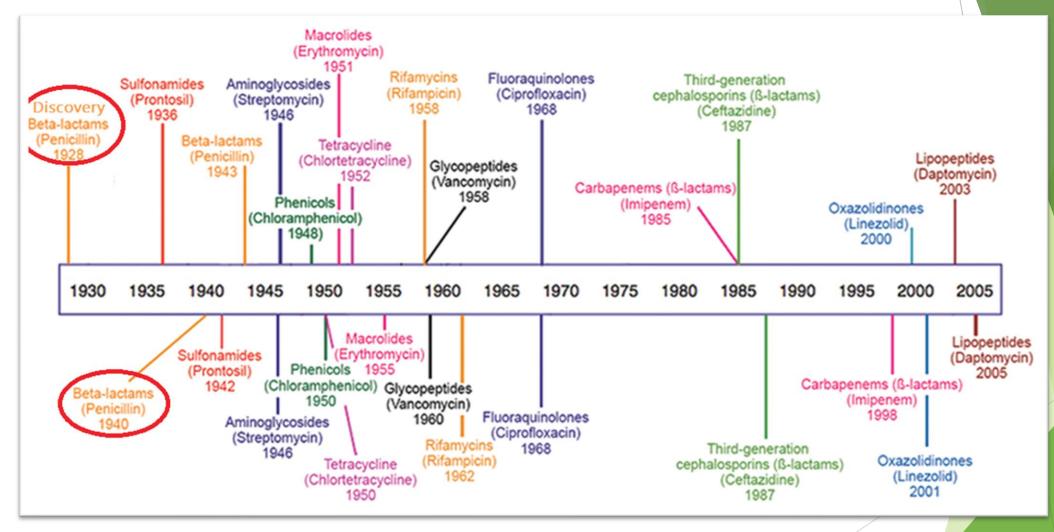

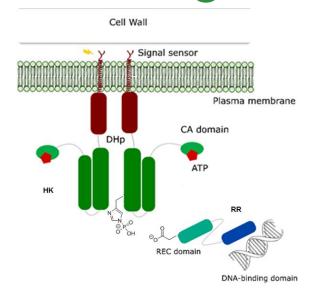


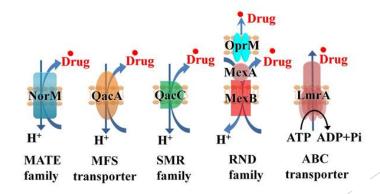
#### Two-component systems (TCS)

Responsible for efflux of antibiotics





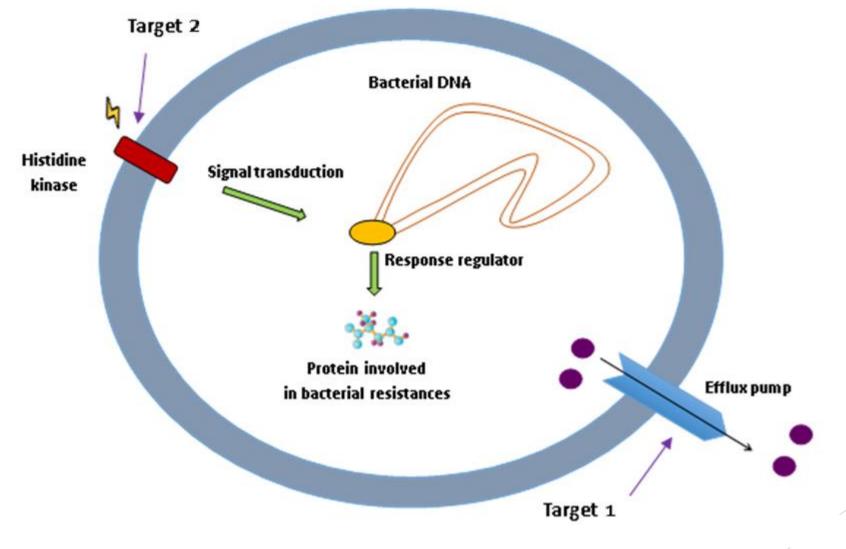

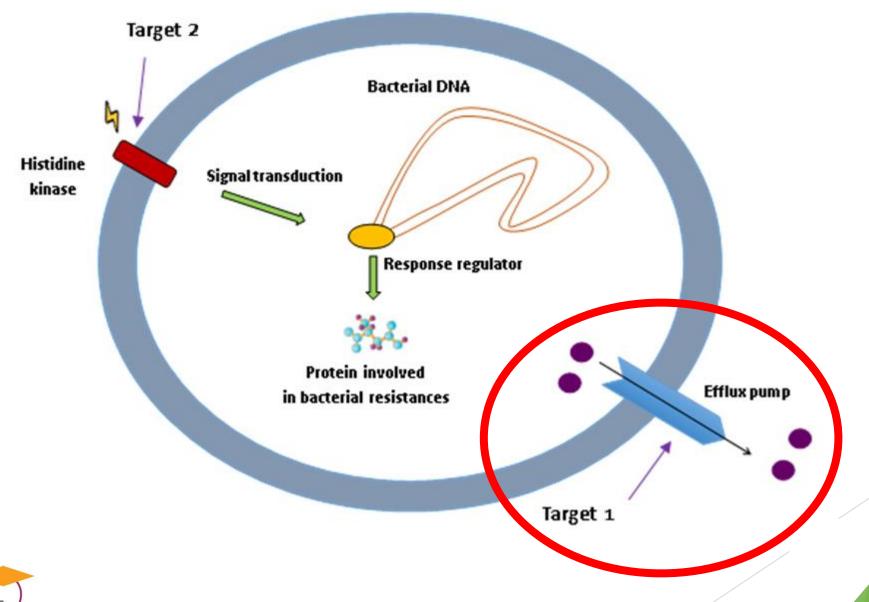

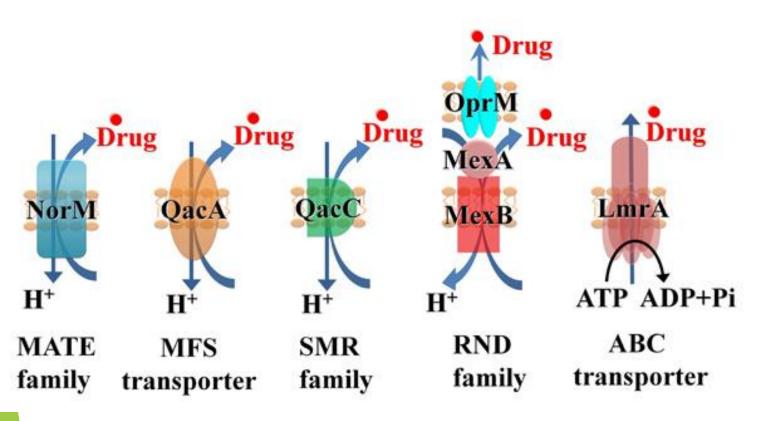




### Target 1: efflux pumps







- Responsible for the efflux of metals, antibiotics and drugs
- Resistance to Tetracyclines & Fluoroquinolones
- Inherent for bacteria functioning



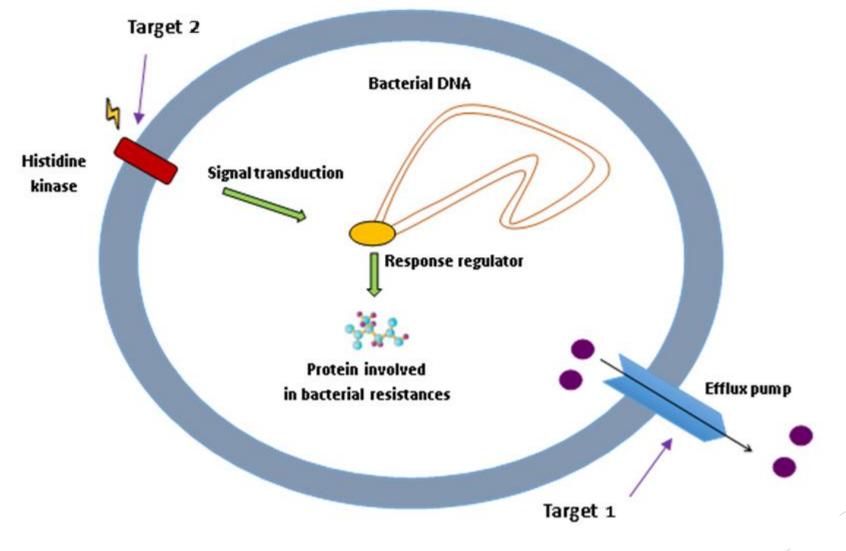

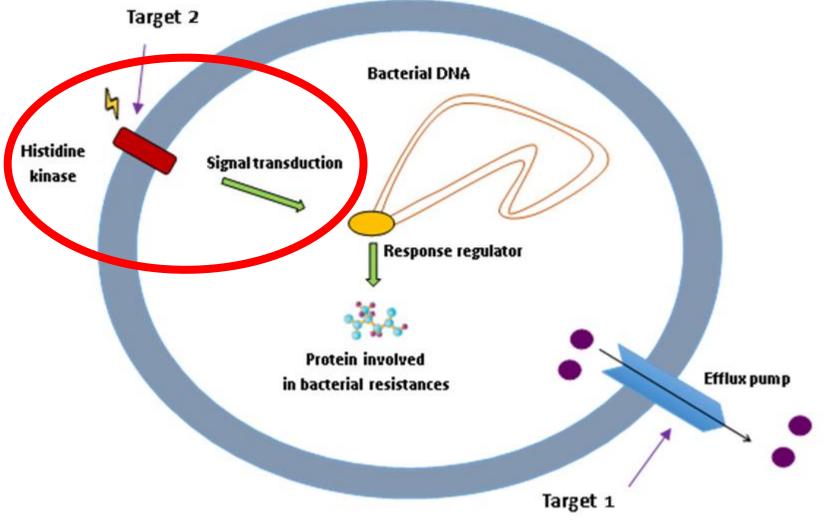

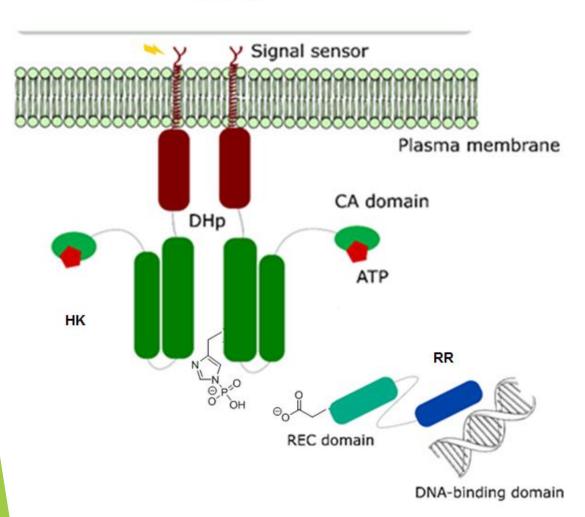


### Target 2: two-component system





#### Cell Wall



HK & RR

- Involved in virulence, resistance phenomena and adaptation
- Ubiquitous in bacteria/absent in mammals
- Signal ⇒ His phosphorylation ⇒ Phosphotransfer



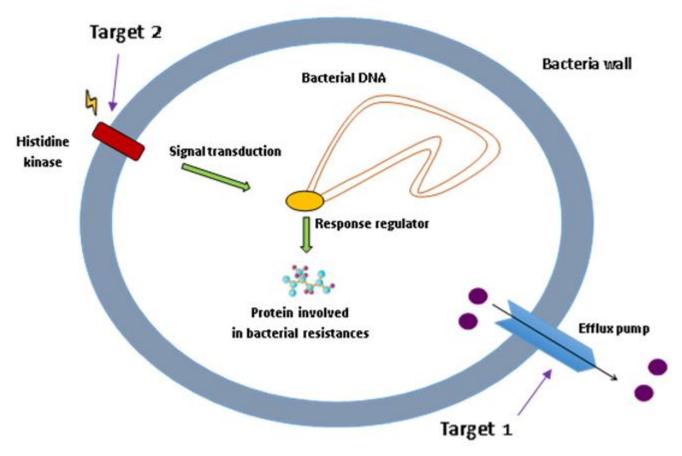
Transcription of genes involved in resistance phenomena.

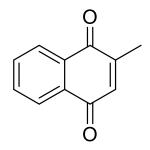

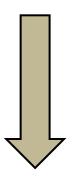


#### Menadione (vitamin K3) targets:

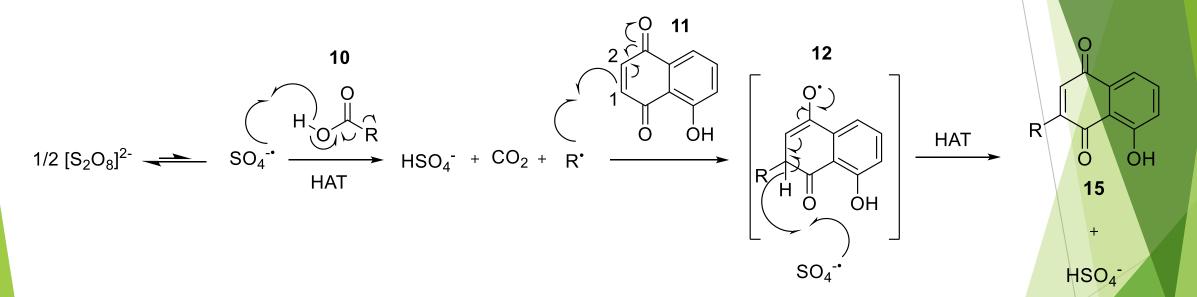

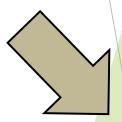




- ❖ 53 molecules were synthesized using this synthesis methodology
