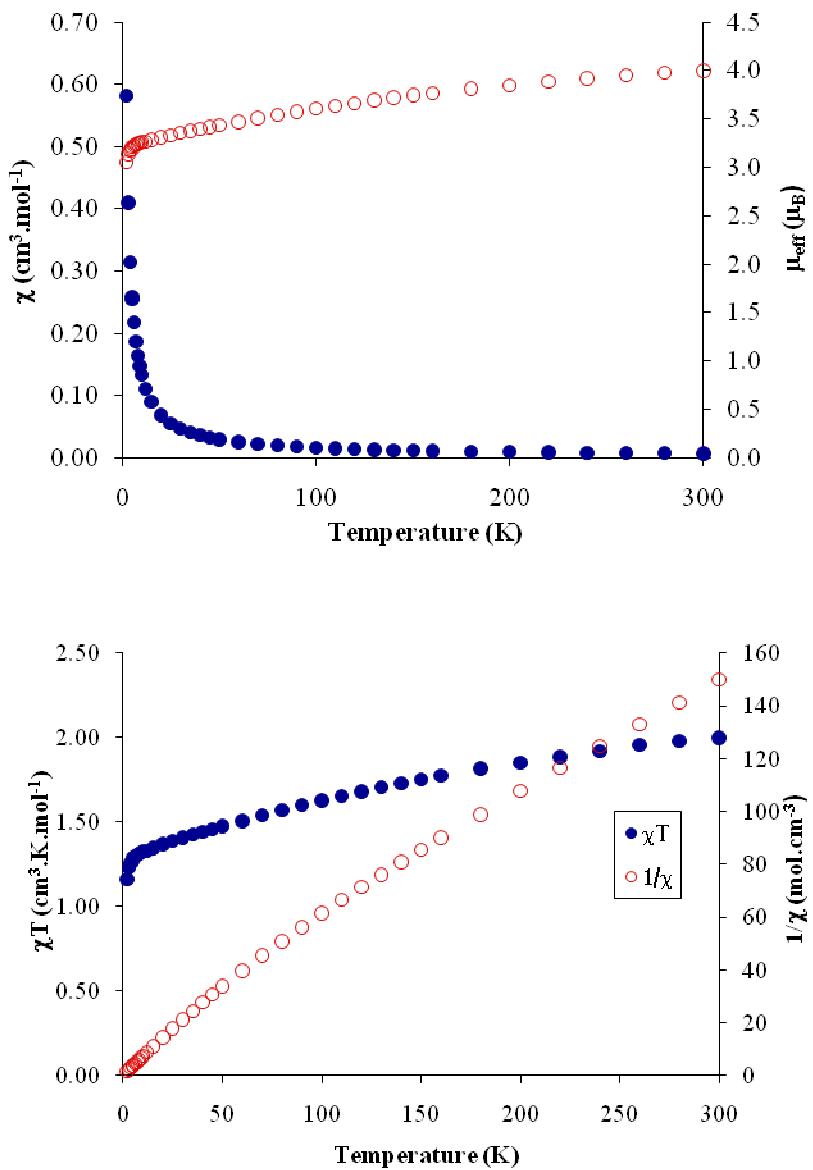

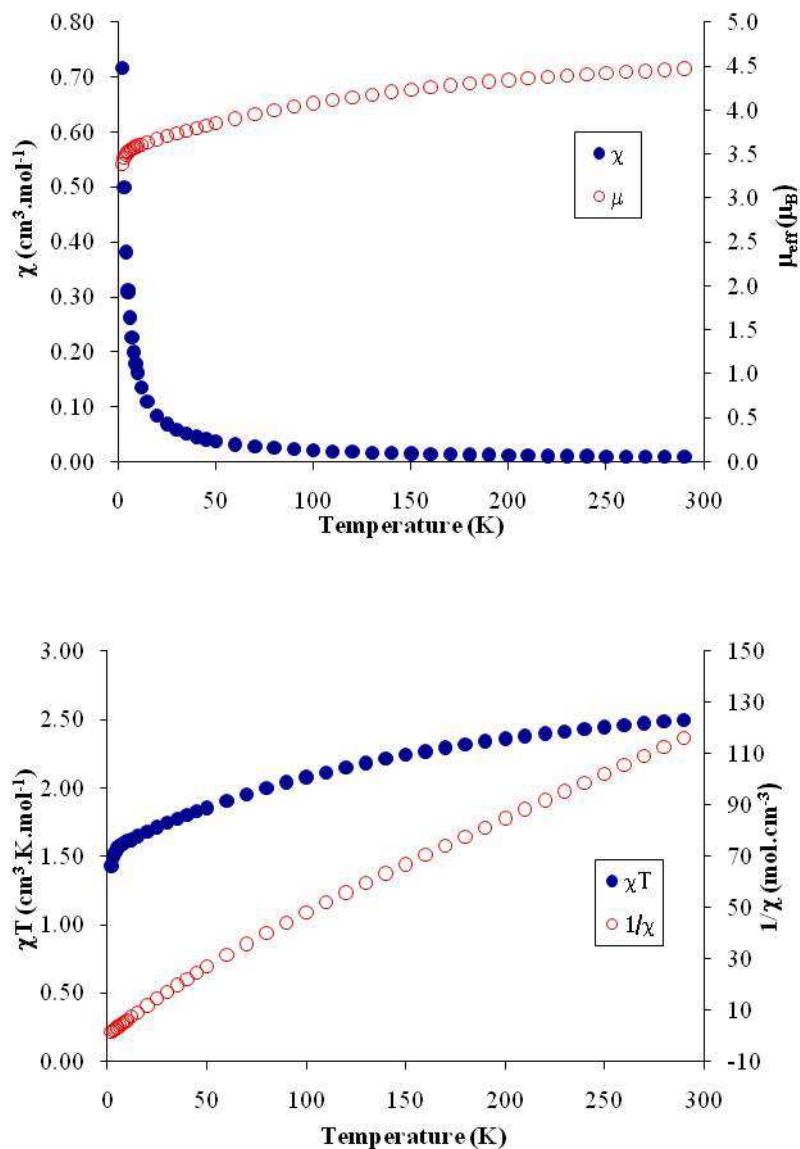

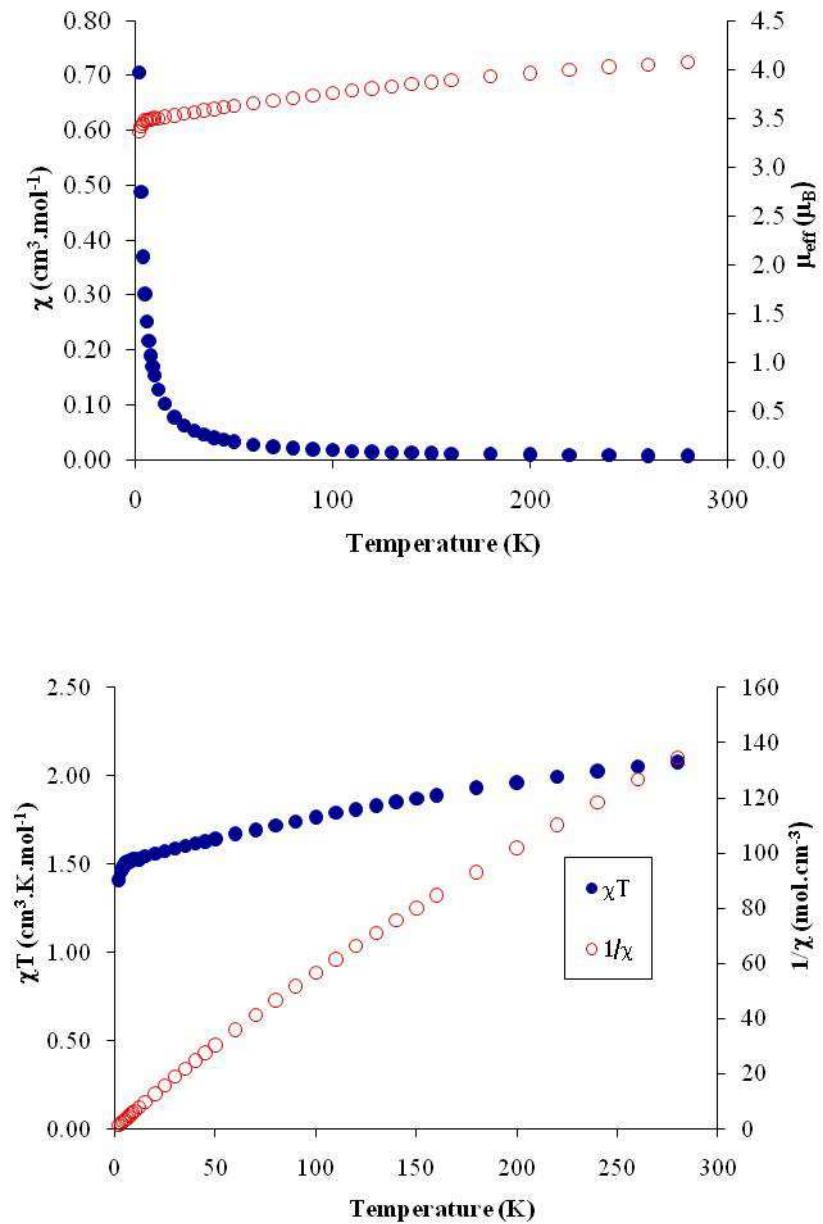

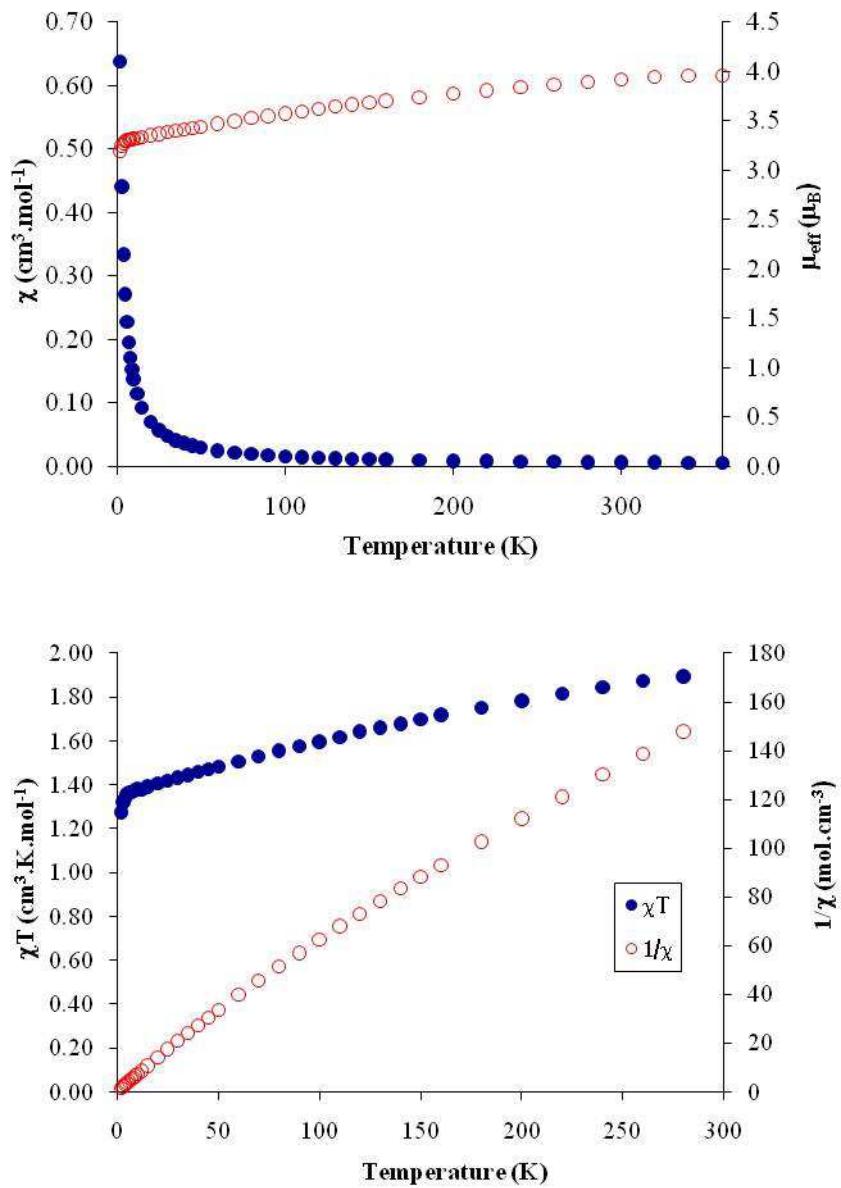

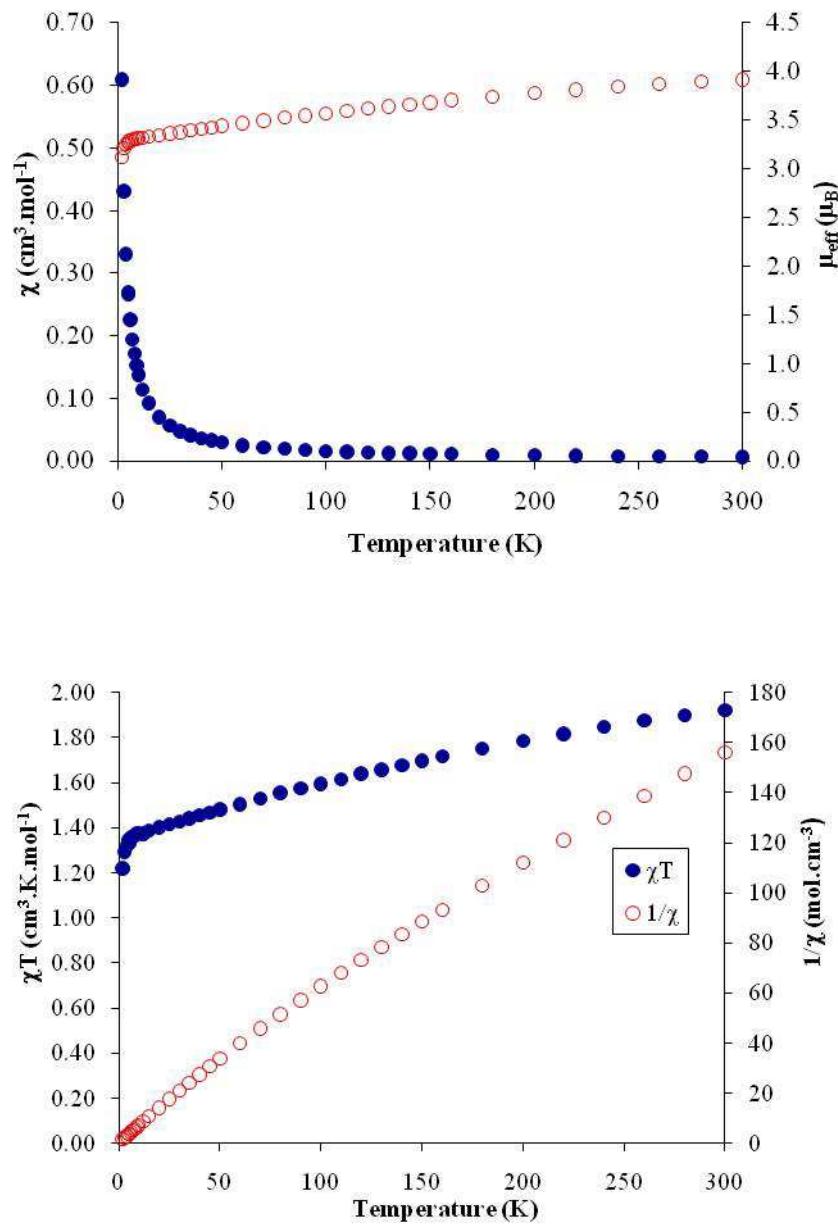

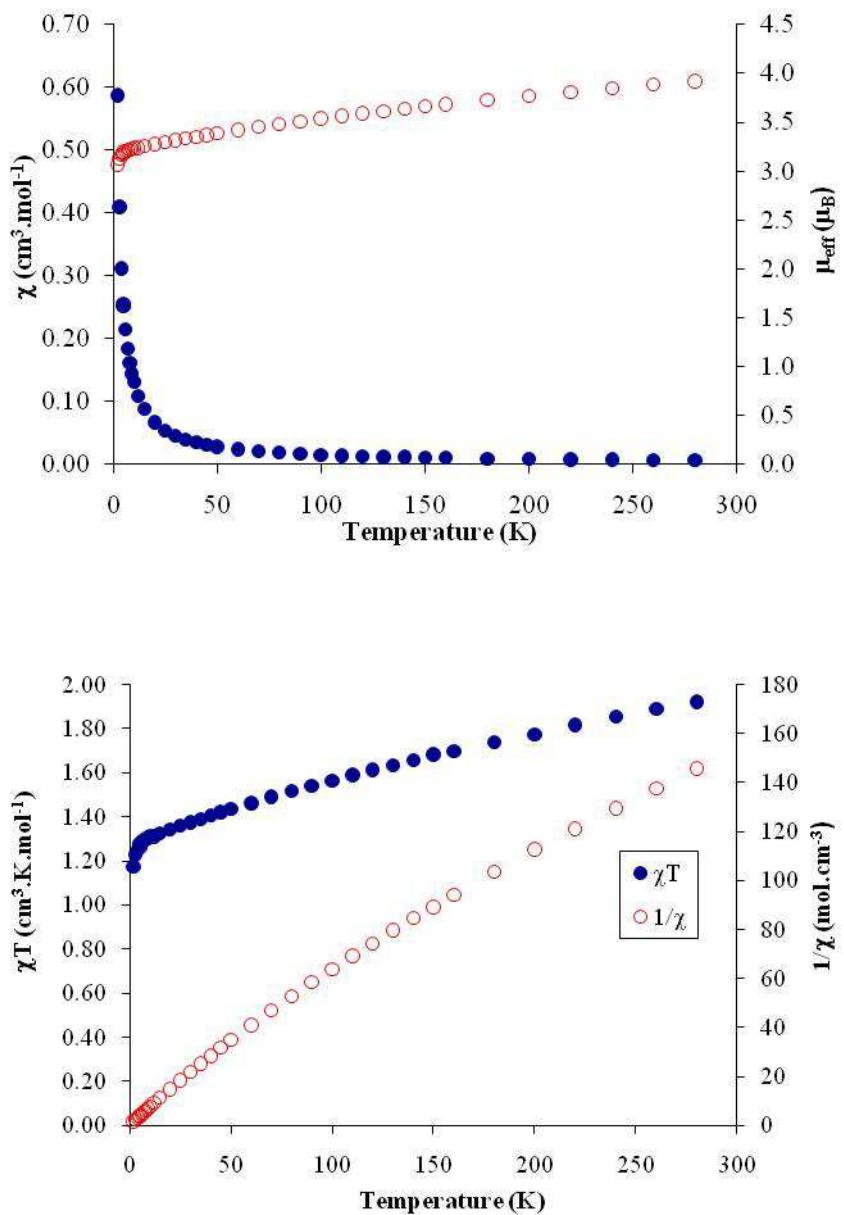

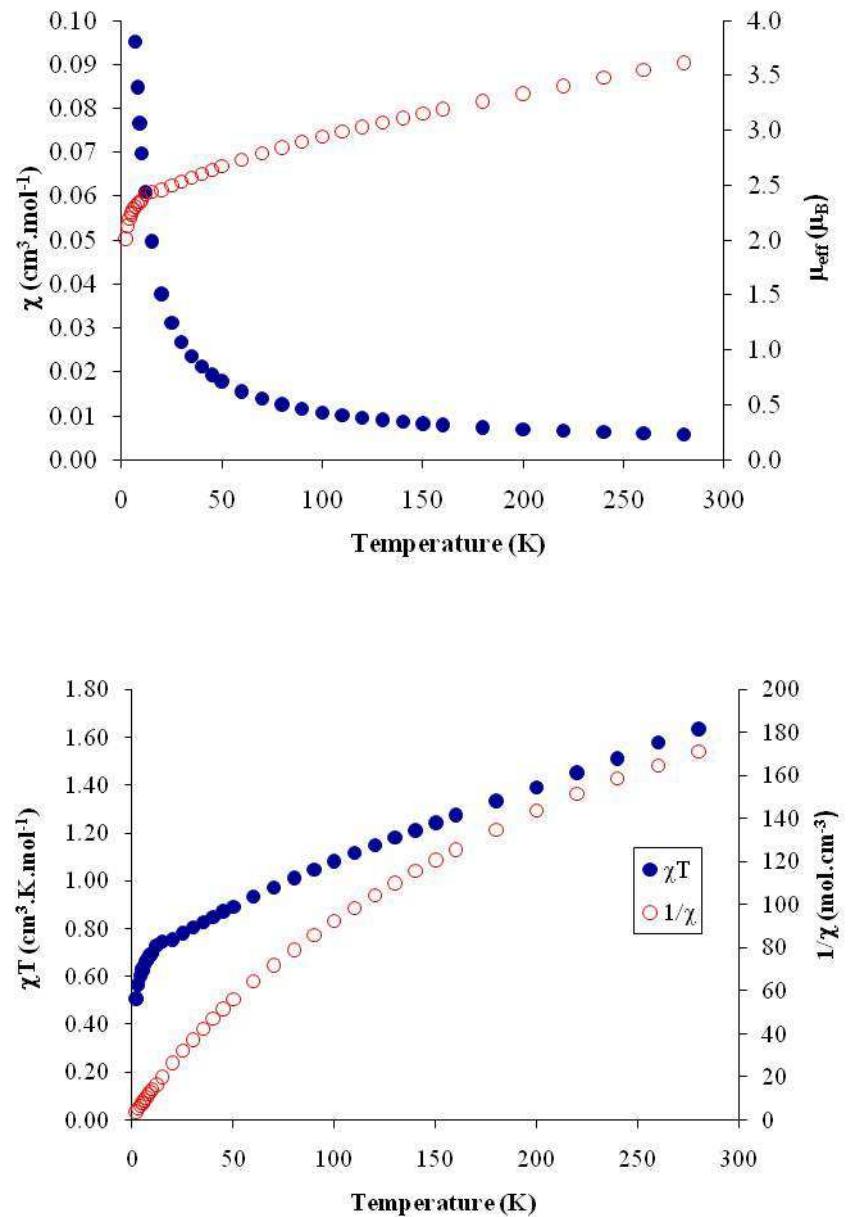
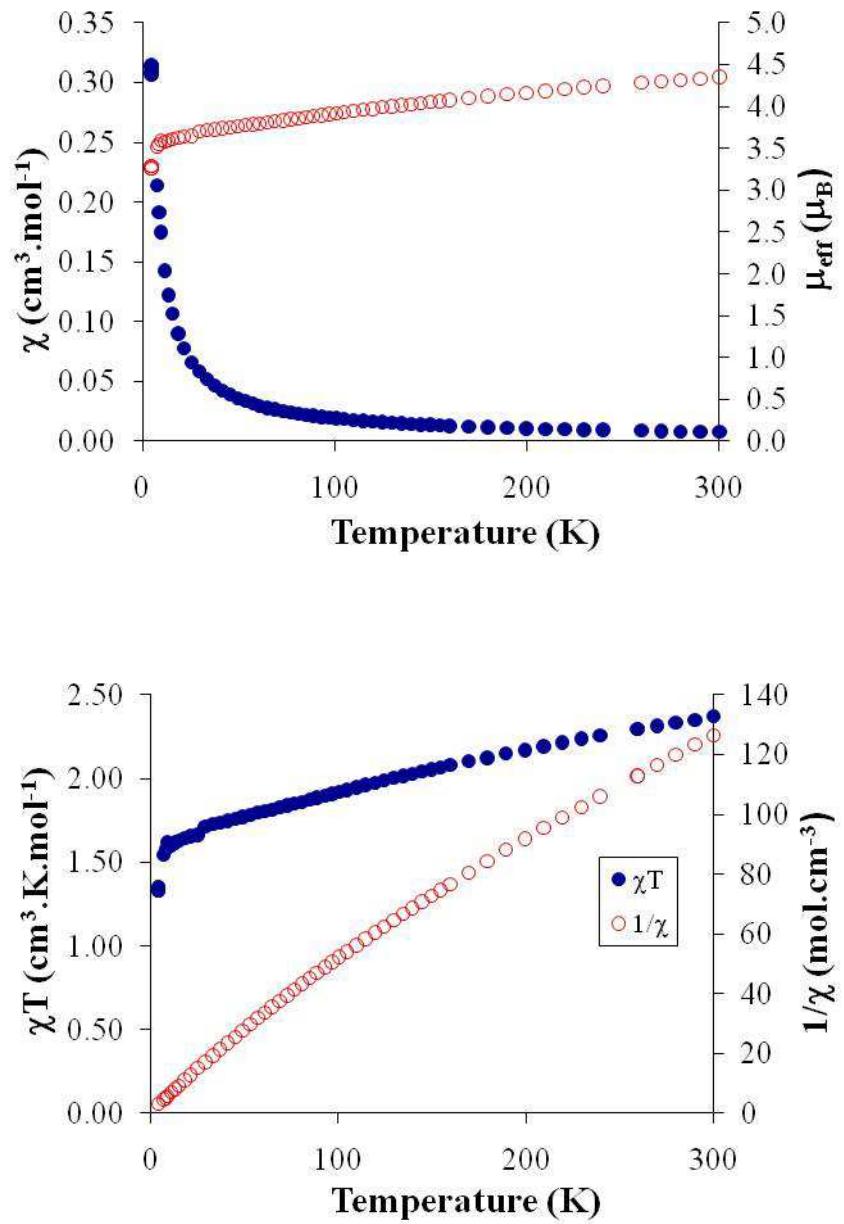

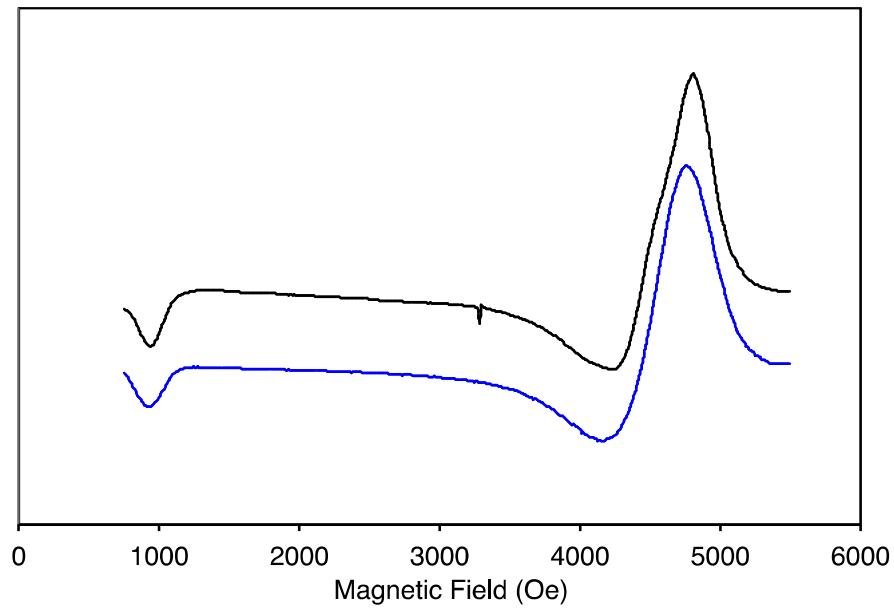

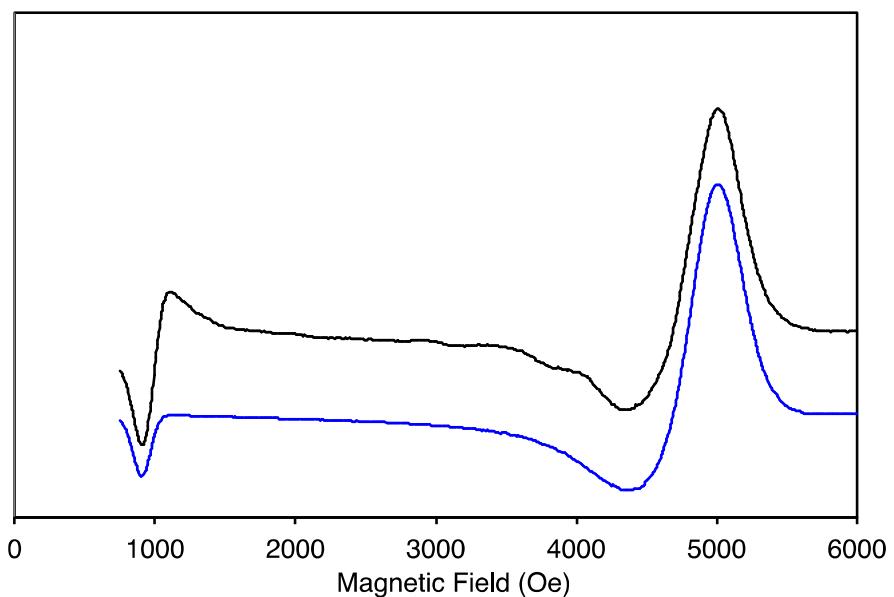

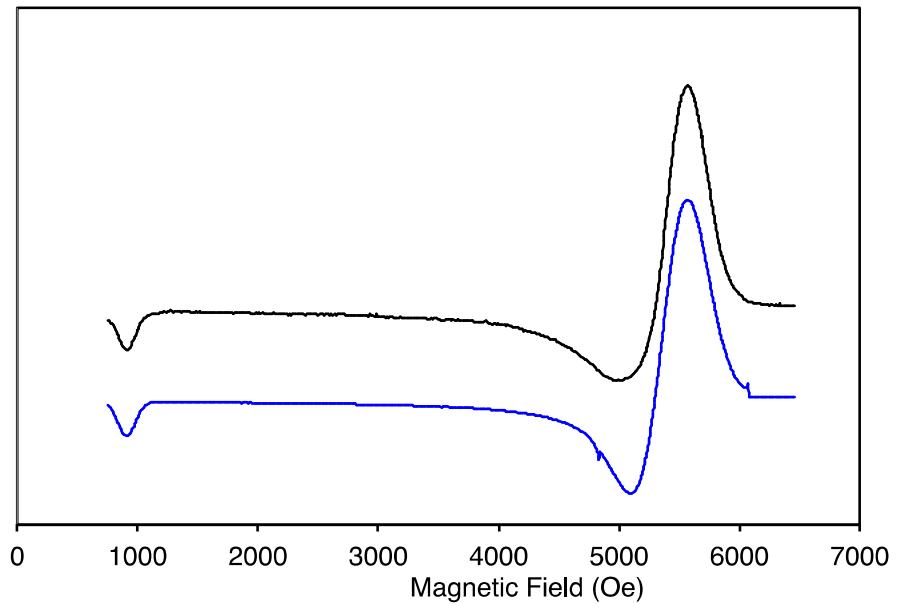

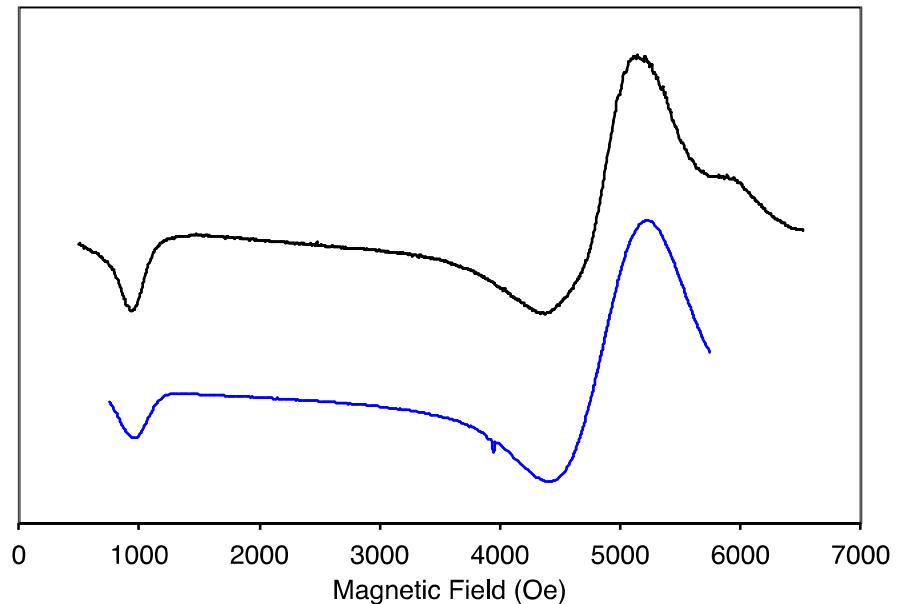
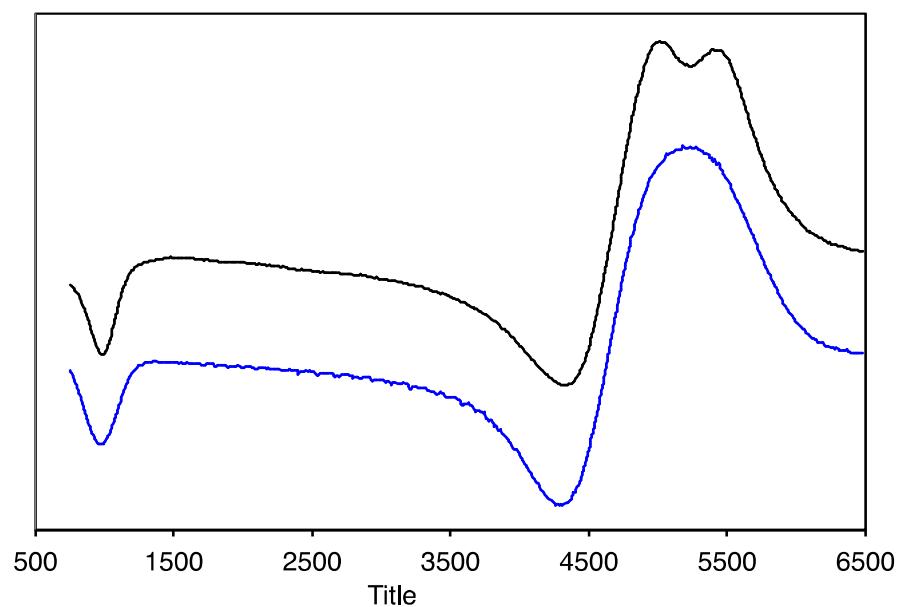

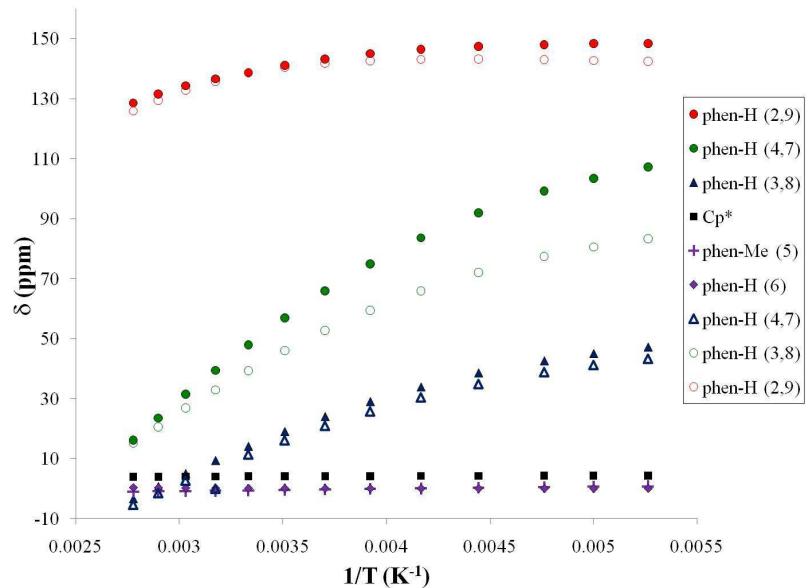
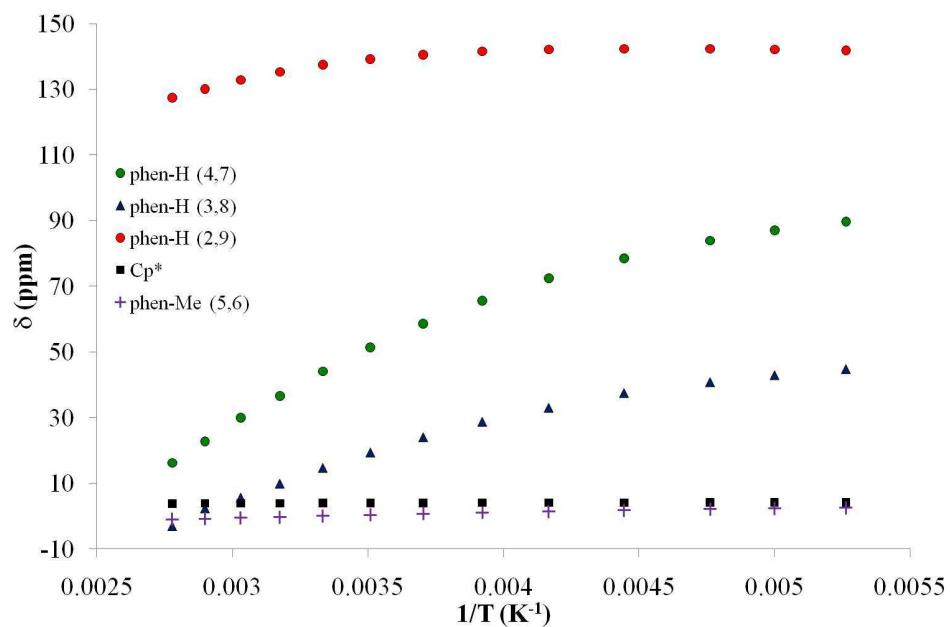

Figure S16. Absorption spectrum in the Vis-NIR region for the complex **3** in toluene at room temperature.

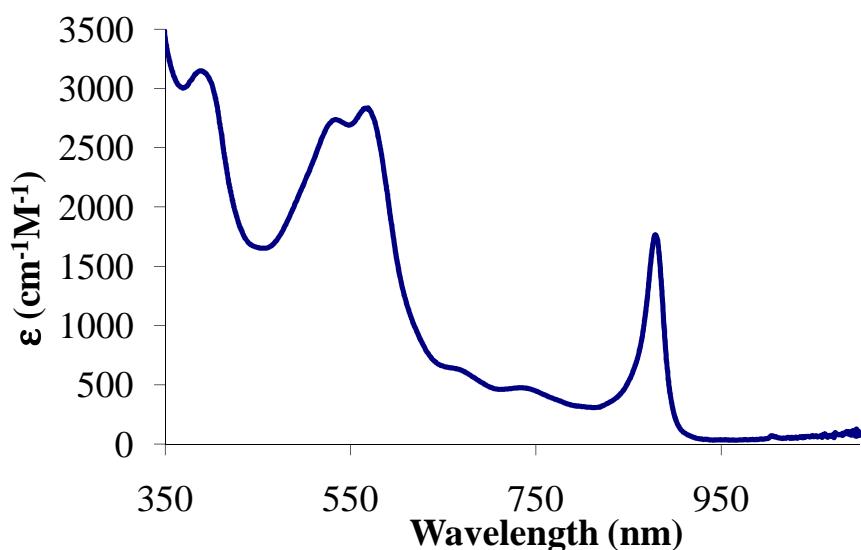


Figure S17. Absorption spectrum in the Vis-NIR region for the complex **5** in toluene at room temperature.

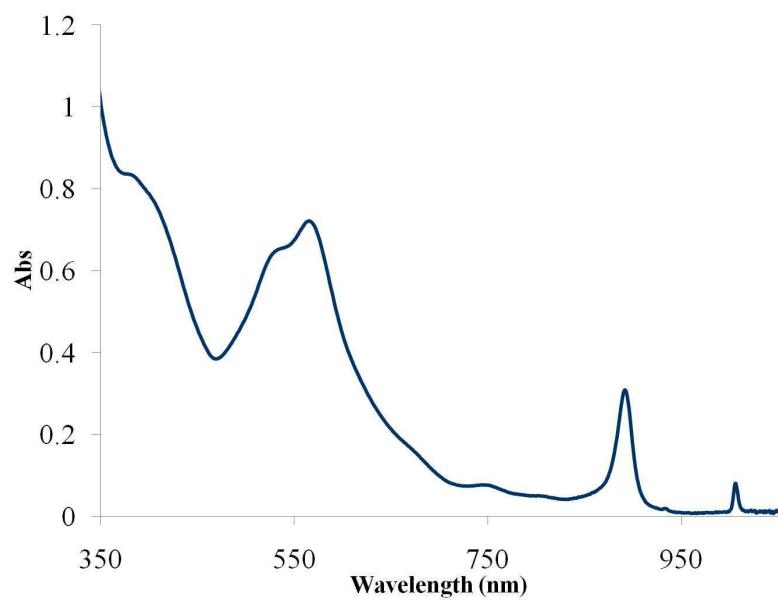


Figure S18. Absorption spectrum in the Vis-NIR region for the complex **6** in toluene at room temperature.

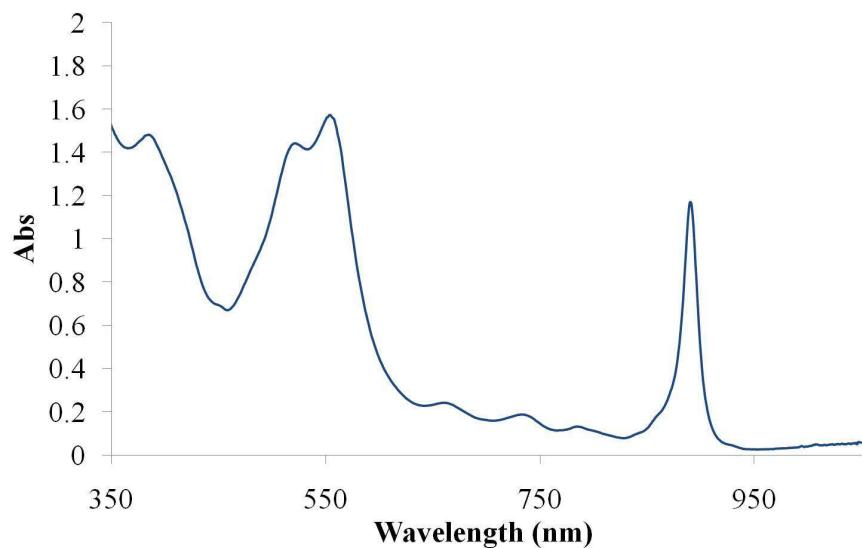
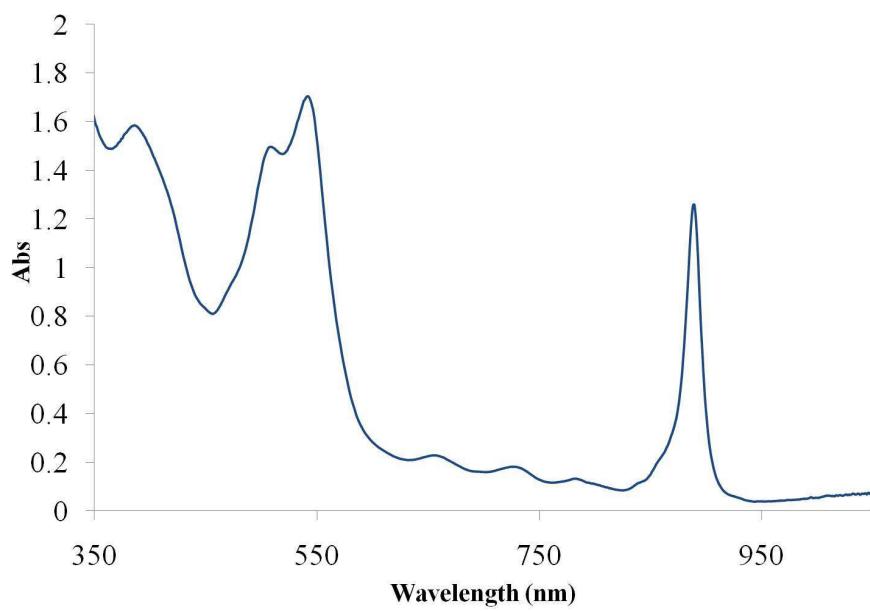


Figure S19. Absorption spectrum in the Vis-NIR region for the complex **7** in toluene at room temperature.



5. X-ray Studies.

5.1. Cp^{*}₂Yb(phen) (1, crystallized)

Data collection

A fragment of a purple block-like crystal of C₆₄H₇₆N₄Yb₂ [Cp^{*}₂Yb(phen)]₂ crystallized from a slow diffusion of a phenanthroline solution in toluene in a toluene solution of the complex Cp^{*}₂YbOEt₂ and having approximate dimension of 0.1 x 0.08 x 0.05 mm was mounted on a Kapton loop using Paraton N hydrocarbon oil. All measurements were made on a Bruker APEX¹ CCD area detector with graphite monochromated Mo-K α radiation.

Cell constants and an orientation matrix, obtained from a least-squared refinement using the measured positions of 9726 reflexions with I > 10 σ in the range 5.12 < 2 θ < 50.92 corresponded to a primitive orthorhombic cell with dimensions:

$$\begin{array}{ll} a = 17.9675(15) \text{ \AA} & a = 90^\circ. \\ b = 17.8594(15) \text{ \AA} & b = 90^\circ. \\ c = 16.2715(13) \text{ \AA} & g = 90^\circ. \\ V = 5221.3(7) \text{ \AA}^3 & \end{array}$$

For Z = 4 and F.W. = 1247.36, the calculated density is 1.587 g cm⁻³. Based on a statistical analysis of intensity distribution, and successful solution and refinement of the structure, the space group was determinate to be

$$P\bar{b}\bar{c}a (\#61)$$

The data were collected at a temperature of -173(1) °C. Exposure time was 20.0s per frame.

Data reduction

Data were intergrated by the program SAINT² to a maximum 2 θ value of 52.22°. The data were corrected for Lorentz and polarization effects. Data were analyzed for agreement and possible absorption using XPREP.³ An semi-empirical multi-scan absorption correction⁴ was applied using SADABS.⁵ This models the absorption surface using a spherical harmonic series based on differences between equivalent.

Structure solution and refinement

The structure was solved by direct methods.⁶ Non-hydrogen atoms were refined anisotropically and hydrogen atoms were placed in calculated positions and not refined. The final cycle of full matrix least squares refinement was based on 4079 observed reflections and 320 parameters and converged with unweighted and weighted agreement factors of:

$$R = \Sigma |F_o| - |F_c| / \Sigma |F_o| = 0.0344$$

$$R_w = [(\Sigma w (|F_o| - |F_c|)^2 / \Sigma w |F_o|^2)]^{1/2} = 0.0783$$

The standard deviation of an observation of unit weight was 1.003. The maximum and minimum peaks on the final difference Fourier map corresponded to 1.2 and -0.799 e.A⁻³, respectively.

The SHELX program uses the neutral atom scattering factors, f , f'' and absorption coefficients from International Tables for Crystallography, Volume C (1992), Ed. A.J.C. Wilson, Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht: Tables 6.1.1.4(pp. 500-502), 4.2.6.8 (pp.219-222) and 4.2.4.2 (pp. 193-199), respectively. All calculations were performed using the WinGX crystallographic software package.⁷ (“WinGX suite for small molecule single-crystallography”)

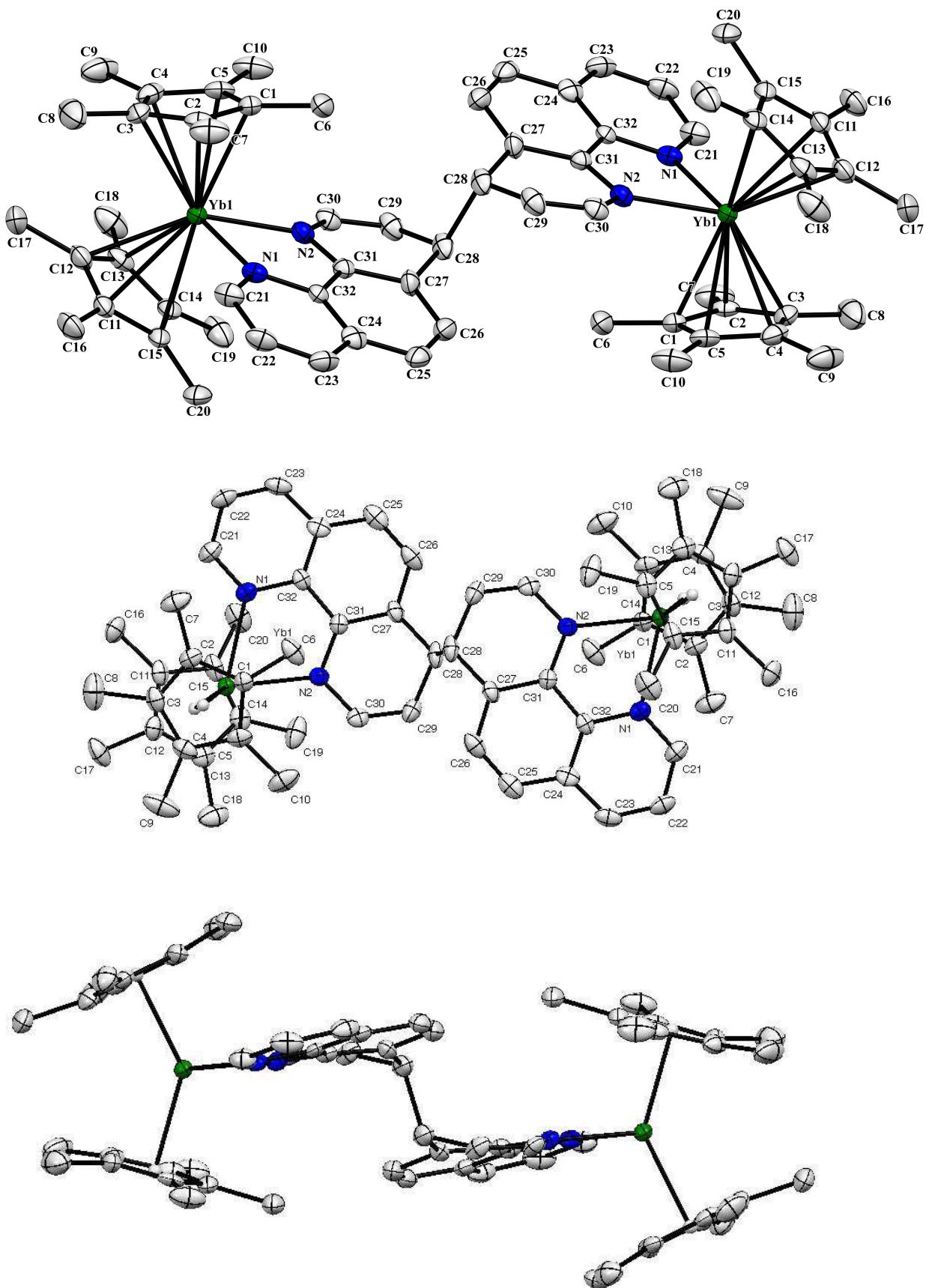

5.2.Cp^{*}₂Yb(phen), sublimed (1)

Data collection

A fragment of a purple block-like crystal of C₃₂H₃₈N₂Yb (Cp^{*}₂Yb(phen)) crystallized by sublimation at 280°C having approximate dimension of 0.15 x 0.15 x 0.10 mm was mounted on a Kapton loop using Paraton N hydrocarbon oil. All measurements were made on a Bruker APEX¹ CCD area detector with graphite monochromated Mo-Kα radiation.

Cell constants and an orientation matrix, obtained from a least-squared refinement using the measured positions of 9920 reflexions with I > 10σ in the range 4.79 < 2θ < 50.79 corresponded to a primitive monoclinic cell with dimensions:

For Z = 2 and F.W. = 623.68, the calculated density is 1.555 g cm⁻³. Based on a statistical analysis of intensity distribution, and successful solution and refinement of the structure, the space group was determinate to be

$$P - I (\#2)$$

The data were collected at a temperature of -173(1) °C. Frames corresponding to an arbitrary hemisphere of data were collected using ω scans of 0.3° counted for a total of 10.0s per frame.

Data reduction

Data were intergrated by the program SAINT² to a maximum 2θ value of 50.86°. The data were corrected for Lorentz and polarization effects. Data were analyzed for agreement and possible absorption using XPREP.³ An semi-empirical multi-scan absorption correction⁴ was applied using SADABS.⁵ This models the absorption surface using a spherical harmonic series based on differences between equivalent.

Structure solution and refinement

The structure was solved by Patterson methods.⁶ Non-hydrogen atoms were refined anisotropicaly and hydrogen atoms were placed in calculated positions and not refined. The final cycle of full matrix least squares refinement was based on 4882 observed reflections (I > 2.00 σ(I)) and 348 parameters and converged with unweighted and weighted agreement factors of:

The standard deviation of an observation of unit weight was 1.178. The weighting scheme was based on counting statistics and include a factor p to downweight the intense

reflections ($w=1/[\sigma^2F_o^2+(0.0188P)^2+(10.30P)]$) where $P=(\text{Max}(F_o^2,0)+2Fc^2)/3$). Plot of $\Sigma w (|F_o| - |F_c|)^2$ versus $|F_o|$, reflexion order in data collection, $\sin \theta/\lambda$ and various classes of indices showed no unusual trends. The maximum and minimum peaks on the final difference Fourier map corresponded to 0.859 and -1.067 e. \AA^{-3} , respectively.

The SHELX program uses the neutral atom scattering factors, f' , f'' and absorption coefficients from International Tables for Crystallography, Volume C (1992), Ed. A.J.C. Wilson, Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht: Tables 6.1.1.4(pp. 500-502), 4.2.6.8 (pp.219-222) and 4.2.4.2 (pp. 193-199), respectively. All calculations were performed using the WinGX crystallographic software package.⁷ (“WinGX suite for small molecule single-crystal crystallography”)

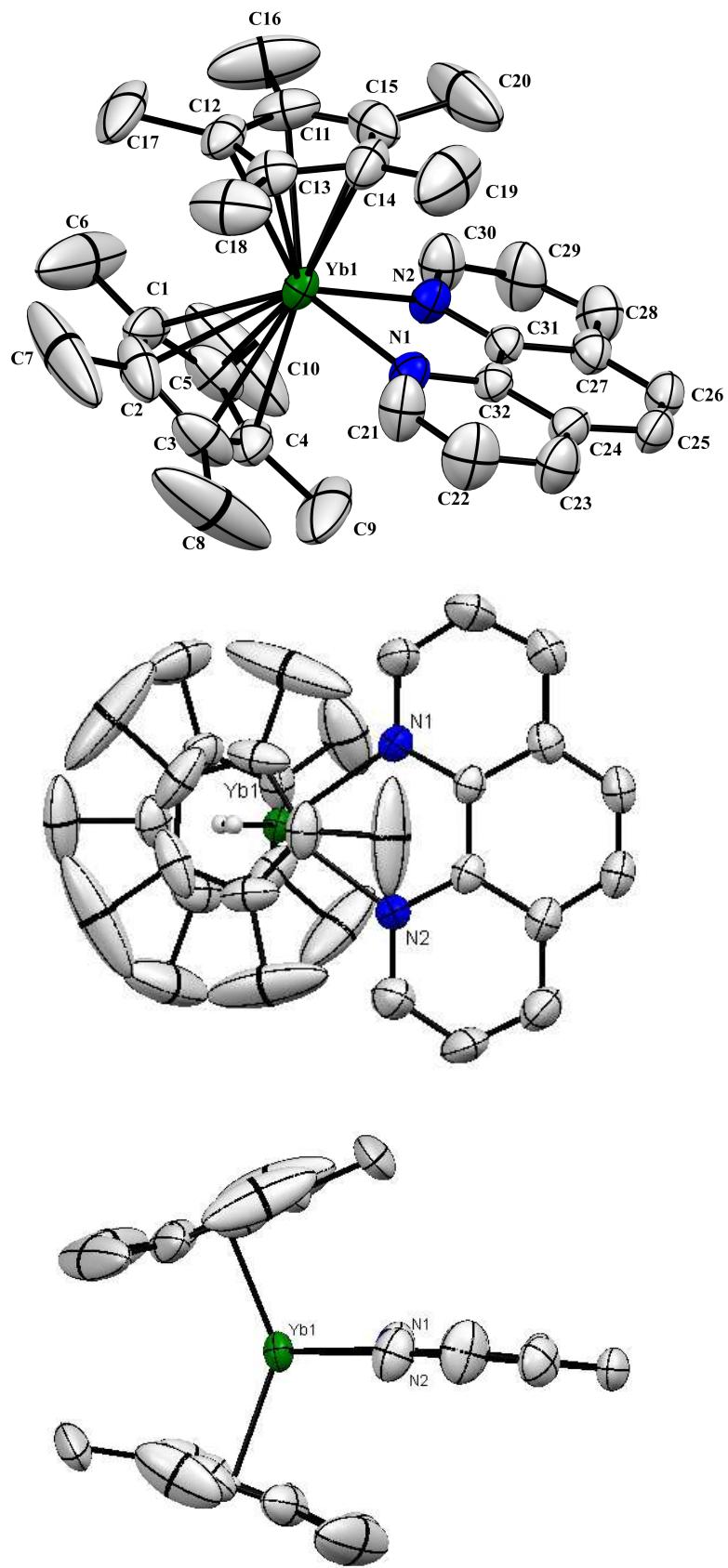

5.3.Cp^{*}₂Yb(3,8-Me₂phen) (3)

Data collection

A fragment of a red block-like crystal of C₄₁H₅₀N₂Yb (Cp^{*}₂Yb(3,8-Me₂phen)·C₇H₈) crystallized from toluene having approximate dimension of 0.20 x 0.20 x 0.08 mn was mounted on a Kapton loop using Paraton N hydrocarbon oil. All measurements were made on a Bruker APEX¹ CCD area detector with graphite monochromated Mo-Kα radiation.

Cell constants and an orientation matrix, obtained from a least-squared refinement using the measured positions of 9854 reflexions with I > 10σ in the range 4.48 < 2θ < 50.70 corresponded to a primitive monoclinic cell with dimensions:

For Z = 2 and F.W. = 743.87, the calculated density is 1.444 g cm⁻³. Based on a statistical analysis of intensity distribution, and successful solution and refinement of the structure, the space group was determinate to be

$$P - I (\#2)$$

The data were collected at a temperature of -173(1) °C. Frames corresponding to an arbitrary hemisphere of data were collected using ω scans of 0.3° counted for a total of 10.0s per frame.

Data reduction

Data were intergrated by the program SAINT² to a maximum 2θ value of 50.70°. The data were corrected for Lorentz and polarization effects. Data were analyzed for agreement and possible absorption using XPREP.³ A semi-empirical multi-scan absorption correction⁴ was applied using SADABS.⁵ This models the absorption surface using a spherical harmonic series based on differences between equivalent.

Structure solution and refinement

The structure was solved by direct methods.⁶ Non-hydrogen atoms were refined anisotropicaly and hydrogen atoms were placed in calculated positions and not refined. The final cycle of full matrix least squares refinement was based on 6213 observed reflections (I > 2.00 σ(I)) and 394 parameters and converged with unweighted and weighted agreement factors of:

The standard deviation of an observation of unit weight was 1.070. The weighting scheme was based on counting statistics and include a factor p to downweight the intense

reflections ($w=1/[\sigma^2F_o^2+(0.0188P)^2+(10.30P)]$) where $P=(\text{Max}(F_o^2,0)+2Fc^2)/3$). Plot of $\Sigma w (|F_o| - |F_c|)^2$ versus $|F_o|$, reflexion order in data collection, $\sin \theta/\lambda$ and various classes of indices showed no unusual trends. The maximum and minimum peaks on the final difference Fourier map corresponded to 1.235 and -1.252 e. \AA^{-3} , respectively.

The SHELX program uses the neutral atom scattering factors, f' , f'' and absorption coefficients from International Tables for Crystallography, Volume C (1992), Ed. A.J.C. Wilson, Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht: Tables 6.1.1.4(pp. 500-502), 4.2.6.8 (pp.219-222) and 4.2.4.2 (pp. 193-199), respectively. All calculations were performed using the WinGX crystallographic software package.⁷ (“WinGX suite for small molecule single-crystal crystallography”).

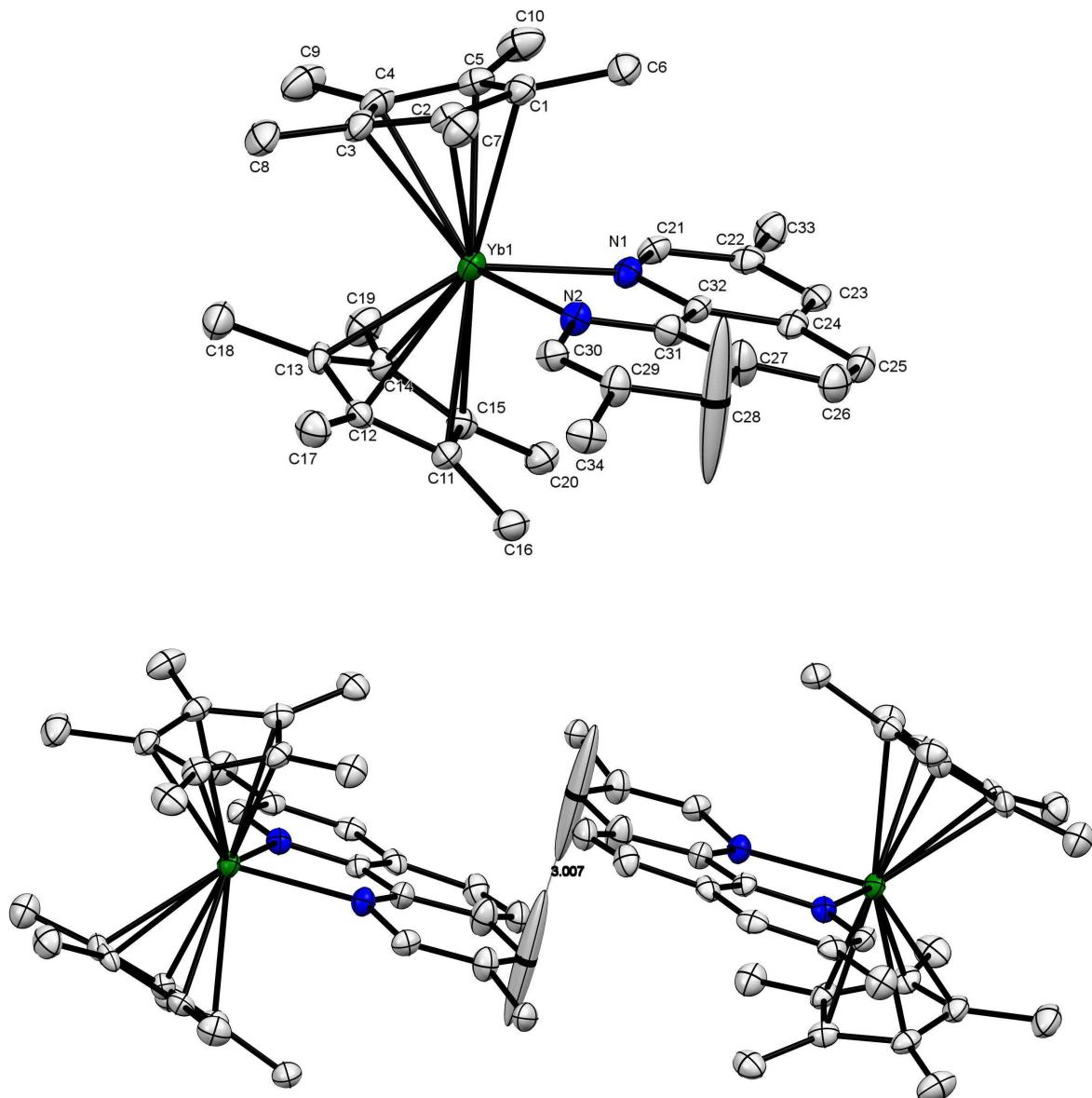

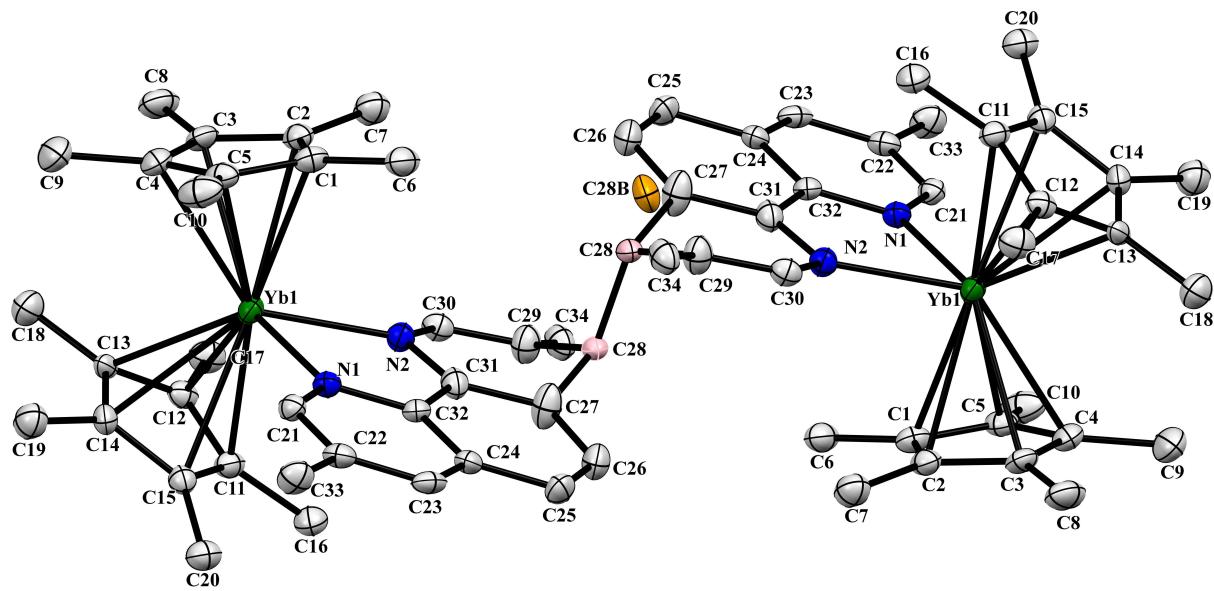

Cp^{*}₂Yb(5,6-Me₂phen) (7), Sublimed.

A fragment of a dark-brown block-like crystal of C₃₄H₄₂N₂Yb sublimed at 195 °C, having approximate dimensions of 0.11 x 0.07 x 0.04 mm was mounted on a Kapton loop using Paratone N hydrocarbon oil. It was transferred to a APEX II QUAZAR diffractometer with CCD area detector,¹ centered in the beam, and the crystal was cooled during data collection by a nitrogen flow low-temperature apparatus previously calibrated by a thermocouple placed at the same position as the crystal (T = 100 K). Preliminary orientation matrixes and cell constants were determined by collection of 36 10 s frames, followed by spot integration and least-squares refinement. A data collection strategy was computed with COSMO to ensure a redundant and complete data set, and the raw data were integrated using SAINT.² The data were corrected for Lorentz and polarization effects, but no correction for crystal decay was applied. An empirical absorption correction based on comparison of redundant and equivalent reflections was applied using SADABS.⁵ XPREP³ was used to determinate the space group. The structures were solved using SIR-97⁸ and refined on all data by full-matrix least-squares with SHEXL-97.⁶ Thermal parameters for all non-hydrogen atoms were refined anisotropically. Hydrogen atoms were found in the Fourier map and refined isotropically.

Figure S24. ORTEP of Cp^{*}₂Yb(5,6-Me₂phen) (7), Sublimed (50% probability ellipsoids).

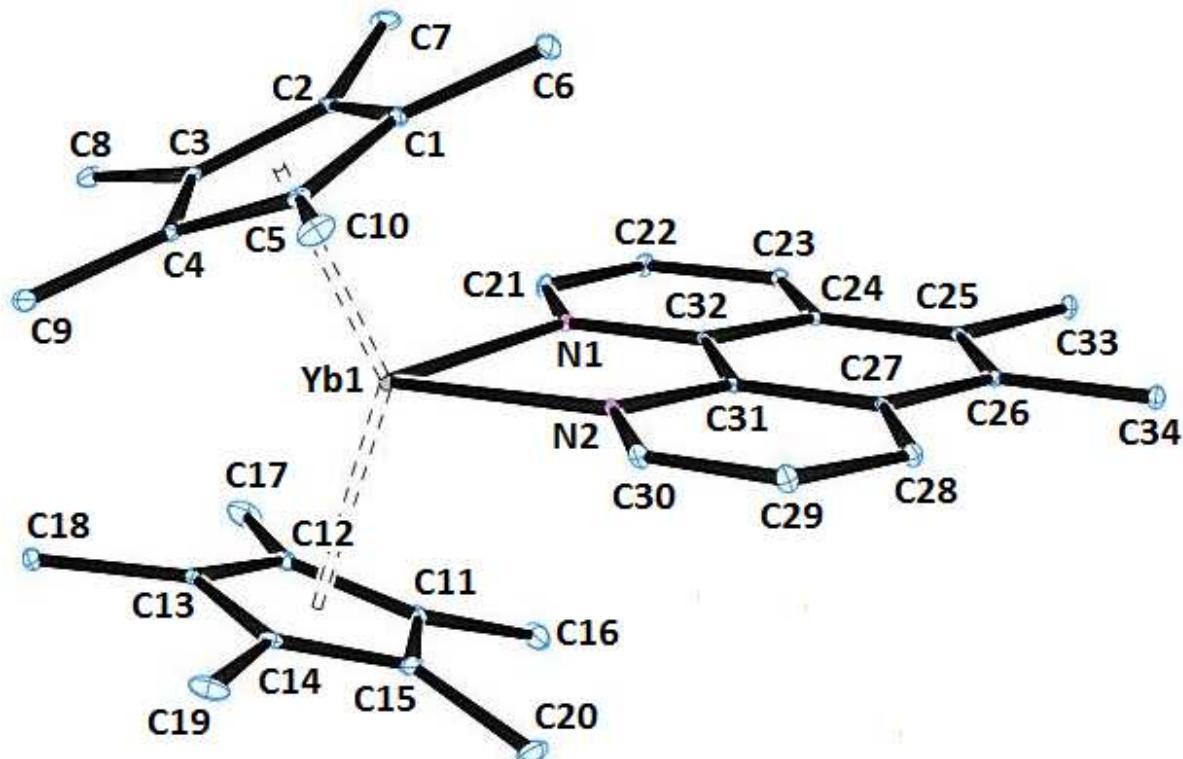

Data collection

A fragment of a red block-like crystal of C₃₄H₄₂N₂Yb (Cp^{*}₂Yb(5,6-Me₂phen)) (7) crystallized from cyclohexane having approximate dimension of 0.3 x 0.30 x 0.20 mn was mounted on a Kapton loop using Paraton N hydrocarbon oil. All measurements were made on a Bruker SMART 1000¹ CCD area detector with graphite monochromated Mo-K α radiation.

Cell constants and an orientation matrix, obtained from a least-squared refinement corresponded to a primitive monoclinic cell with dimensions:

For Z = 12 and F.W. = 651.74, the calculated density is 1.520 g cm⁻³. Based on a statistical analysis of intensity distribution, and successful solution and refinement of the structure, the space group was determinate to be

The data were collected at a temperature of -136(2) °C. Frames corresponding to an arbitrary hemisphere of data were collected using ω scans of 0.3° counted for a total of 10.0 s per frame.

Data reduction

Data were intergrated by the program SAINT² to a maximum 2 θ value of 50.48°. The data were corrected for Lorentz and polarization effects. Data were analyzed for agreement and possible absorption using XPREP.³ A semi-empirical multi-scan absorption correction⁴ was applied using SADABS.⁵ This models the absorption surface using a spherical harmonic series based on differences between equivalent.

Structure solution and refinement

The structure was solved by direct methods.⁶ Non-hydrogen atoms were refined anisotropically and hydrogen atoms were placed in calculated positions and not refined. The final cycle of full matrix least squares refinement was based on 12833 observed reflections ($I > 2.00 \sigma(I)$) and 1000 parameters and converged with unweighted and weighted agreement factors of:

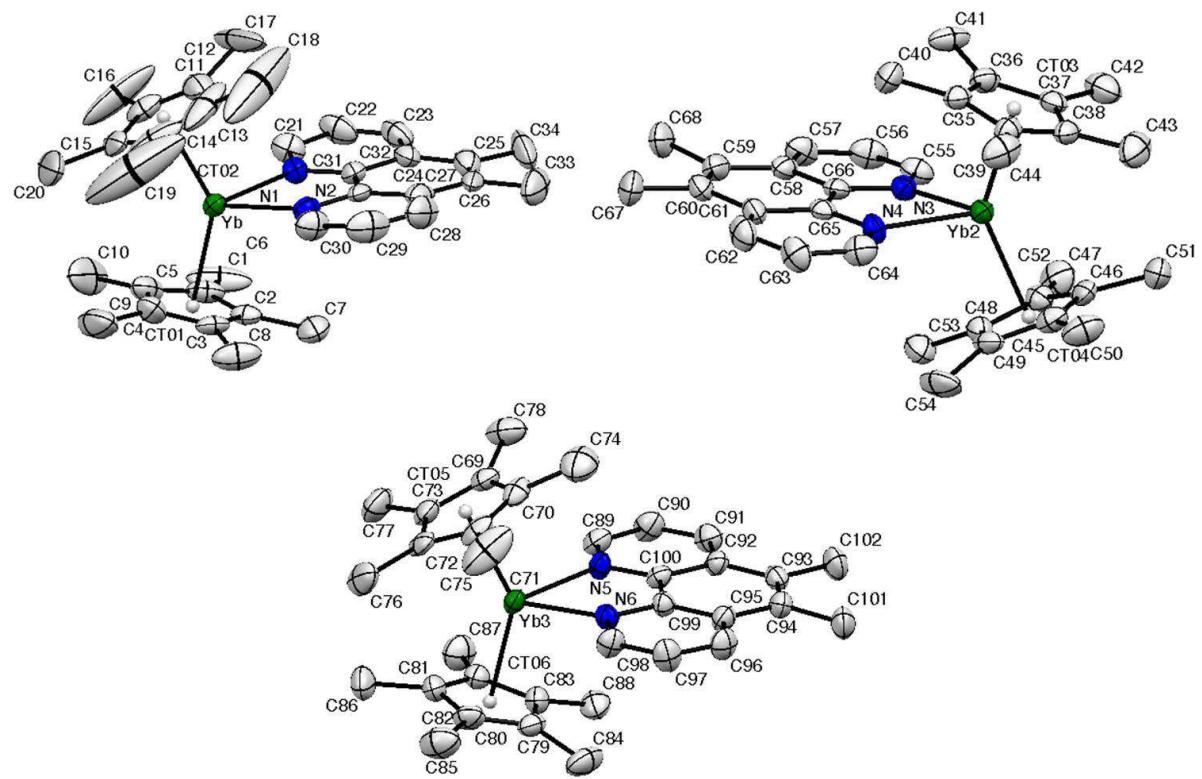
The standard deviation of an observation of unit weight was 0.980. The weighting scheme was based on counting statistics and include a factor p to downweight the intense reflections ($w=1/[\sigma^2 F_o^2 + (0.0188P)^2 + (10.30P)]$ where P=(Max(Fo²,0)+2Fc²)/3). Plot of Σ

$w (|F_o| - |F_c|)^2$ versus $|F_o|$, reflexion order in data collection, $\sin \theta/\lambda$ and various classes of indices showed no unusual trends. The maximum and minimum peaks on the final difference Fourier map corresponded to 1.225 and -0.917 e. \AA^{-3} , respectively.

The SHELX program uses the neutral atom scattering factors, f , f'' and absorption coefficients from International Tables for Crystallography, Volume C (1992), Ed. A.J.C. Wilson, Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht: Tables 6.1.1.4(pp. 500-502), 4.2.6.8 (pp.219-222) and 4.2.4.2 (pp. 193-199), respectively. All calculations were performed using the WinGX crystallographic software package.⁷ (“WinGX suite for small molecule single-crystal crystallography”)

The carbons C16, C17, C18 and C19 have large thermic ellipsoids. As a result several A-levels alerts are present in the checkcif report. However, it does not alterate the structurals parameters (i.e. distances and bond angles) wheather there are refined isotropically or anisotropically.

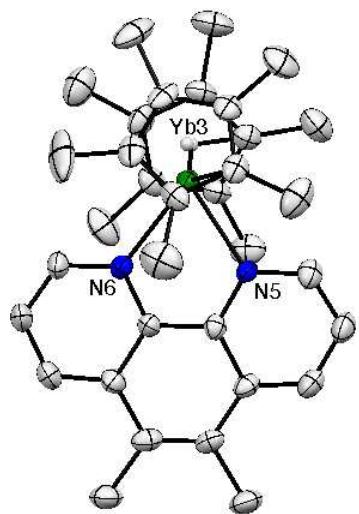
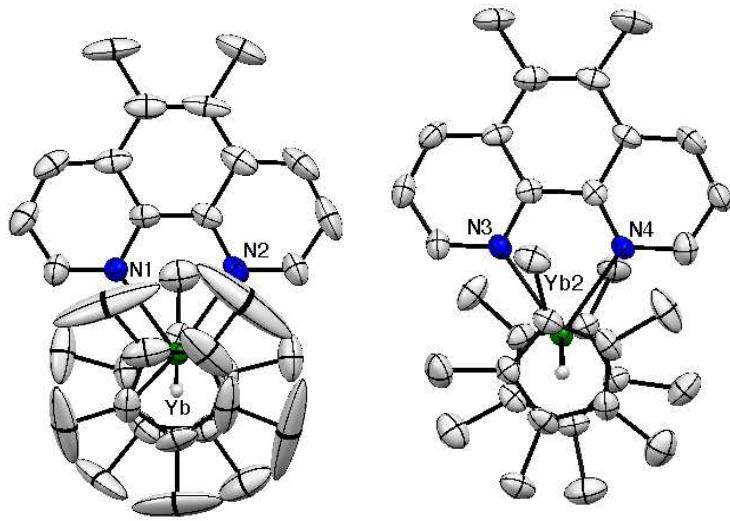

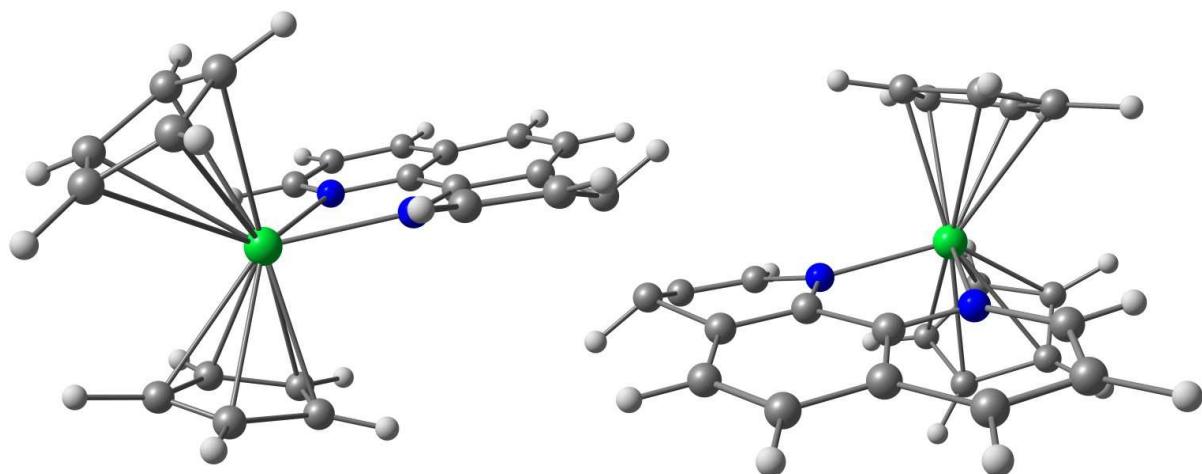
