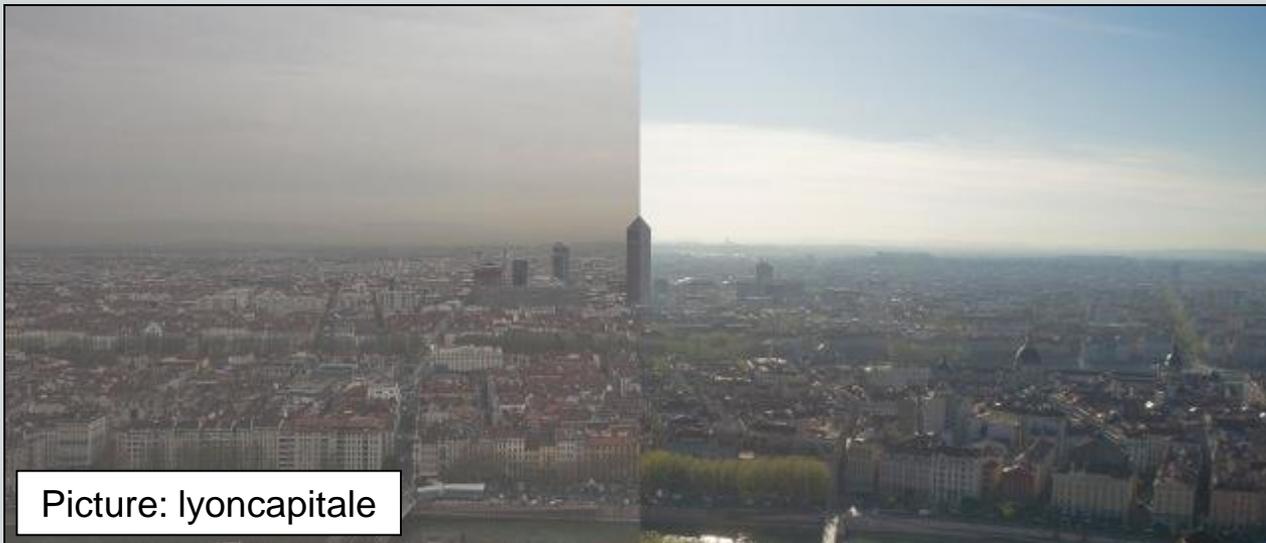

Introduction

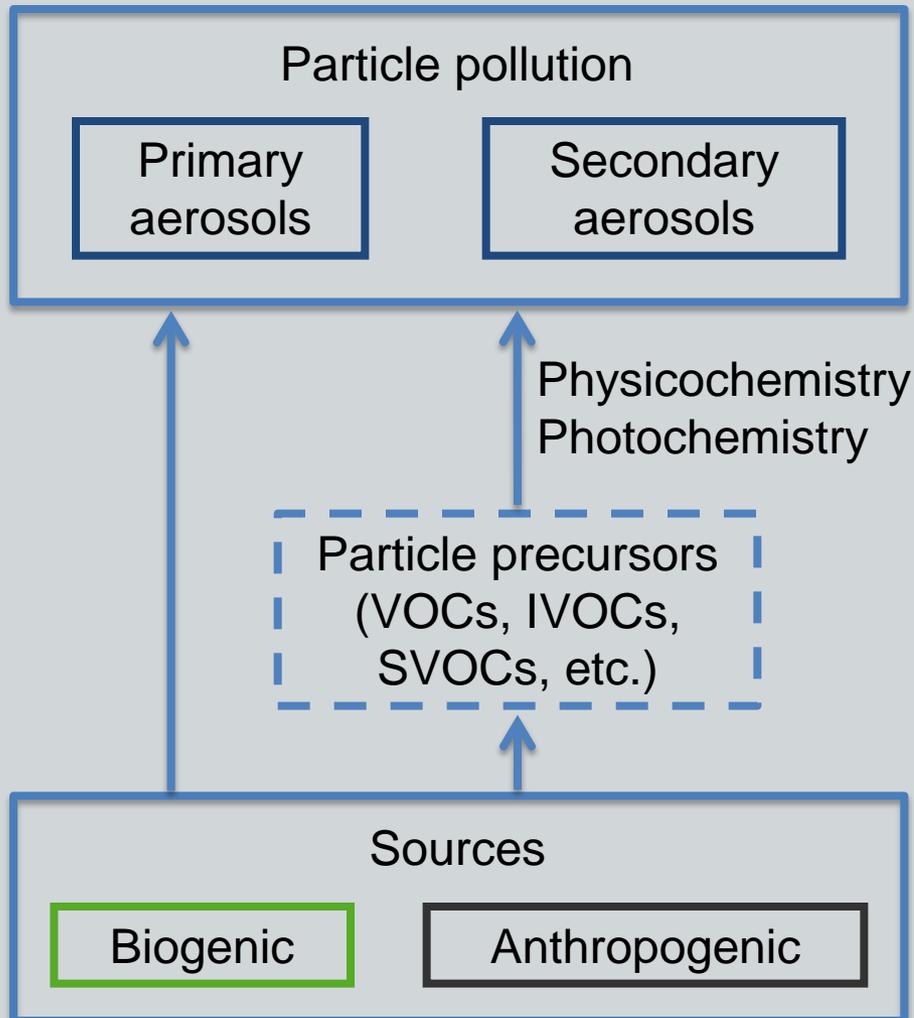
- 600 000 prematured deaths / year in Europe ⁽¹⁾
- US\$ 1.5 trillion / year in Europe ⁽¹⁾
- Road traffic contribution
 - 54% of NO_x ⁽²⁾
 - 46% of BC ⁽²⁾
 - 30% of PM_{2.5} in Lyon ⁽³⁾

Primary and secondary particles



- **Precursor emissions**
 - Sampling methodology (dilution & temperature)
 - Unspeciated organics
 - **Particle formation**
 - Complex processes
 - Lab conditions \neq atmospheric
- **Road traffic contribution to particle pollution not accurately described in air quality models**



Objectives

- **Investigate emissions of several pollutants in different sampling conditions**

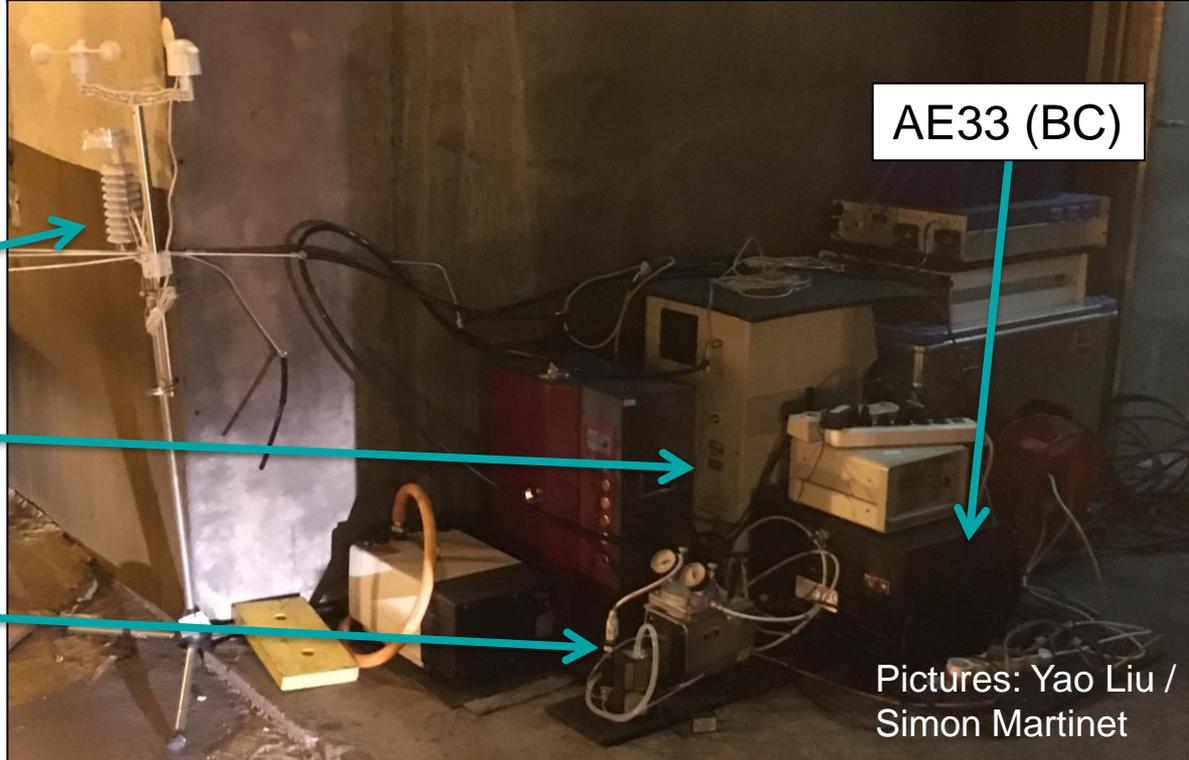
Emission factors (EFs) of:

- Particle number (PN)
- Black Carbon (BC)
- Intermediate-Volatility Organic Compounds (IVOCs)



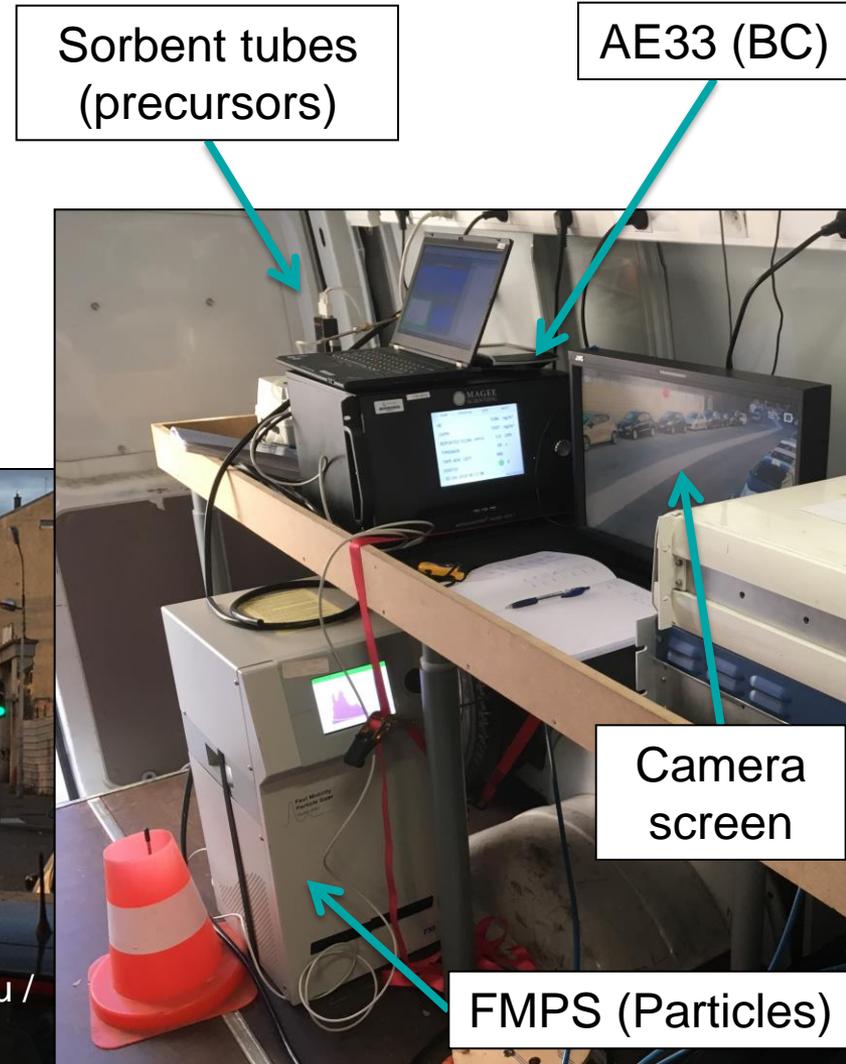
Tunnel experiment

- 70 km/h (43 miles/h)
- June
- 25° celsius (77° F)
- 7 am – 9 pm



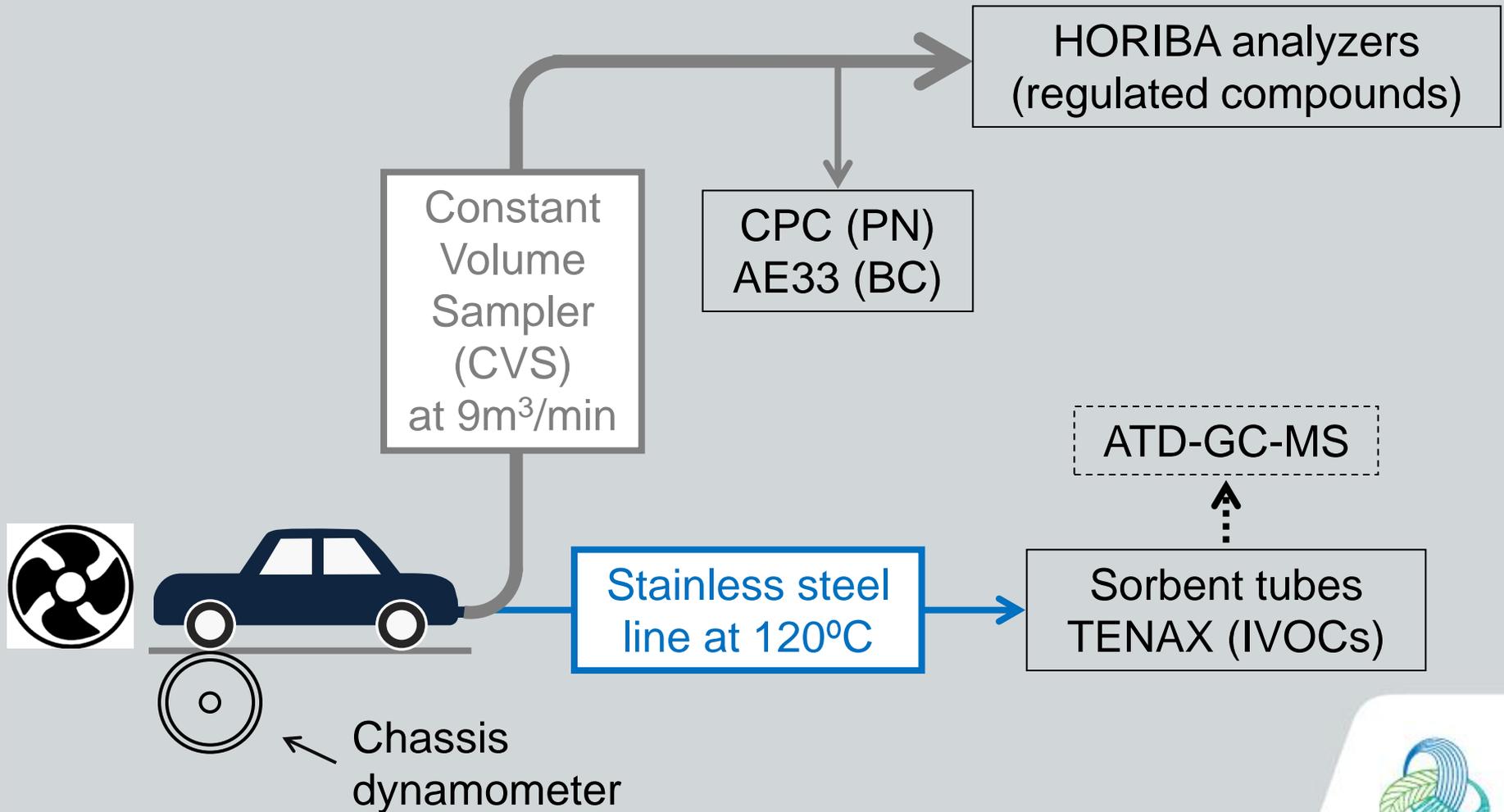
Near-road experiment

- 50 km/h (31 miles/h)
- October
- 15° celsius (59° F)
- 8 am – 10 am

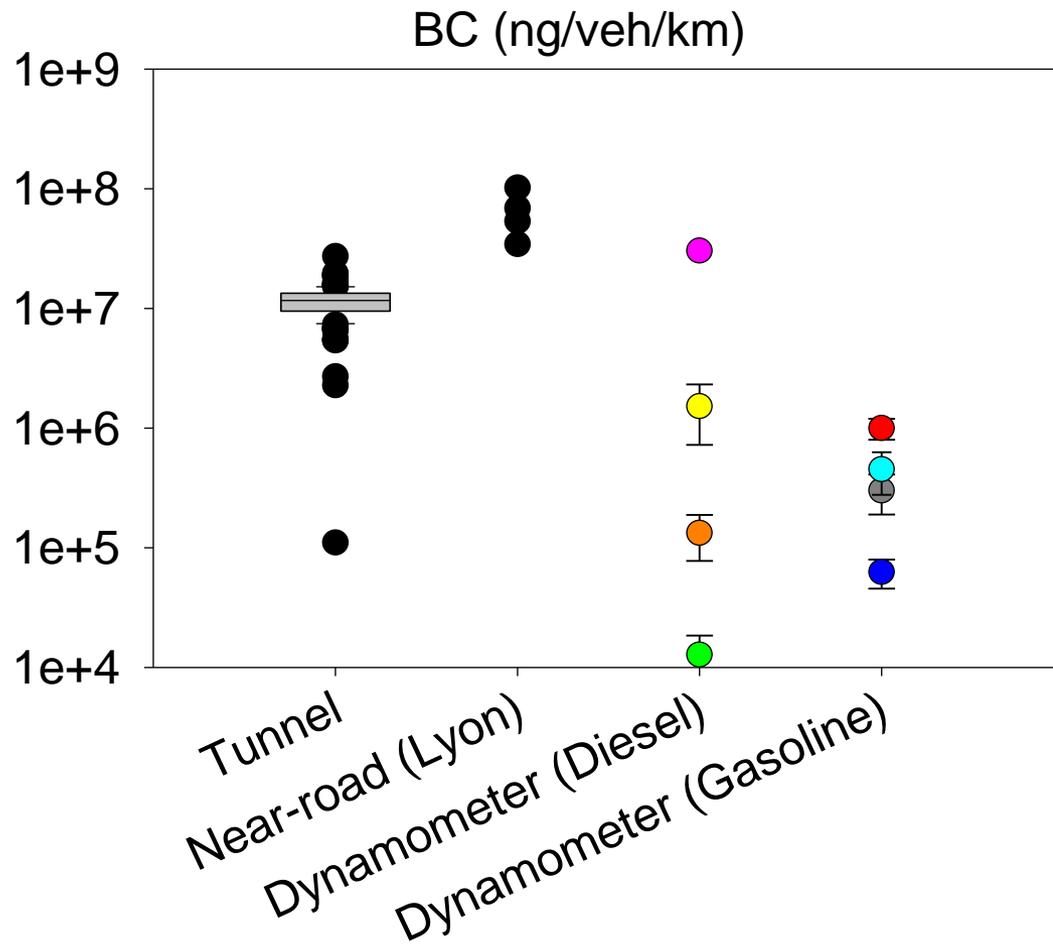

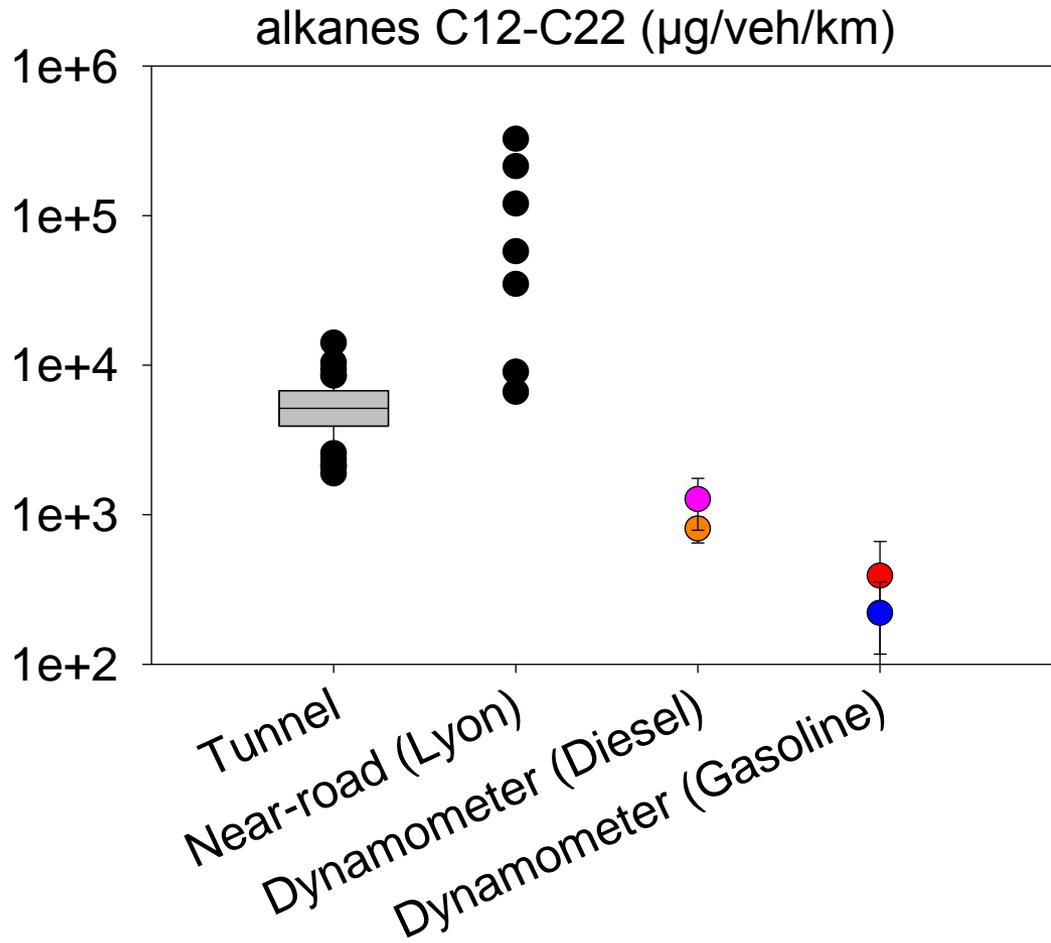

Results: IVOC (alkanes) EFs



- **Lyon: high variability**
- **$EF_{\text{in situ}} > EF_{\text{dynamo}}$**
- **Effect of sampling conditions and dilution:**

~ 8 (dynamometer)

> 1000 (ambient)

Conclusions and prospects

- **PN and BC emissions** ↘ for newer diesel vehicles but ↗ for newer gasoline vehicles
- **Major effects of dilution on IVOC measurements**
 - Low dilutions underestimate IVOC emissions
- **Investigate IVOC emissions in more conditions (driving, atmospheric, sampling methodology)**
- **IVOCs = important contribution to secondary particles: in situ studies to link with particle evolution**

Appendix 1: In situ measurements

Tunnel (Paris)

- 3 lanes – unidirection
- 70 km/h (43 miles/h)
- No heavy duty vehicles
- Avoid external pollution sources
- 7 days in June
- 25° celsius (77° F)
- 7am to 9pm + 1 night

Near-road (Lyon)

- 1 lane - bidirection
- 50 km/h (31 miles/h)
- All vehicles
- Representative conditions
- 3 days in October
- 15° celsius (59° F)
- 8am to 10am



Appendix 2: In situ EF determination

- **Traffic characterization**

- Recorded by camera
- Categorized by type, motorization, Euro norm

- **Background concentrations**

- Lyon: away from traffic
- Tunnel: closed 1 night

- **NO_x EFs from COPERT 5**

- $$EF_p = \Delta[P] \times \frac{EF_{NO_x}}{\Delta[NO_x]}$$

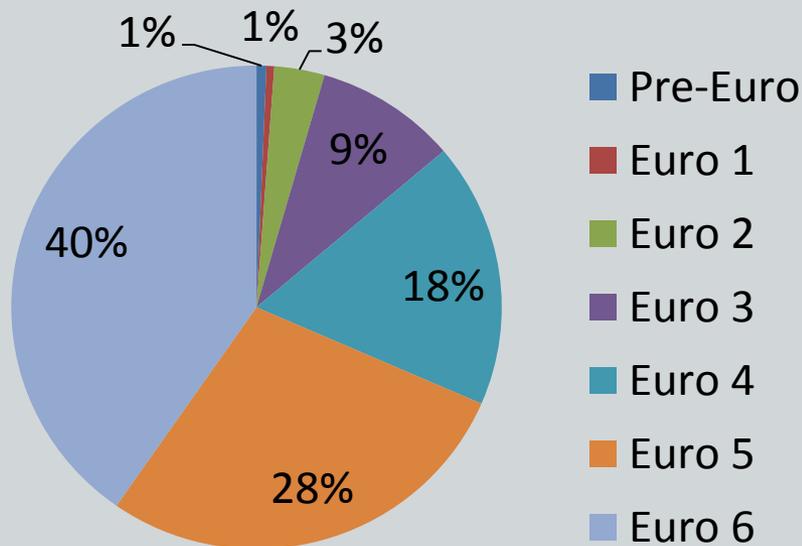

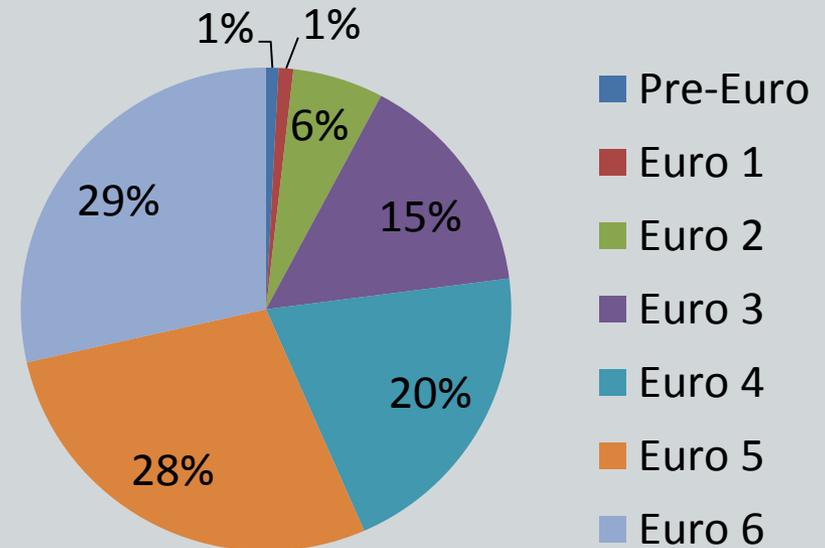
Appendix 3: In situ fleets

Tunnel



- **Passenger cars: 87%**
- **Heavy-duty: ~ 1%**
- **Diesel ~ 65%**
- **Gasoline ~ 30%**

Lyon



- **Passenger cars: 75%**
- **Heavy-duty: ~ 4%**
- **Diesel ~ 65%**
- **Gasoline ~ 30%**



Appendix 4: IVOC potential on particle formation

- IVOCs can play an important role in particle formation
 - Nucleation
 - Condensation
- Particle mass (PM) ↗ in dark prototype chamber

	Dilution ratios	PM ↗	
Diesel (Euro 3-5)	19-387	3-51%	→ PM ↗ for both diesel and gasoline
Gasoline (Euro 3-5)	19-97	4-27%	→ PM ↗ for all Euro norms
			→ PM ↗ up to 50%
