SBE $k$, surface binding energy from [3] based on the electronegativity concept. SBE, surface binding energy calculated in this work for different uniaxial tensile strains, as described in the text. The uncertainty is the sum of the standard deviation of the data set and the systematic error. It describes the spread of the SBE values.
