

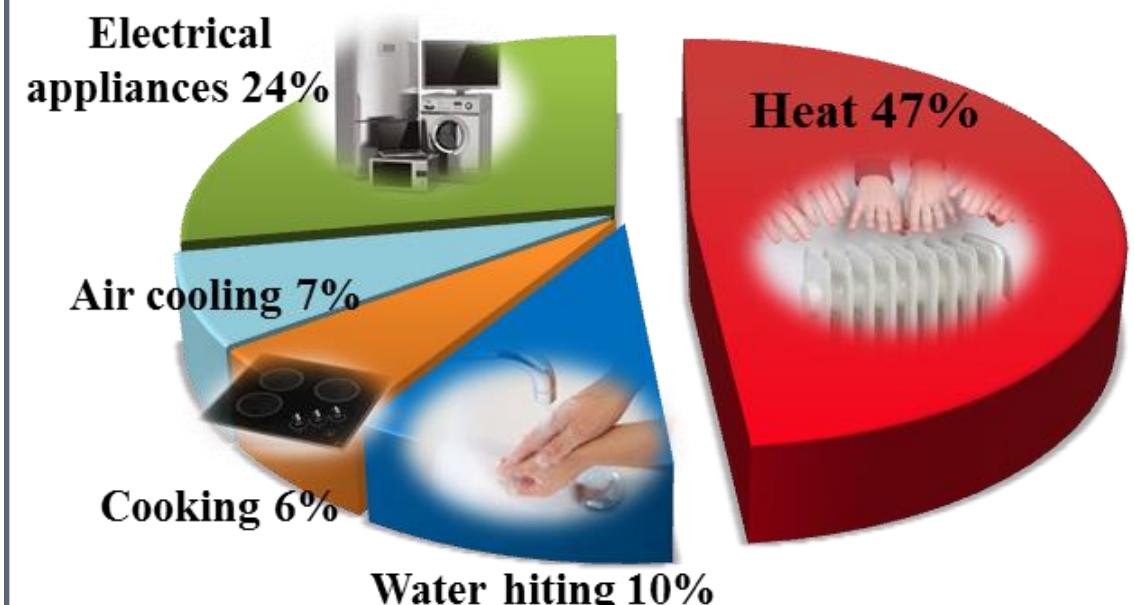

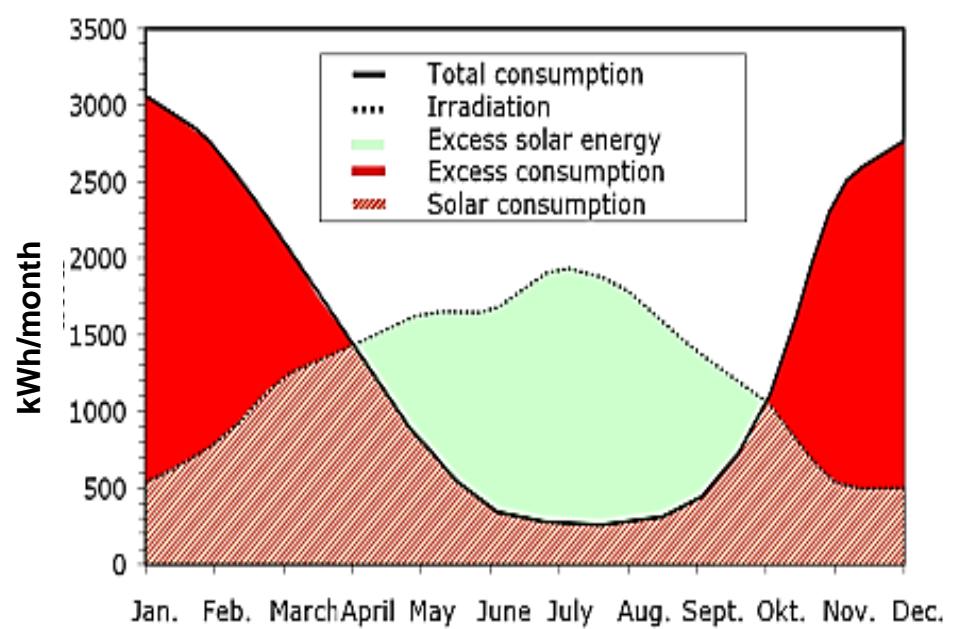
Context



Energy consumption for households in France [1]

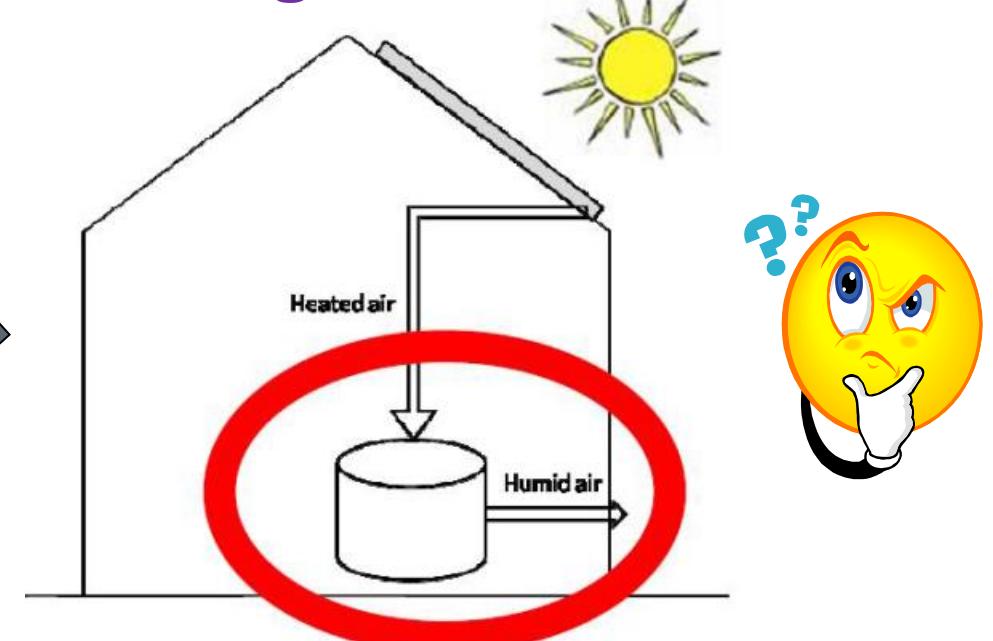


Solar irradiation during seasons



Shift between the supply and the demand of the solar energy

Inter-seasonal heat storage needed



Solution

■ zeolite@ MgSO_4 composite [2,3]:

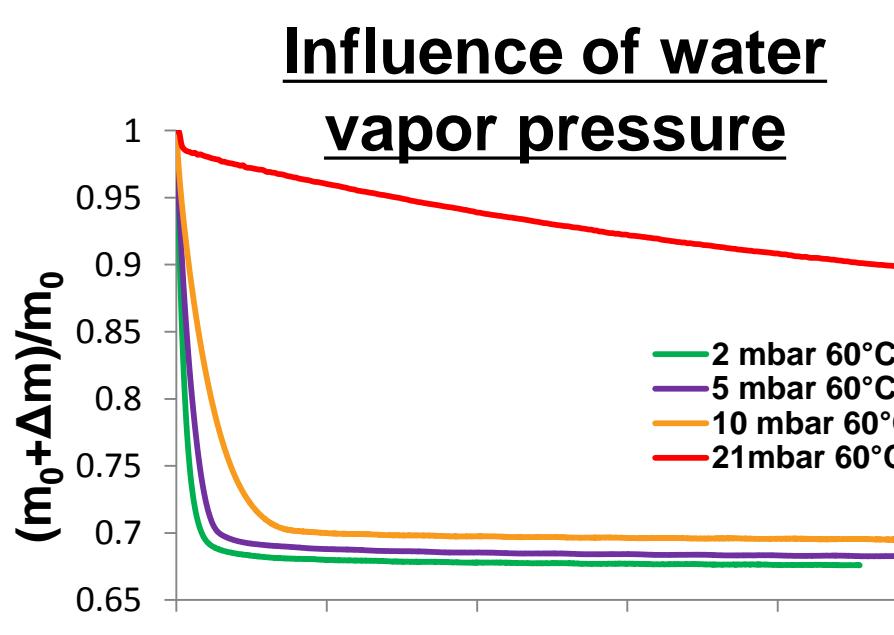
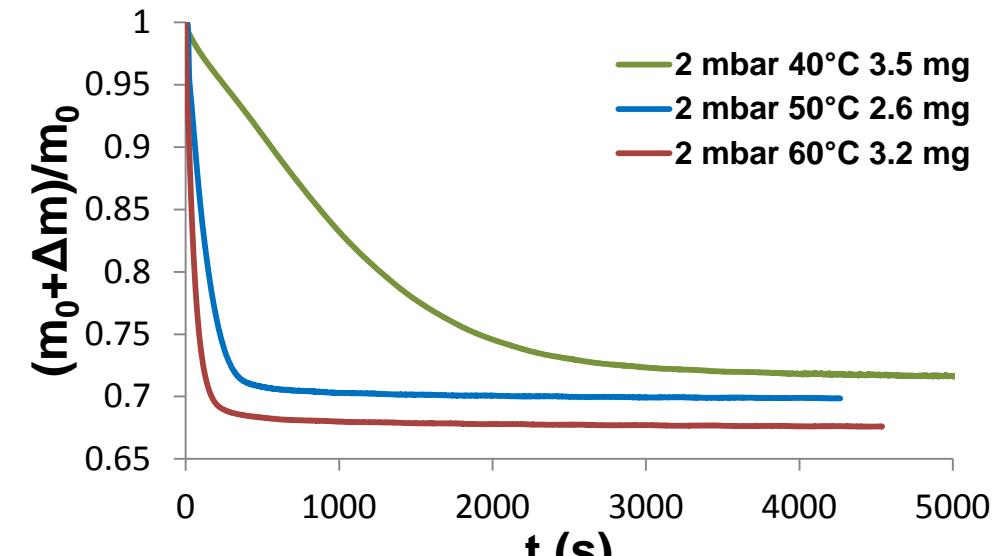
- Heat of hydration
- Energy density
- Sufficient power to a low energy building

Objectifs

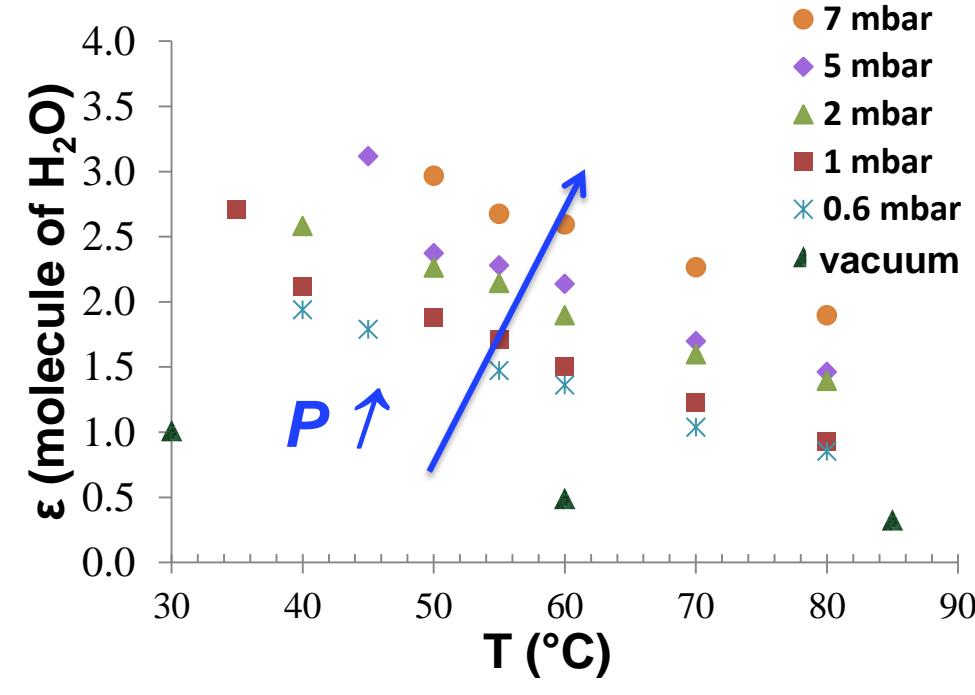
- Kinetic study of dehydration/hydration of MgSO_4
- Determination of reaction mechanisms
- Analysis of coupled phenomena: kinetics (adsorption + chemical reaction) + mass and heat transfer in the zeolite@ MgSO_4 composite

Thermodynamics of $\text{MgSO}_4 \cdot \text{H}_2\text{O}$ system

Influence of temperature



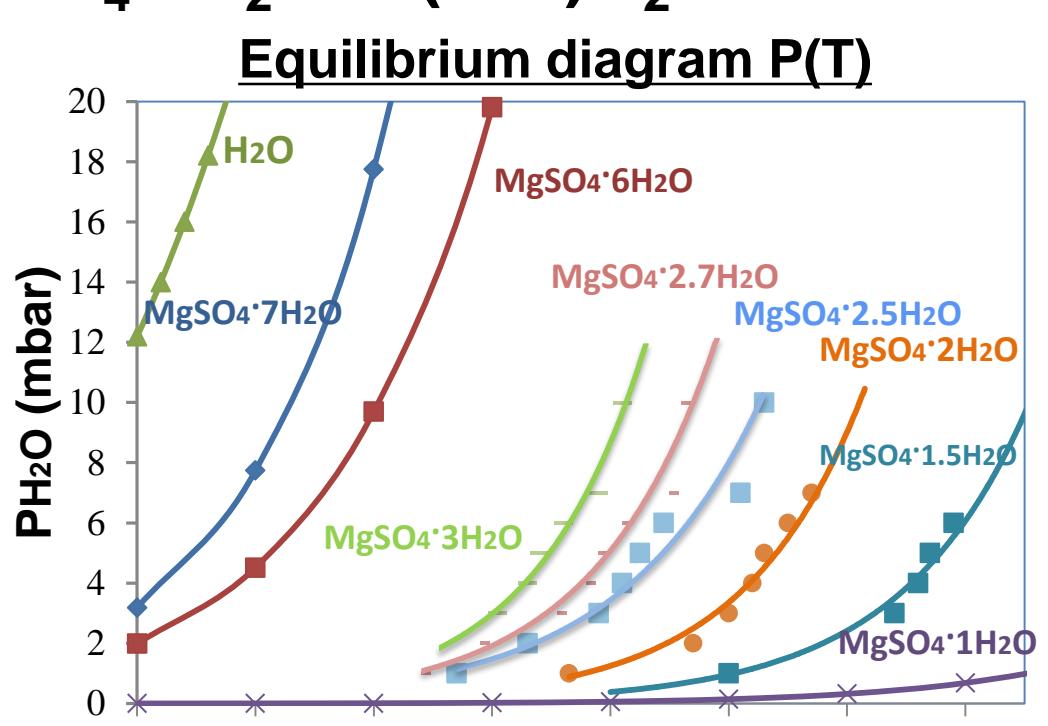
Isobaric of 1, 2, 5, et 10 mbar



$\epsilon(\text{H}_2\text{O}) = f(T)$ at P_{const} → Divariant equilibria between water vapor and water molecules of solid

Localized water molecules isotherm:

$$\epsilon = n + \frac{p \frac{\gamma_1 p^q}{\gamma_2}}{K + \frac{\gamma_1 p^q}{\gamma_2}}$$



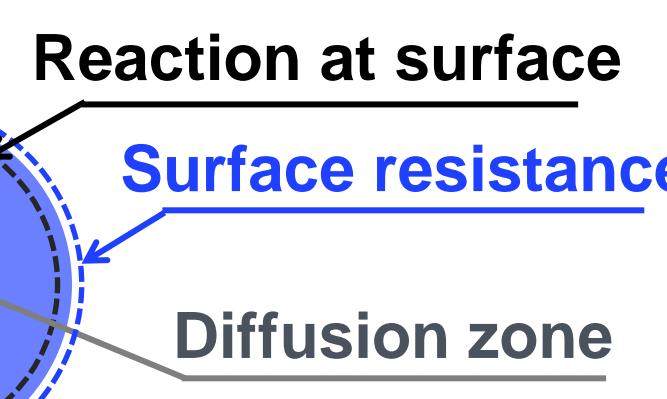
van't Hoff law:

$$\ln K = -\frac{\Delta H^0}{RT} + \frac{\Delta S^0}{R}$$

$$\Delta H^0 = 67.3 \text{ kJ.mol}^{-1}$$

$$\Delta S^0 = 107.3 \text{ J.mol}^{-1}.K^{-1}$$

Kinetics of dehydration



Surface resistance model

$$\alpha_\epsilon = \frac{m_t}{m_\infty} = 1 - \exp\left(-\frac{3kt}{r_0}\right)$$

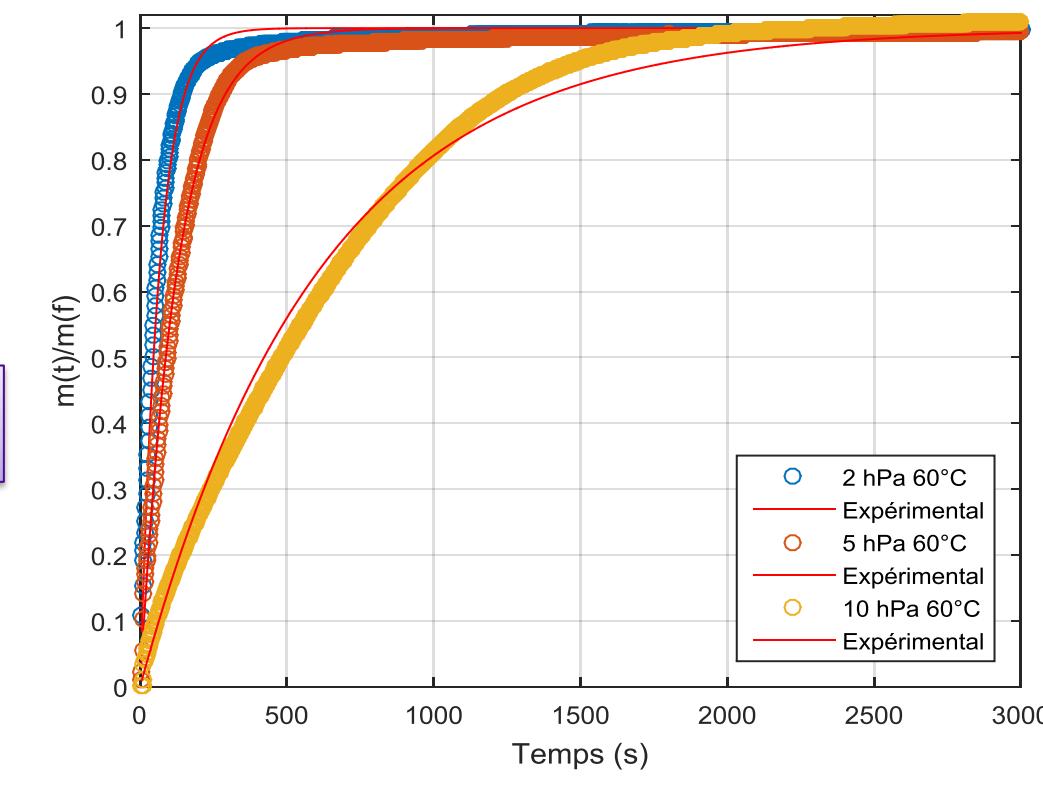
$k = \frac{D}{\delta}$ is mass transfer coefficient

$D = D_0 \frac{\partial \ln P_{\text{H}_2\text{O}}}{\partial \ln C}$ is diffusion coefficient

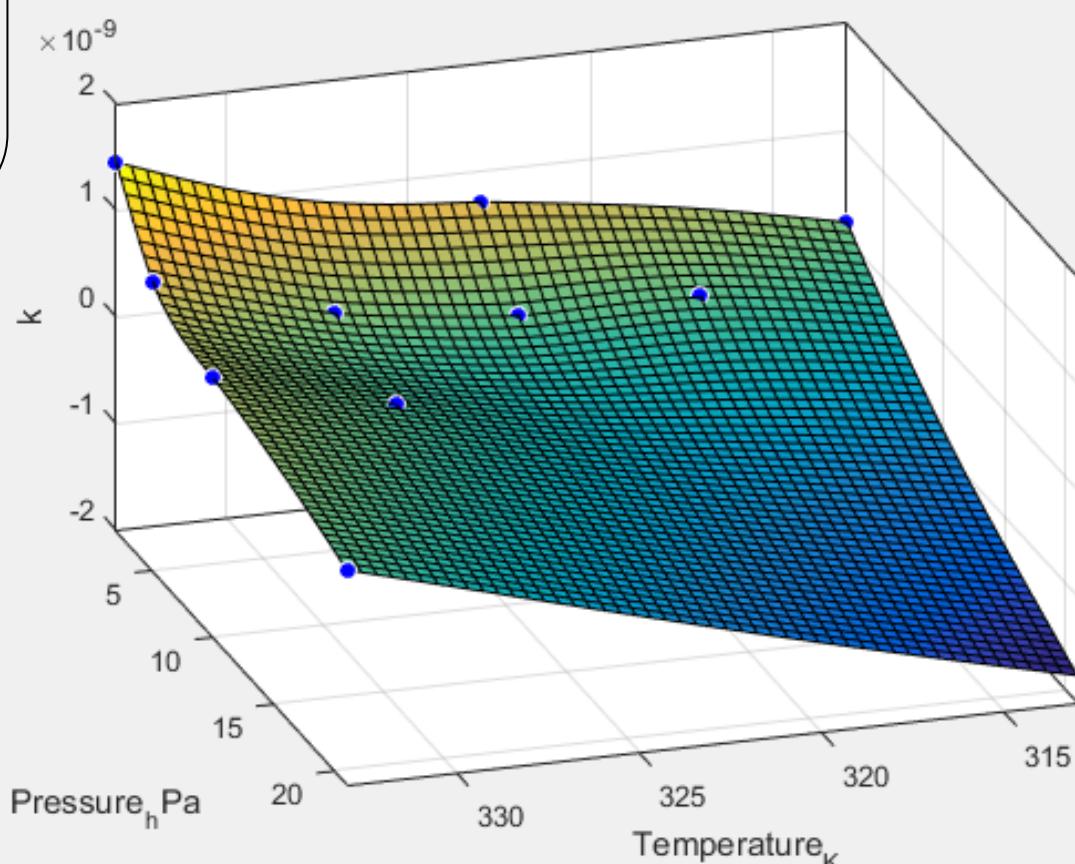
δ is thickness of film surface

r_0 is spherical radius

Experimental kinetic curves of dehydration $\text{MgSO}_4 \cdot 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$



Pressure and temperature dependence of mass transfer coefficient



Arrhenius law:

$$\ln k = \ln k_0 - \frac{E_A}{RT}$$

$$E_A = 102.3 \text{ kJ.mol}^{-1}$$

$$k_0 = 8.9 \cdot 10^6 \text{ m.s}^{-1}$$

Conclusions

- MgSO_4 hydrate is non-stoichiometric of water
- Rate controlled by diffusional resistance through a thin film at the surface, diffusion coefficient is $P_{\text{H}_2\text{O}}$ and T dependent
- Activation energy $E_A = 102.3 \text{ kJ.mol}^{-1}$
