On page 3361, the description of the variants of β -casofensin was incorrect. β -Casofensin (GVSKVKEAMAPKH-KEMPFKYPVEPFOTESQ) corresponds to fragment (f)94–123 of β -casein variant A2 but also to β -casein variants A1 and G. The variant of β -casofensin named A1 in our article therefore corresponds to the variant A1 (or A2) with a substitution in position 117 (Gln instead of Glu).

For the purpose of clarification, the sequences synthesized chemically and tested in the context of our study are summarized in Table 1.

The authors regret the errors. For further explanation, see the letters to the editor in this issue (Chessa et al., 2018; Plaisancié et al., 2018).
