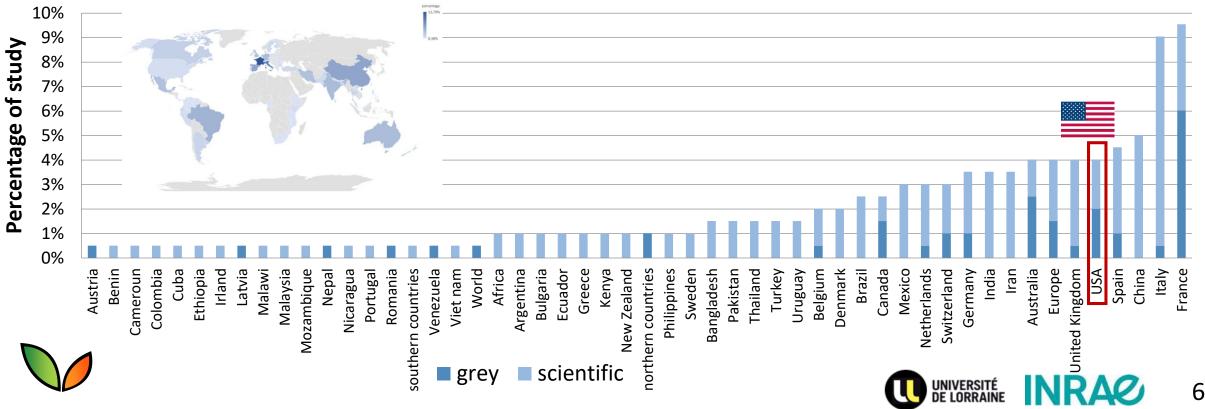






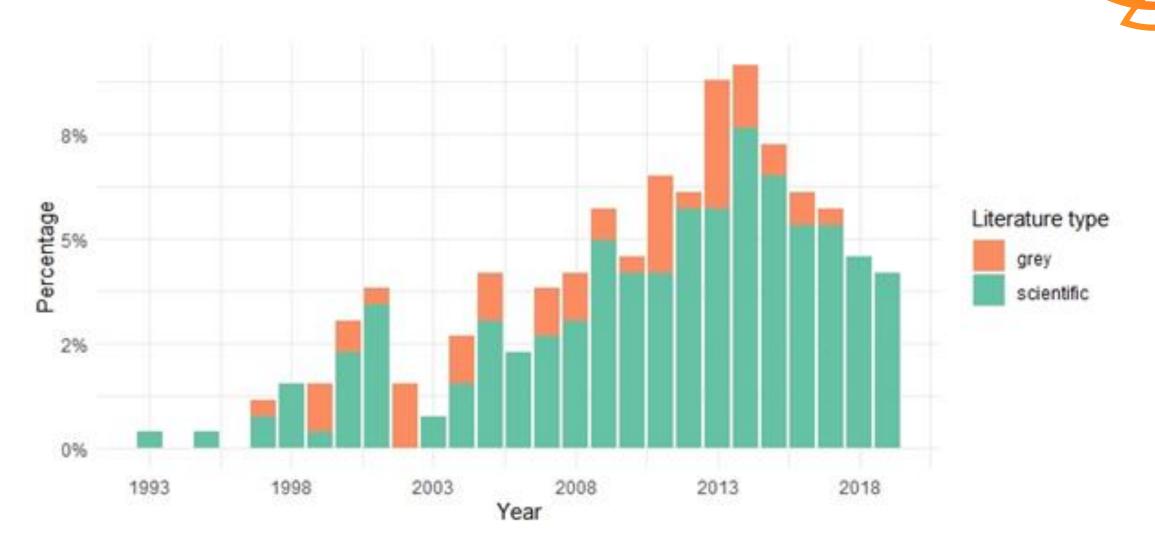

Publications by country (52)

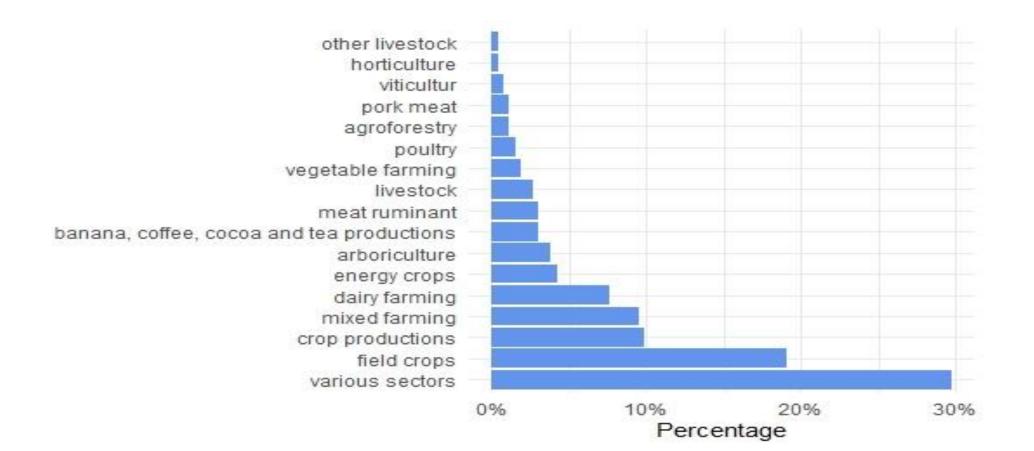

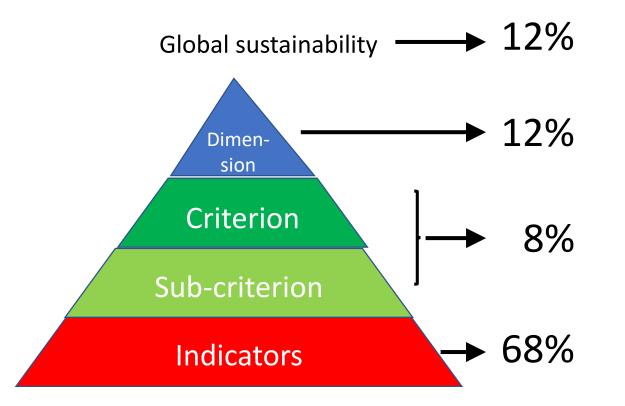

Level of aggregation (% methods)





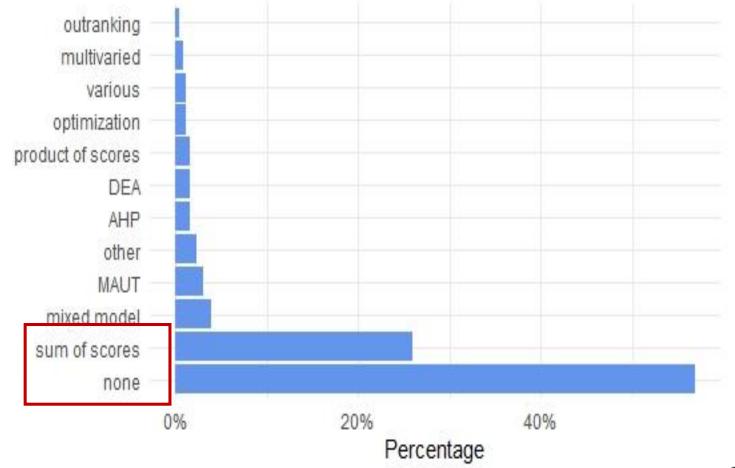

INSPIA method (Trivino-Tarradaset al. 2019)

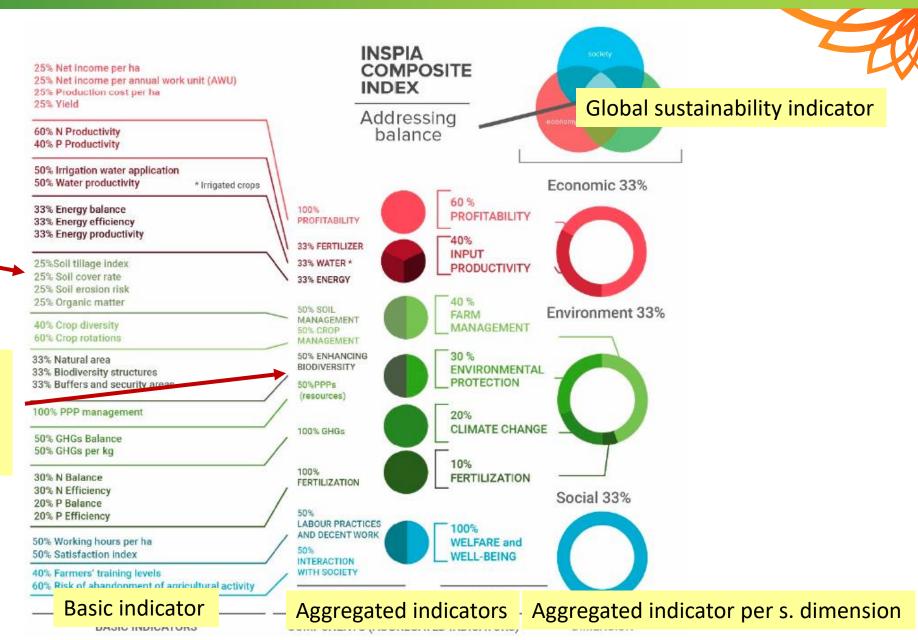
- Typical approach of sum of scores

Hierarchical structure

Aggregation:

- Normalization "min-max"
- Weighting (by experts panel)
- Weighted sum of scores
