




MorphoMuseuM mainly aims at publishing 3D anatomy atlases

(no standard for the publication/creation of 3D models exist)







- infrastructure is cheap (<2000 €, hosted at the university)

Drawbacks

- relies 100% on RL (me). Issues when I am out of the lab.
- time spent to correct bugs/develop new functionalities.
- diffusion, archiving, hosting relies on us.

<u>3D data treatment</u>

- I often end-up editing "bad" 3D data myself.
- data pipeline : several actions (data validation and conversion) can not be automated and are done manually.

Editing a 3D journal

- Both technical skills (rare) + scientific skills are needed.
 - → difficult to rely on the editorial board members
- PDF production: I use latex and produced the 47 .pdf files.
 Hard to find someone who can or would like to help.
