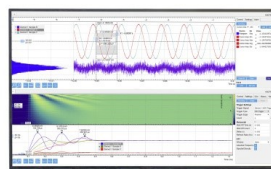

In Table I of Ref. 1, the values of the parameters S_1 and S_2 should be $S_1 = 5.56087$ and $S_2 = -2.5205$. The values provided in the original paper had not been made dimensionless, as they should have been for implementation of the equation of state. The results of the paper are unaffected.
