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

<sup>1</sup>H NMR chemical shifts of epicatechin-(4→5)-menthofuran.



<sup>13</sup>C NMR chemical shifts of epicatechin-(4→5)-menthofuran.



HSQC spectrum of epicatechin-(4→5)-menthofuran.











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

UV chromatograms (280 nm) of the grape seed extract depolymerization products obtained with menthofuran at all the reaction time performed (i.e., 5 min, 15 min, 35 min, 65 min, 85 min, 115 min, 145 min, 205 min, 305 min, and 485 min) for a single kinetic experiment out of three independent replicates. **1**: C (Retention Time (RT) 2.2 min; 291 m/z), **2**: EC (RT 2.5 min; 291 m/z), **3**: ECG (RT 3.0 min; 443 m/z), **4**: C-MF (RT 5.3 min; 439 m/z), **5**: EC-MF (RT 5.7 min; 439 m/z), **6**: ECG-MF (RT 5.9 min; 591 m/z). The peak areas measured for these six products are used to obtain Figure 2.

Retention times determined with (a) the first gradient conditions given in the section Analytical method (UHPLC-DAD-MS system), (b) the second gradient conditions applied exclusively to menthofuran analyses.

Molar responses relative to EC (c) were determined by calibration with commercial standards, (d) were found in Kennedy and Jones<sup>30</sup>, (e) were obtained by depolymerizing a procyanidin B2 sample with a large excess of nucleophile, (f) were assumed considering that the additional nucleophile moiety does not alter the molar response of the flavanol.







Kinetics of the depolymerization tests performed on procyanidin B2 with 1 molar equivalent of nucleophile including menthofuran, phloroglucinol, and 2-mercaptoethanol. Procyanidin B2 are represented by black triangles, extension units (EC-NU) by red circles, and terminal units (EC) by blue squares, all concentrations being normalized by the initial concentration of procyanidin B2. The same experimental data are used in Table 1.

UV chromatograms (280 nm) of the grape pericarp depolymerization products obtained with 2-mercaptoethanol for a single characterization experiment out of three independent replicates. **1**: C (Retention Time (RT) 2.6 min; 291 m/z), **3**: ECG (RT 3.8 min; 443 m/z), **4'**: C-ME (RT 3.2 min; 367 m/z), **5'**: EC-ME (RT 3.6 min; 367 m/z), **6'**: ECG-ME (RT 4.2 min; 519 m/z), **7'**: EGC-ME (RT 3.0 min; 383 m/z), **8'**: EGCG-ME (RT 3.4 min; 535 m/z). The peak areas measured for these seven products are used to obtain Figure 3.
