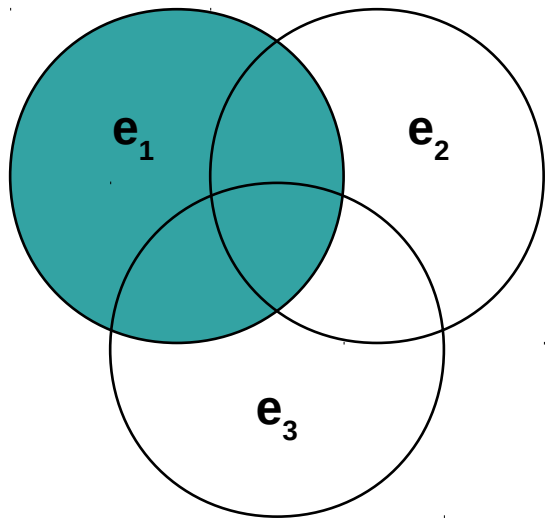
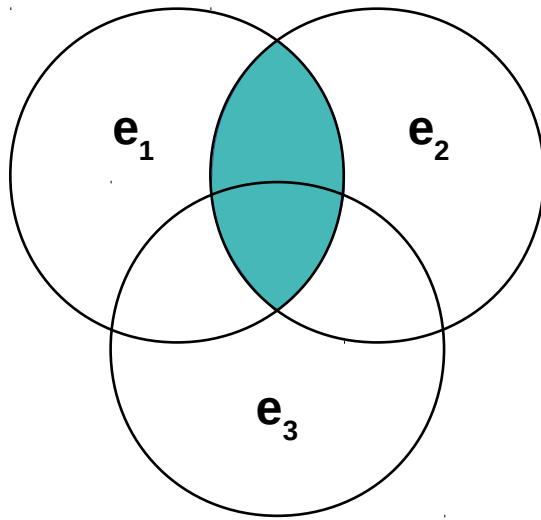


a) $E(\{g_1\}) = e_1$
