Temperature :

- Need for dedicated sample holder
 - « Easy » : -100°C to ~ 300°C « Tricky » : 70 K ... 800 °C « Dedicated » : few K 1500°C

Biasing:

> Sample holder with up to 10 connexions
> Nanofab with electron transparency
> Careful of heating
> High Frequency is the key !

« STM » probing:

Local biasing or stress Developping new tools with magnetic coils
