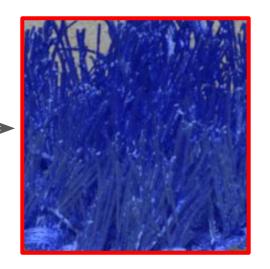
**Density** of microflakes

#### Much more accurate than naïve methods

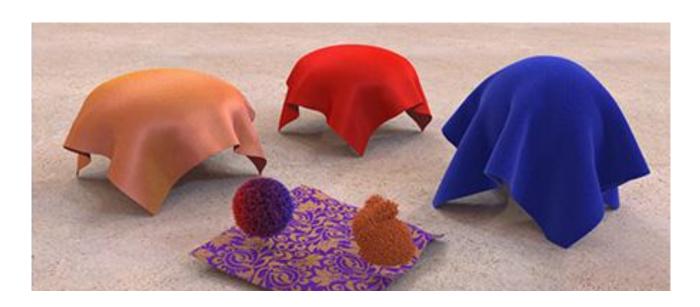

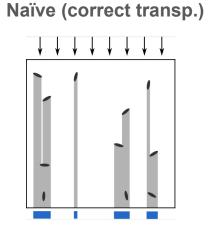
Model of transparent media with multiple scattering at micro-scales







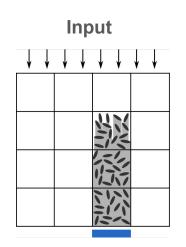


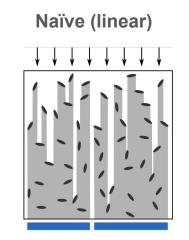


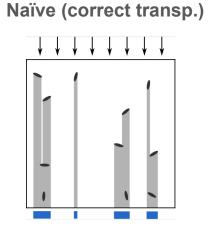


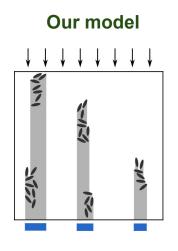














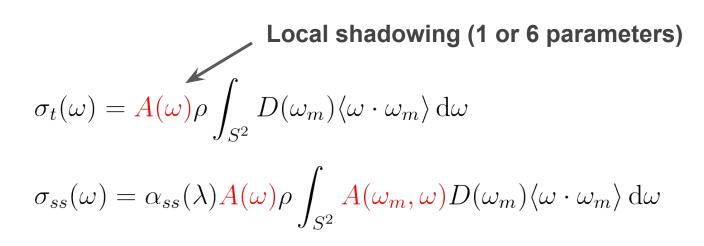
