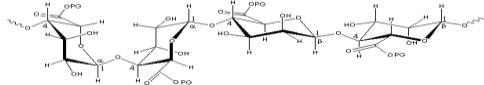


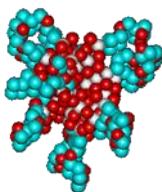

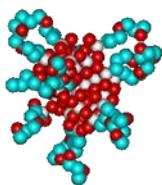

SiO Nanoparticles by Sol-Gel Techniques

Sol Gel

Sol-gel process:

Solid gels from metal oxide derivatives SiO, TiO₂

..

- Low energy
- Aqueous medium, ambient temperature réactions
- Compatible with sensitive biological compounds
- From SiO functionalized nanoparticles
 - Large panel of organic functionalization
 - New hybrids inorganic-organic material
 - New polysaccharide-Siloxan interpenetrated gels



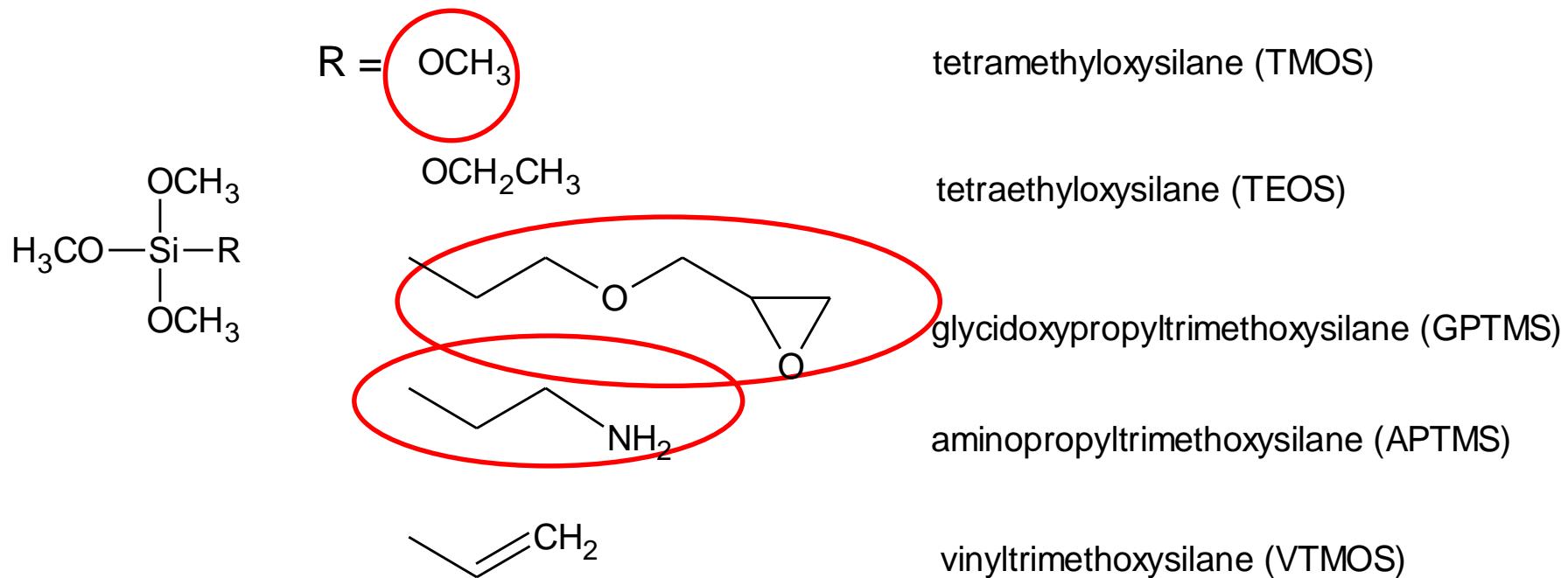

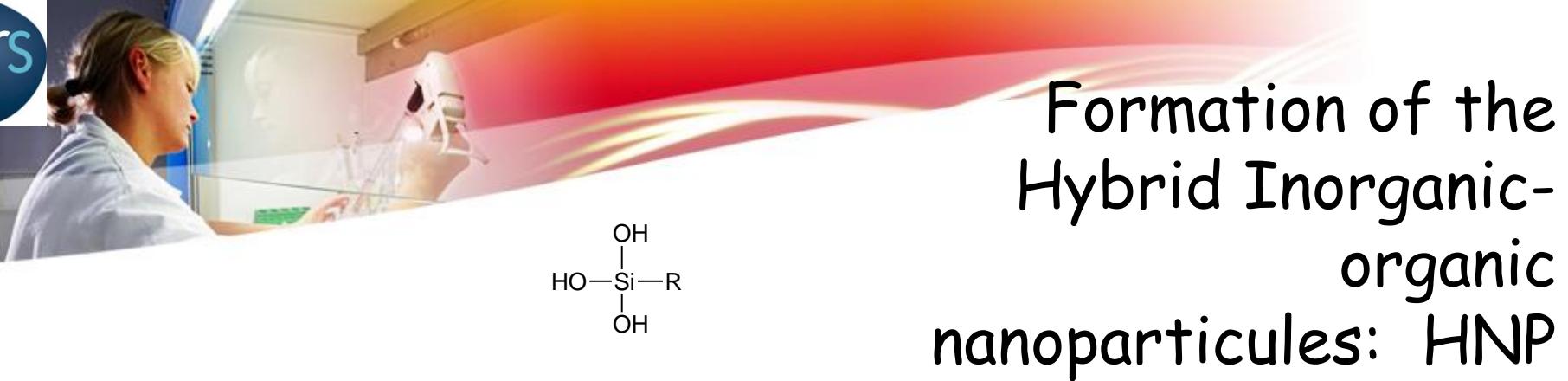
SiO Nanoparticles by Sol-Gel Techniques

- Possible precursors are:

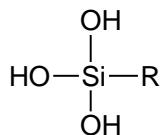

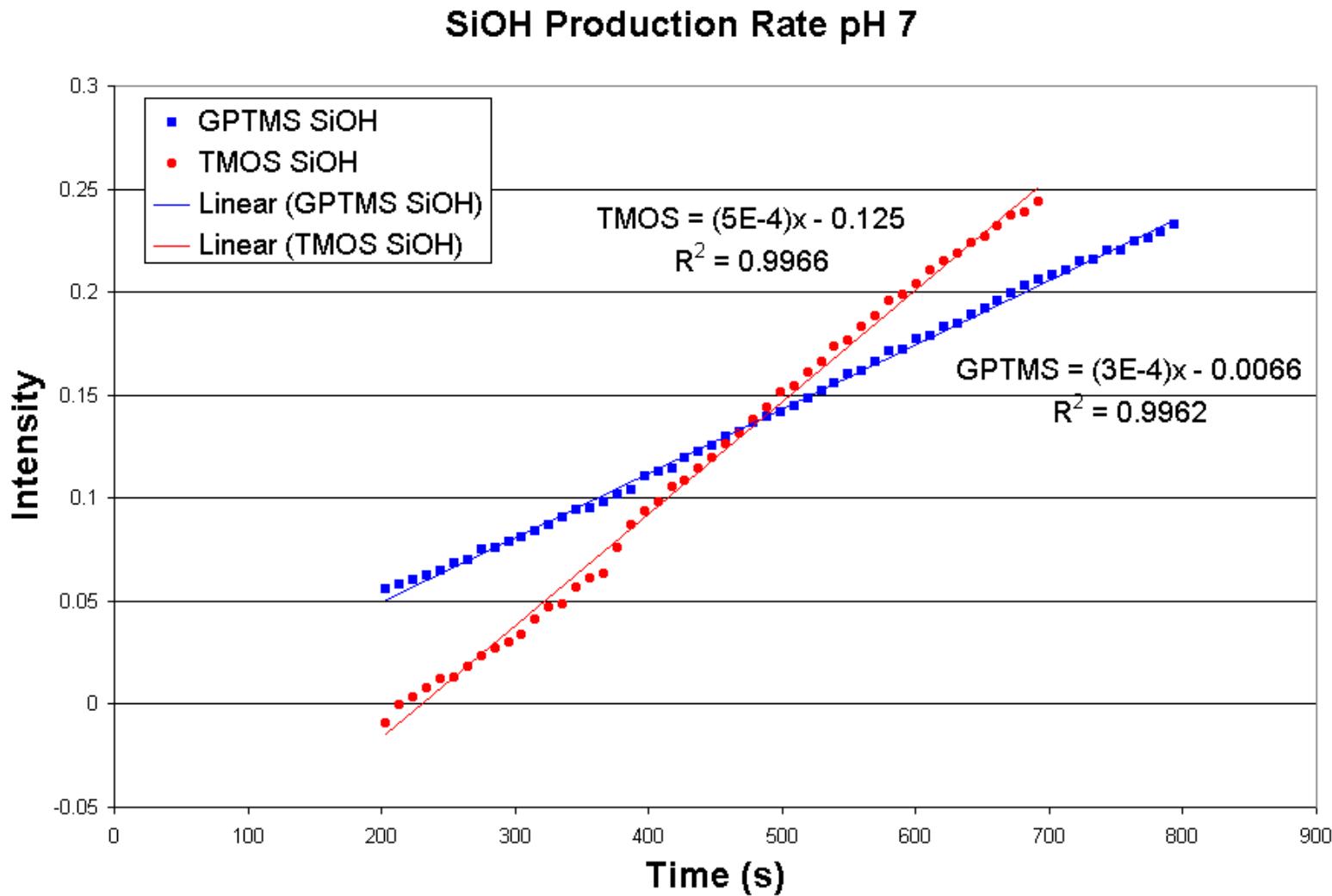


TMOS: In-Situ IR Analysis

- Methoxysilane precursors
 - SiOCH_3 at 832, 1071, 1196 cm^{-1}
- Hydrolysis products
 - MeOH at 1018 cm^{-1}
 - SiOH at 944 cm^{-1}

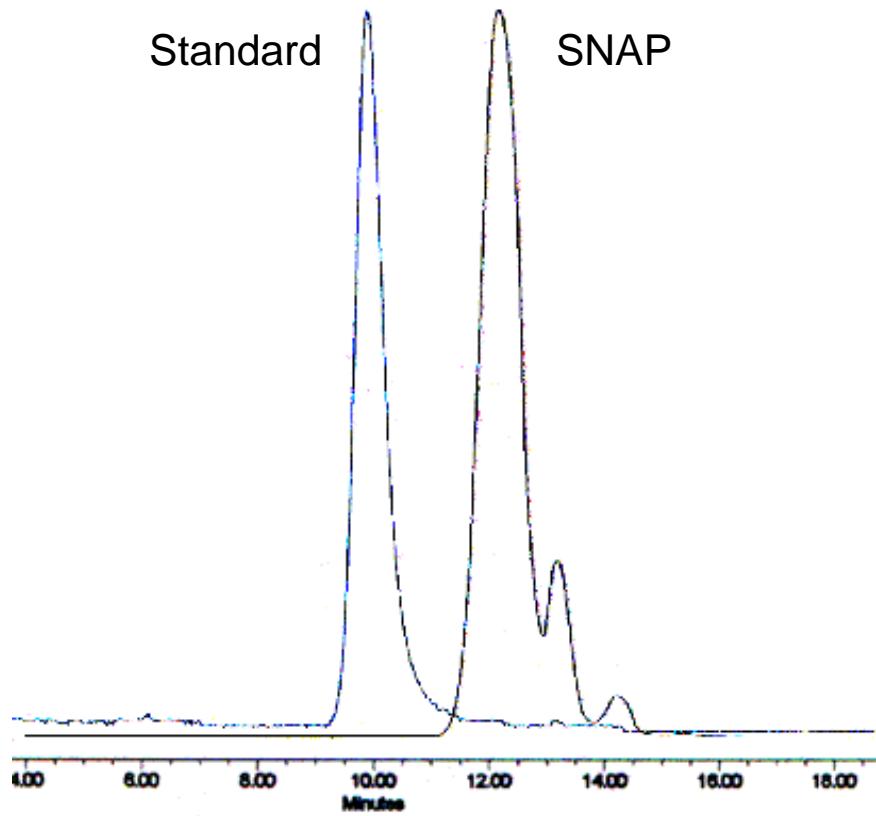

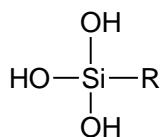


Particle Size by Gel Permeation Chromatography

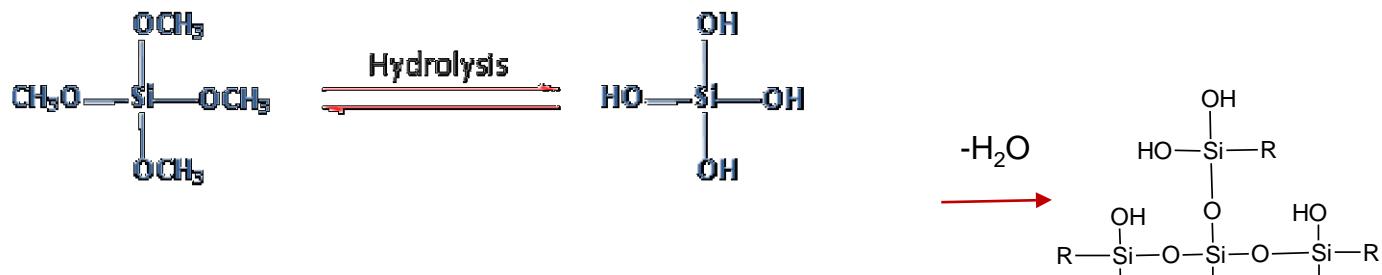
- Particles grow in solution ~ 10 K amu
- Reasonable M.wt. distribution
- Correspond to 60-72 silanes per particle
 - 15-18 TMOS
 - 45-54 GPTMS



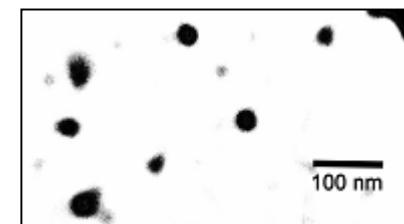
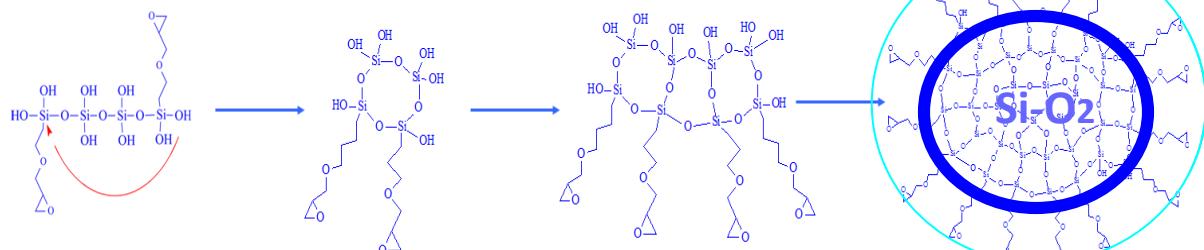
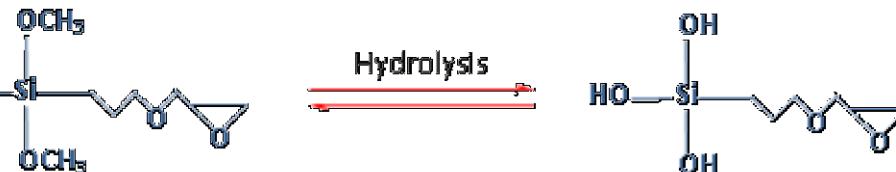

Reactivity of Glyco Nanoparticles Bio-Hybrids BHNP

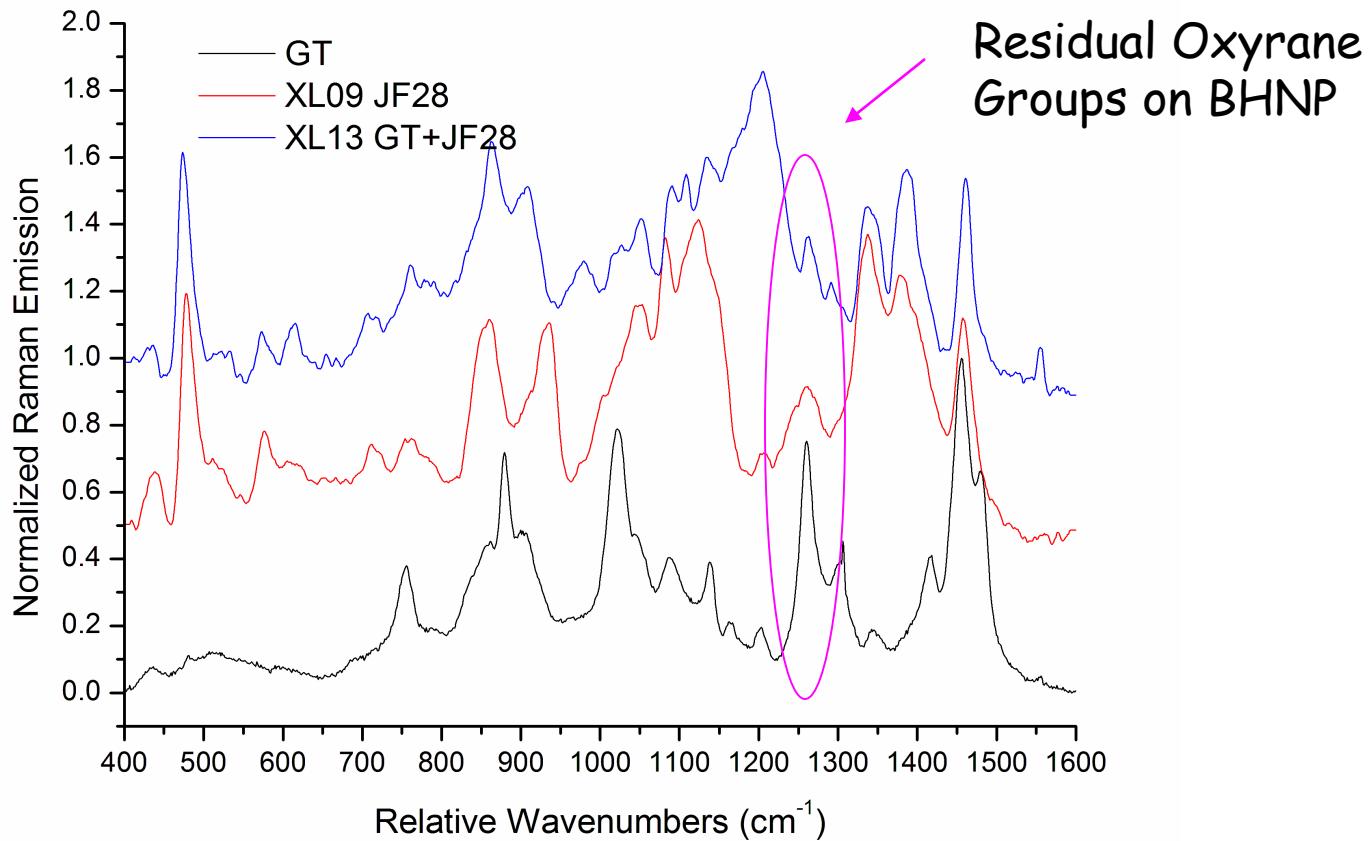


Glc-EA grafting onto GT \rightarrow BHNP unstables

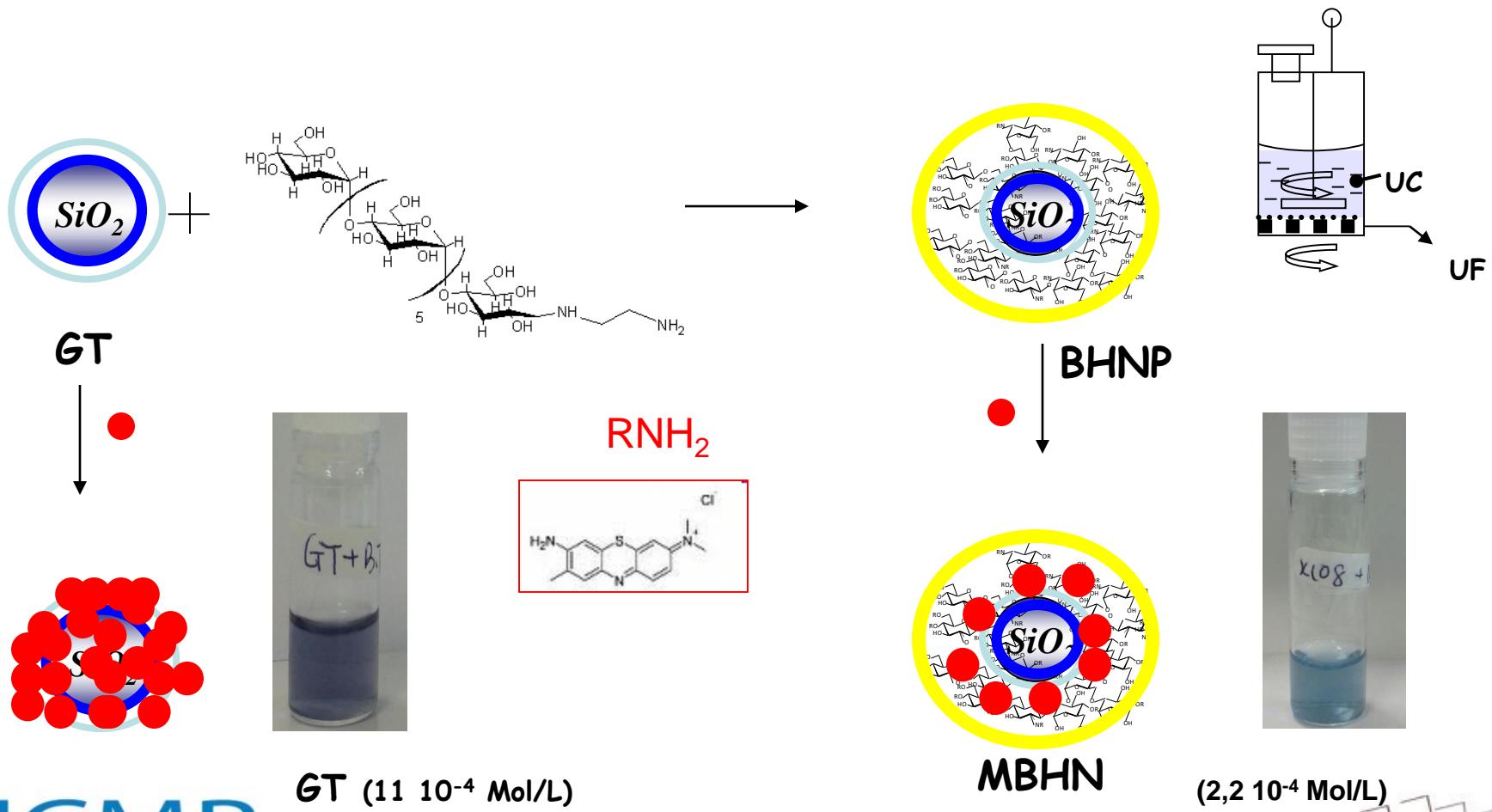


Charactrisation of residual oxyranes on BNP

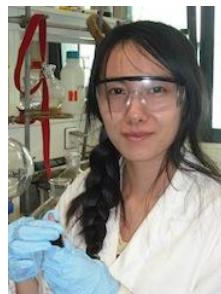
