Conclusions

Localized water

- MgSO₄ hydrate is non-stoichiometric of water
- Rate controlled by diffusional resistance through a thin film at the surface, diffusion coefficient is P_{H2O} and T dependent

van't Hoff law:

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• Activation energy $E_A = 102.3 \text{ kJ.mol}^{-1}$
