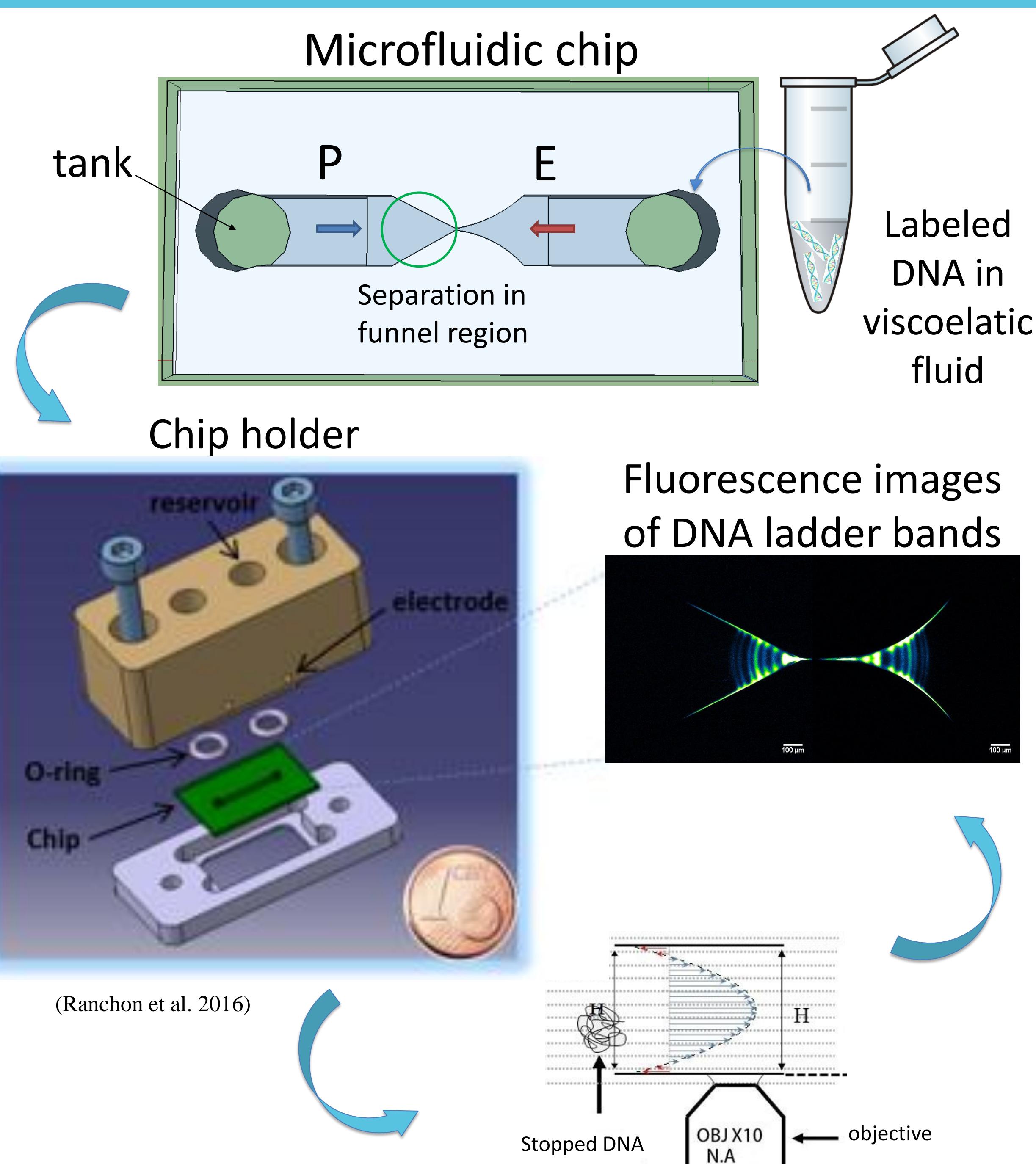

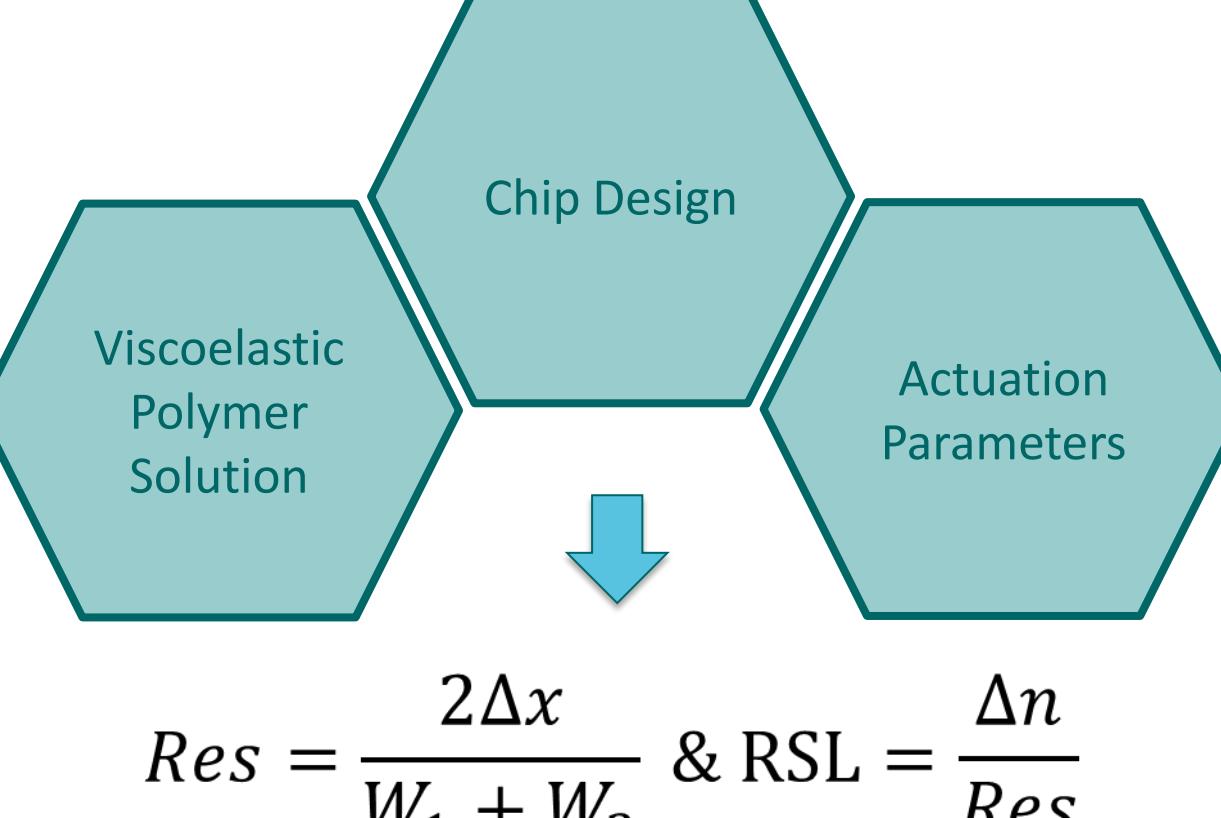
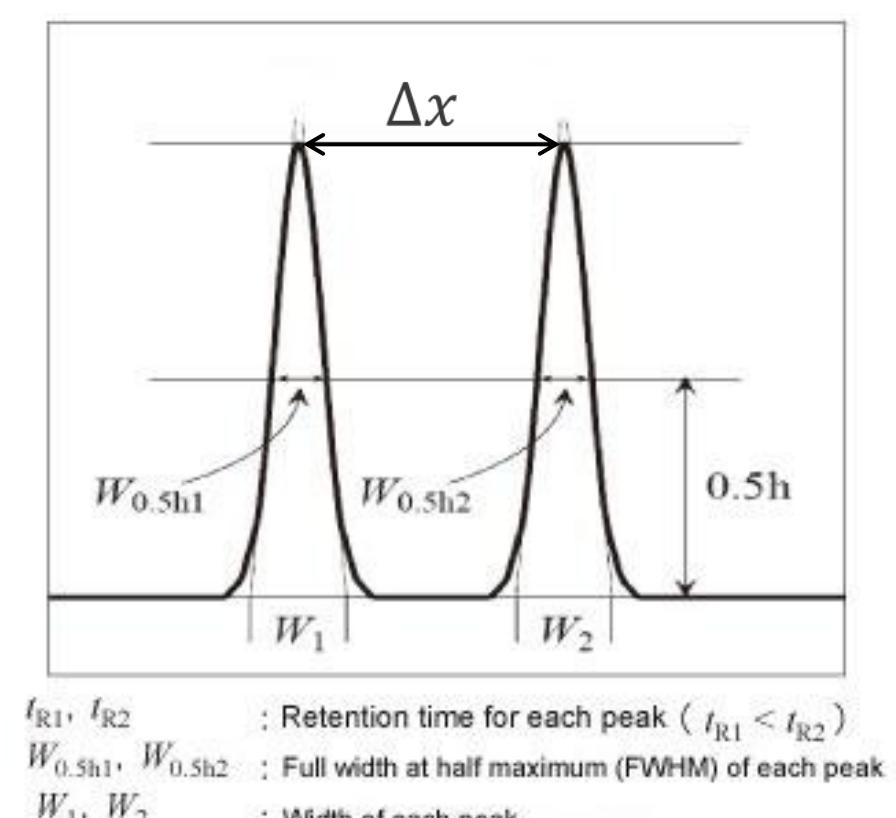

Objective: Analyze circulating DNA by size for the detection of cancer

Technique: Microfluidic lab-on-chip(μ LAS) with **Bidirectional flows** in **Viscoelastic** polymer solution induce **transverse forces** that stop the DNA fragments by size in the funnel region

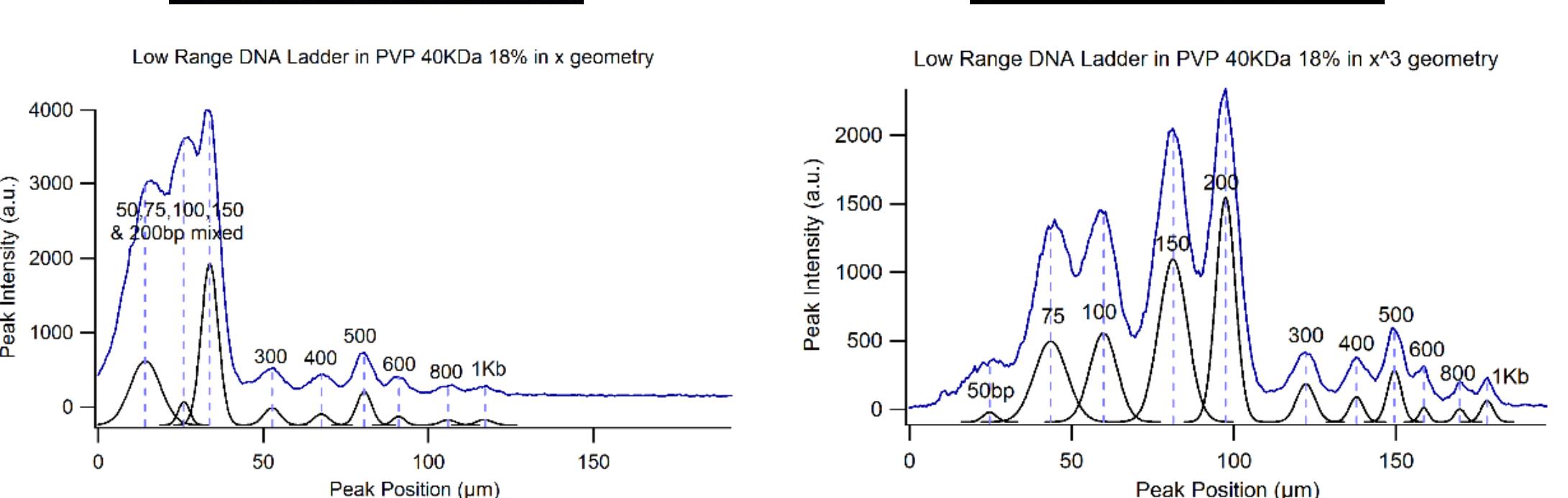
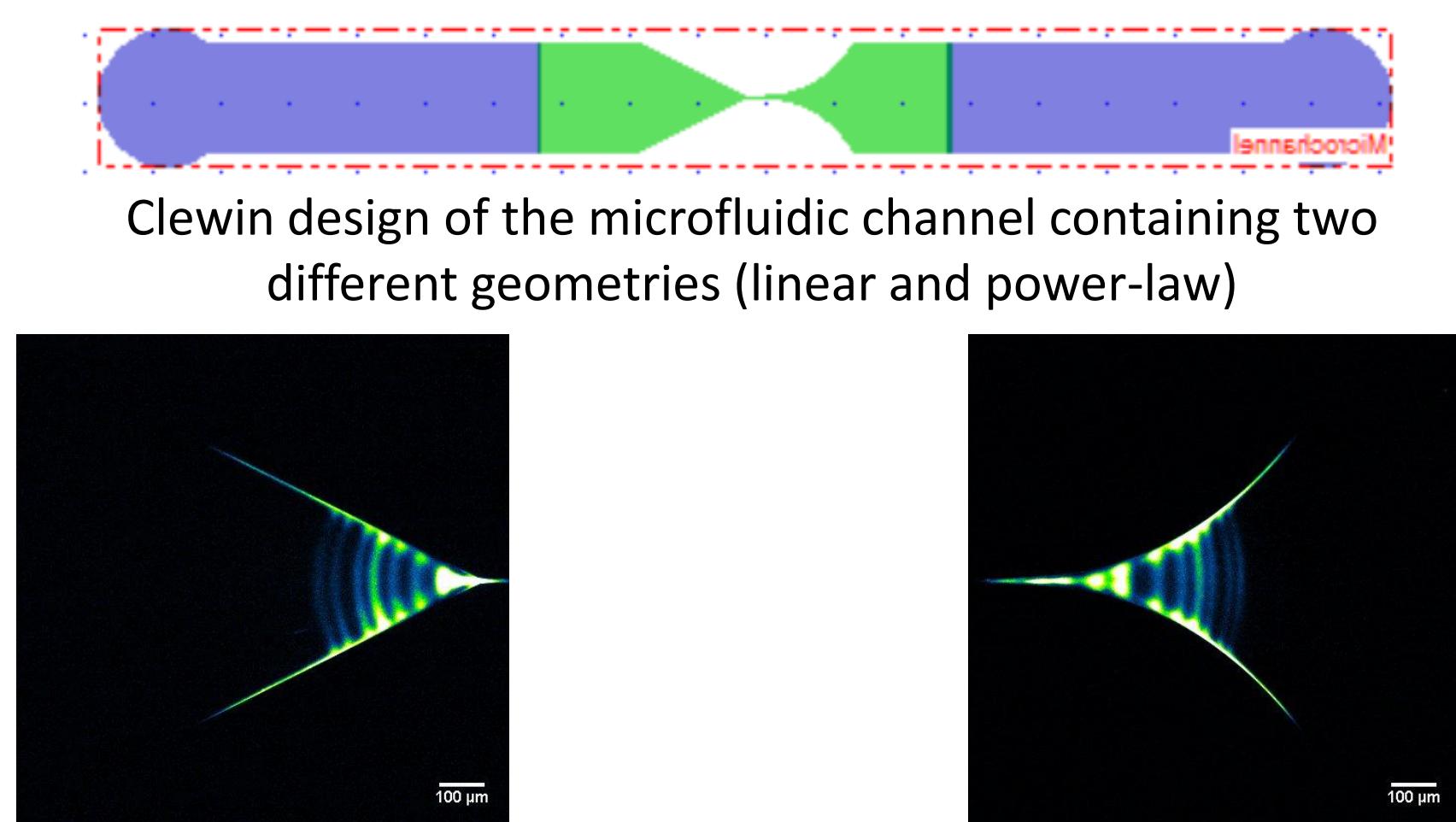


Results: Optimizing the Separation Resolution

Comparison: linear vs. power-law profile



DNA separation and enrichment in the linear versus power-law geometries and their corresponding intensity profiles. In the linear profile bands below 200 bp are unresolved while they are in the power-law profile
