Issues : What are the most appropriate indicators to measure the development of health promotion in schools ?

Good understanding of teaching activity in health education

Issues : How professional working with young (very young) in other service take into account basic needs ?

good understanding of the factors underlying the development of health promoting schools

Global issues are linked to tackle social inequities by taking into account basic needs by every single professional in any services and in a ecological / complex approach (politic, practice and user need, in a specific context)

good understanding of the collective activity of professionals involved with young people in health education / psychosocial skills development

**Issues :
How to develop health education tools and project that support everyday teaching practices?**

Good understanding of the processes for implementing health education tools and devices and their impacts on teaching practices

Issues : develop tools validated scientifically (in appropriate language) and adapted to the different age groups of young people
