To what extent the syntax of speech is different from the syntax of writing?

=> Focus on an alternation phenomenon: the position of the attributive adjective in French une agréable soirée (anteposed)
une soirée agréable (postposed)
'a nice evening'

Aims

- To model the choice between anteposition and postposition
- To characterize the differences between the syntax of speech and writing

Data

- 6612 occurrences of attributive adjectives modifying a nominal head extracted from
 - FTB: French TreeBank, newspaper corpus => Writing
 - CORAL: CORAL-ROM, spontaneous speech corpus => Speech

Tools

- Statistical modeling of corpus data: mixed-effect logistic regression
- Focus on interactions between modality (speech vs. writing) and syntactic constraints
