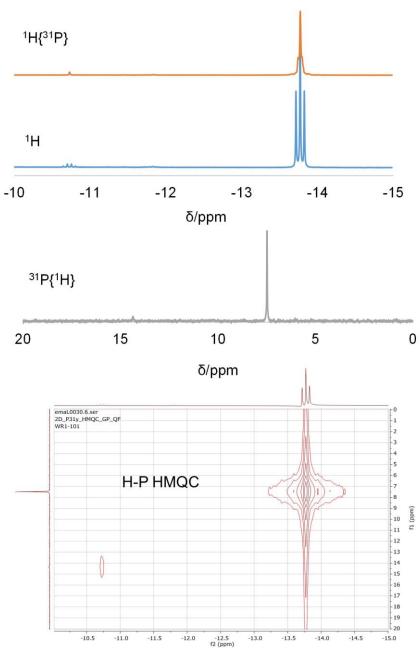


Figure 1S. NMR characterization of the [IrCl(COD)]₂/PPh₃(4 equiv)/KO*t*Bu reaction in isopropanol at room temperature. The solution was evaporated to dryness and redissolved in CDCl₃.

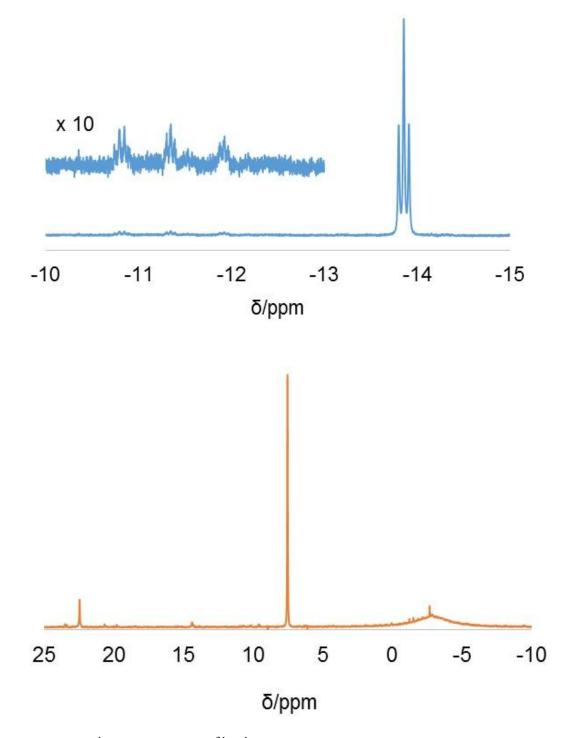


Figure 2S. ¹H (above) and ³¹P{¹H} (below) NMR spectra of the solution obtained from $[IrCl(COD)]_2$, PPh₃ (10 equiv.) and KO*t*Bu (10 equiv.) in *i*PrOH. The solution was evaporated to dryness and redissolved in CDCl₃.

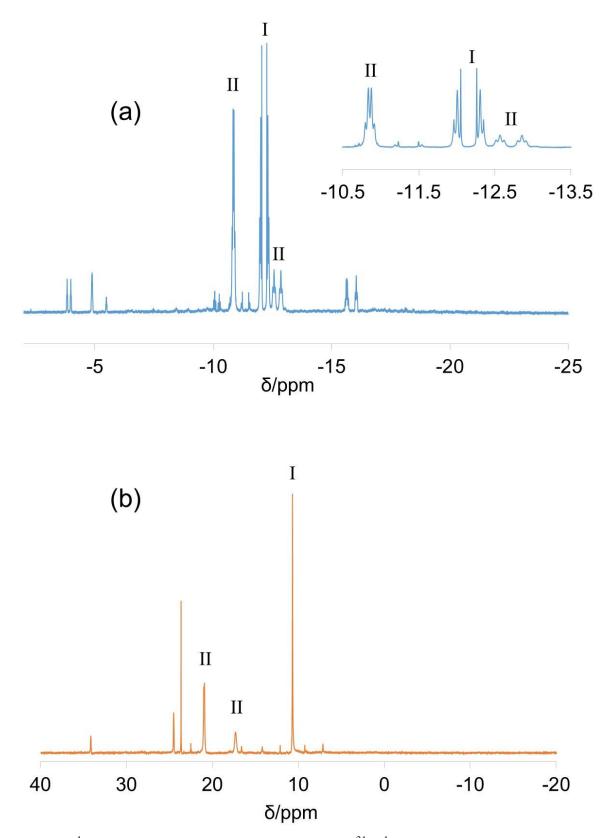


Figure 3S. ¹H NMR in the hydride region (above) and ³¹P{¹H} (below) spectra of the product mixture from the reaction between [IrCl(COD)]₂, PPh₃ (4 equiv) and excess NaOMe in boiling *i*PrOH for 3 h. The spectra were taken on the dried residue redissolved in THF- d_8 .

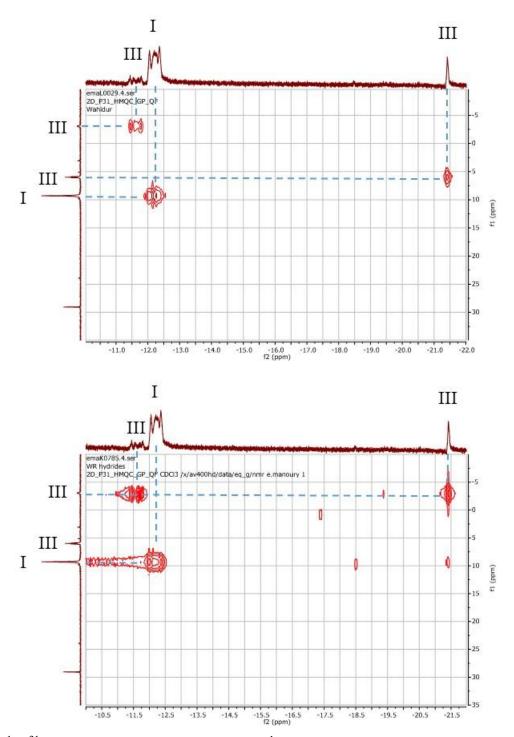


Figure 4S. ${}^{1}\text{H}-{}^{31}\text{P}$ HMQC spectra (expansion of the ${}^{1}\text{H}$ hydride region) for the isolated product of the [IrCl(COD)]₂/4PPh₃/KO*t*Bu reaction in boiling isopropanol (solvent = CDCl₃). The delay was optimized for a J coupling of 5 Hz (above) or 10 Hz (below).

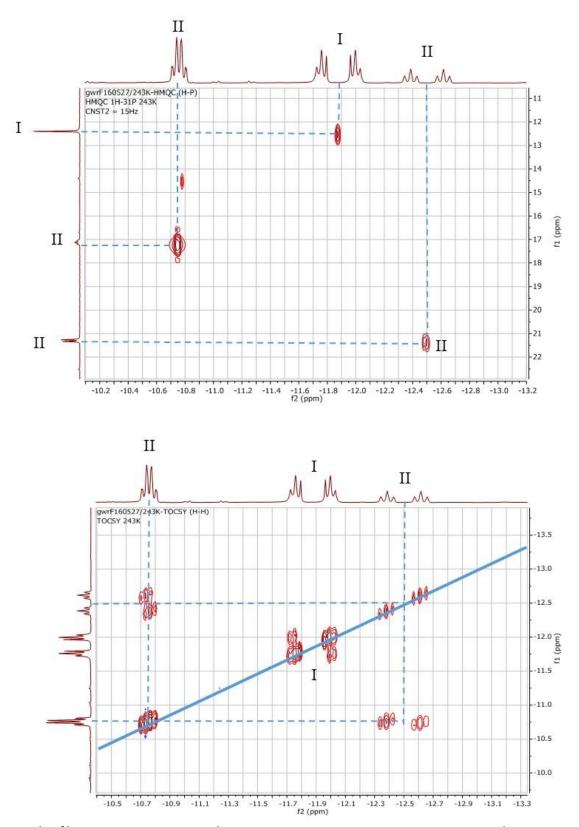


Figure 5S. ¹H-³¹P HMQC (above) and ¹H COSY (below) spectra (expansion of the ¹H hydride region) for the product mixture from the reaction between [IrCl(COD)]₂, PPh₃ (4 equiv) and excess NaOMe in boiling *i*PrOH for 3 h. The spectra were taken on the dried residue redissolved in THF- d_8 .

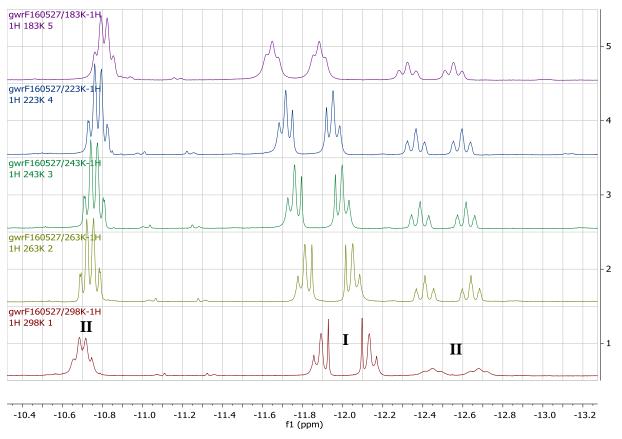


Figure 6S. Detail of the hydride region showing compounds I and II in THF- d_8 solution at different temperatures. The sample is the same one giving the spectra shown in Figures 3S and 5S.

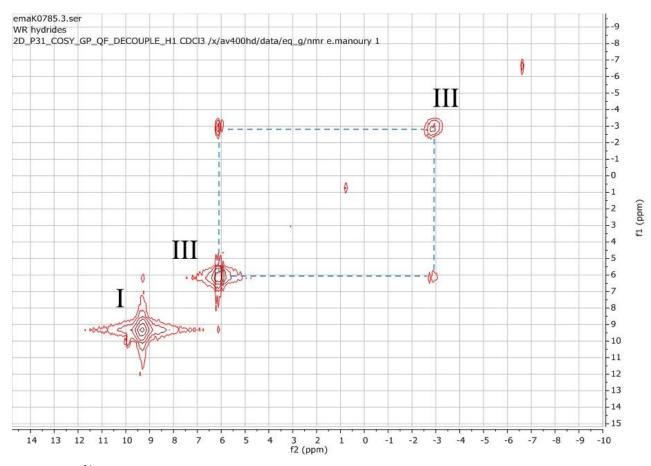


Figure 7S. ³¹P COSY NMR properties of the minor product **III**. The sample is the same one giving the spectra shown in Figure 4 of the main article.
