## Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes - Context

• Context: Breast cancer and axillary lymph nodes



Stage Cancer is determined by: T (tumor volume) N (number of lymph nodes with cancer) M (metastasis state)

#### Diagnosis:

 Doctors proceed to do a surgical procedure to remove all the branches of vessels where a lymph cancer node is present

Normal patient with no breast cancer

Patient with breast cancer

#### Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes - Contribution

- Brown fat has the same metabolism as tumor cells
- They generate FALSE POSITIVES that require extra-time to be visualized by doctors



#### **Contribution:**

- Algorithm can automatically detect N (number of lymph nodes with cancer cells) and contribute to the determination of cancer staging
- Help doctors to identify quicker false positive cancer lymph nodes

#### **Ideal PET acquisition**

Brown fat shows up(due to exposure to cold). Brown fat has the same metabolism as tumor cells

# Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Preprocessing

- Rigid transformation in order to register PET and CT
- Voxel normalisation of isotropic size of 1.5mm<sup>3</sup> for both PET and CT

## Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Preprocessing

• Perform windowing in CT scans to enhance lymph node visualization

Windowing in CT:

Remove gray values bellow – **120 HU** Remove gray values above + **120 HU**

### Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Patch Extraction for CNN

- Positive patches (white bounding boxes) contain a whole lymph node
- > Negative patches (red bounding boxes) contain a piece of lymph node or no lymph node at all

# Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Methodology – 3D Component trees

For a given voxel **v**, it is assigned:

- The valid ratio value of its nearest ancestor node

- **-1** if itself or none of its ancestors has a valid ratio and volume



V1 Descriptor (area and ratio)



Goal: Keep the connected components that describe the best a cancer lymph node

#### **Ideal Result**

Volume descriptor (blue voxels represent cancer lymph nodes)

-1 (all the voxels that do not intersect a lymph node)
 Ratio value (voxels that intersect a lymph node)

### Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Methodology – 3D Component trees

- A 3D component tree is extracted from a PET volume
- Total number of nodes: 1863
- Grays values quantification: 0-63
- Results : Based on meaningful descriptors area and ratio

**Ground-truth-mask** 



Results of lymph nodes candidates All lymph nodes are preserved however false positives remain

Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Results – Using only neural network

Ground-truth
Prediction

Mean dice score (10 datasets) : 53.76/100



Dice score : 46.21/100



Dice score : 29.73/100

Model is able to recognize the axillary area
 Model is able to keep most of true positive
 Model presents a lot of false positives
 Dice score is sensitive to small structures



Dice score : 83.22/100



Dice score : 47.96/100

# Automatic axillary lymph node segmentation in PET/CT volumes – Challenges

PET and CT shifting due to patient movement since axillary area is sensitive to breathing

Non rigid transformation can hardly correct this matching mistake since patient movement does not follow a continuous elastic deformation

In some advanced cancer cases lymph nodes become joint and are difficult to separate (even for medical experts) because of PET resolution limitations

In CT scans, joint lymph nodes appear to be one single lymph node having a huge area
