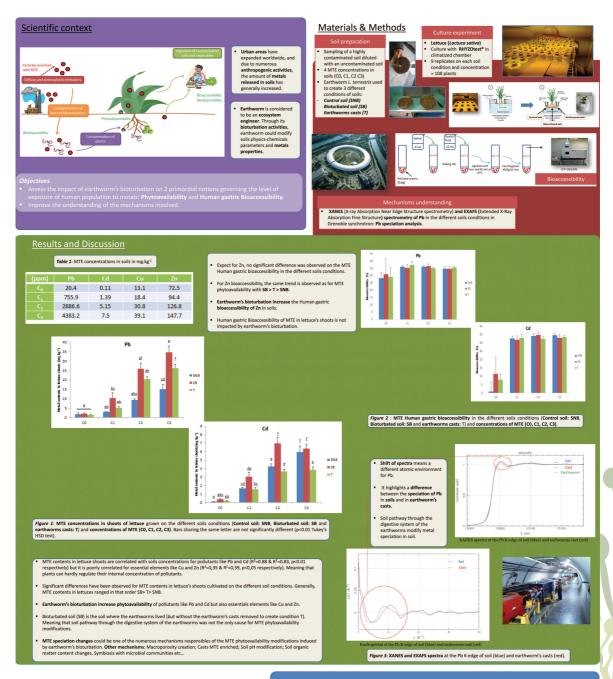

- $\textbf{Earthworm's} \ \text{bioturbation} \ \boldsymbol{\uparrow} \ \textbf{phytoavailability} \ \text{of} \ \textbf{pollutants} \ \text{like} \ \text{Pb} \ \text{and} \ \text{Cd} \ \text{but}$
- Numerous mechanisms involved: MTE speciation changes etc.
- Earthworm's bioturbation increase Human gastric Zn bioaccessibility. Earthworm's bioturbation do not impact MTE bioaccessibility in lettuces.
