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Correction to : On the scattered filed generated by a ball inhomogeneity of constant index

The statement of Lemma A.3 is incorrect and its proof is incomplete. Below is the corrected statement, and its proof.

**Lemma.** For any x > 0 the function  $x \to \ln |H_0^{(1)}(x)|$  is convex. For any y > 1 the function

$$x \to \frac{\left| H_0^{(1)}(xy) \right|}{\left| H_0^{(1)}(x) \right|}$$

is decreasing on  $(0,\infty)$  and

$$1 \ge \frac{\left|H_0^{(1)}(xy)\right|}{\left|H_0^{(1)}(x)\right|} \ge \frac{1}{\sqrt{y}}.$$

Proof. Define

$$f := x \to \ln \left| H_0^{(1)}(x) \right|.$$

The proof (which unfortunately contains obvious typos) given in the paper shows the convexity (not the concavity) of f. Several inequalities of this type are shown in [1]. An asymptotic expansion shows that  $\lim_{x\to\infty} x^4 f''(x) + x^3 f'(x) = -\frac{1}{4}$ , an by inspection we see that

$$x^{4}f''(x) + x^{3}f'(x) < 0$$
 for all  $x > 0$ .

Furthermore,  $x \to x^2 f''(x)$  is increasing. Therefore, for every  $0 < \lambda \leq 1$ , and for every x > 0 there holds

$$x^{2}f''(x\lambda) + \frac{x}{\lambda^{2}}f'(x) \le \frac{1}{\lambda^{2}}\left(x^{2}f''(x) + xf'(x)\right) < 0,$$

thus, for any x > 0,  $y \to x f'(x\lambda) - \frac{x}{\lambda} f'(x)$  is decreasing, and therefore cancels only at  $\lambda = 1$ . We have obtained that  $f'(x\lambda) - \lambda^{-1} f'(x) > 0$  for all  $\lambda < 1$  and all x > 0. Now set  $t = x\lambda$ , and  $y = \lambda^{-1}$ , to derive that

$$yf'(ty) < f'(t)$$

for all y > 1, and all t > 0. In particular,  $x \to \exp(f(xy) - f(x))$  is decreasing on  $(0, \infty)$ , which is our thesis. The bounds follow from the limits the origin and infinity.

## CORRIGENDUM

There is a typo in the statement of Theorem 2.1, Theorem 3.1 and one before last line of the proof of Theorem 2.1. Instead of  $u_s^{\epsilon} \left( |x| = (\varepsilon \omega)^{-1} \right)$ , one should read  $u_i \left( |x| = \varepsilon \right)$ . There is also a typo in the first line of the proof of Theorem 5.1. Instead of  $x \left| \frac{H_n^{(1)}(\sqrt{q_o \omega R})}{H_n^{(1)}(\lambda \omega_{\varepsilon})} \right|^2$ , one should read  $x \left| H_n^{(1)}(x) \right|^2$ .
