Figure S1: Band gap scheme of ZnO and MoO₃ oxides and Schottky barrier with electron transfer from ZnO to MoO₃ conduction bands, intervalence charge transfer in MoO₃ (where oxo-bridges are represented per analogy with a forbidden gap) and power/film color obtained versus the intervalence charge transfer density (photo-redox reaction advancement).
