at the Seine outlet

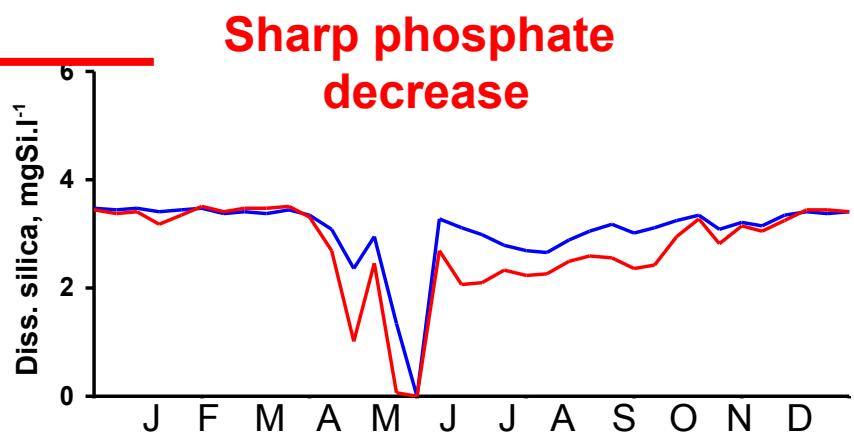
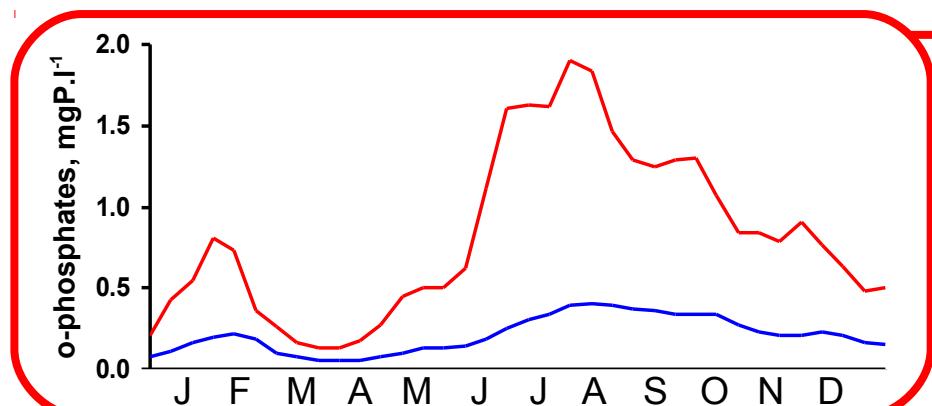

Decrease in N WWTP input

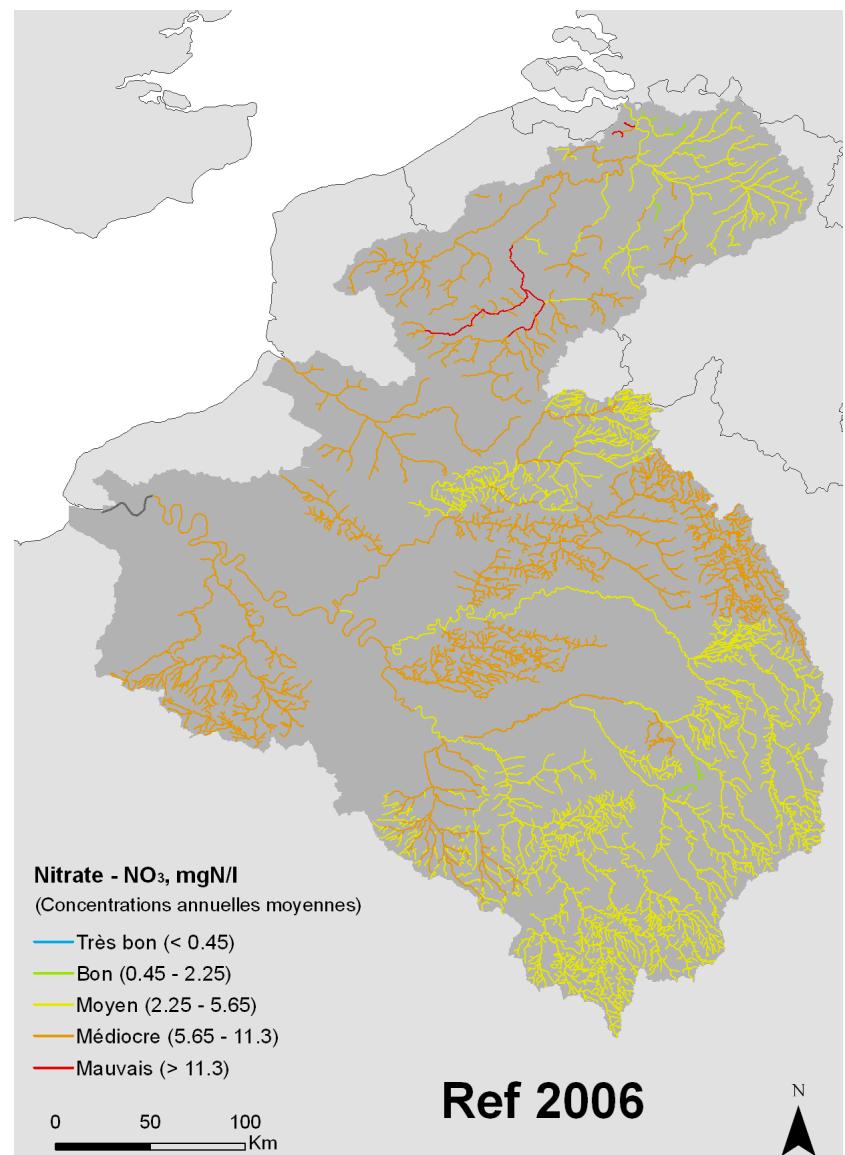
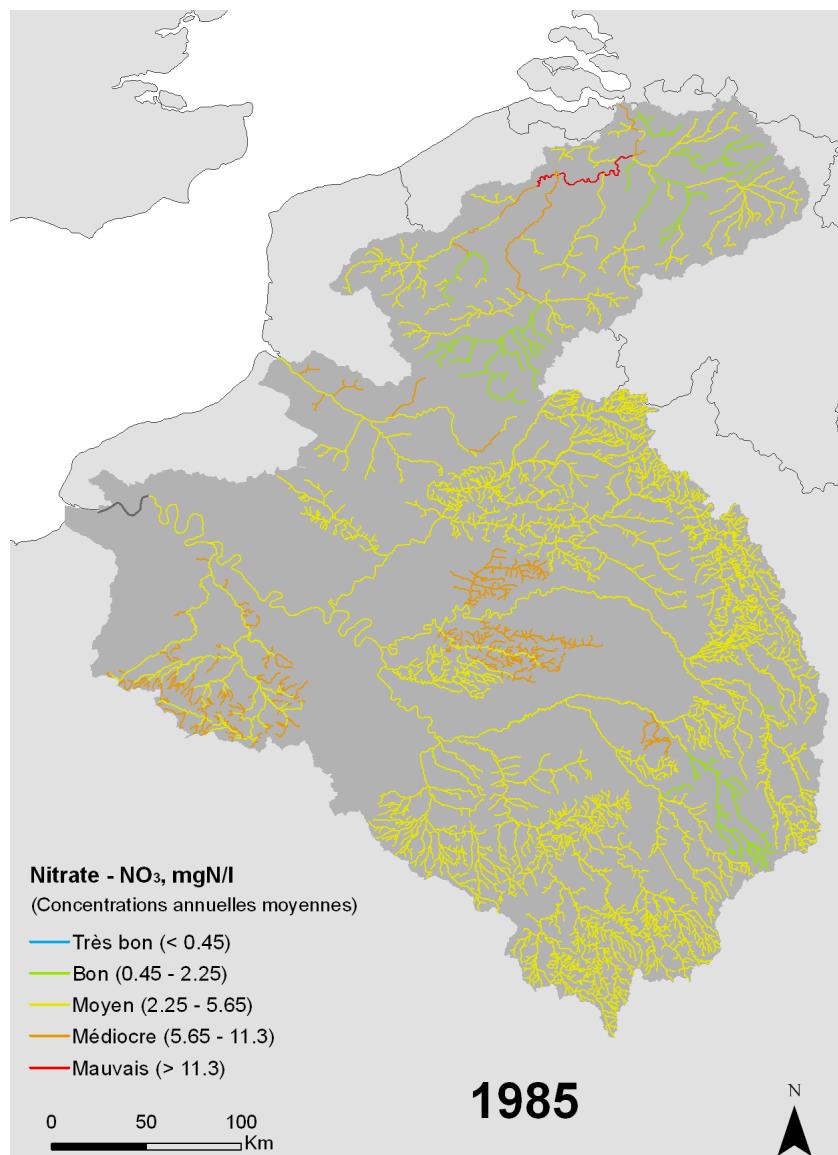

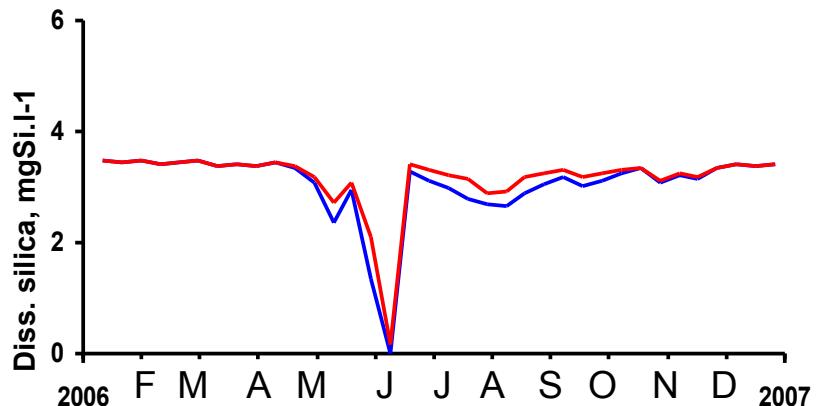
Phaeocystis,  $10^6$ c.l.<sup>-1</sup>



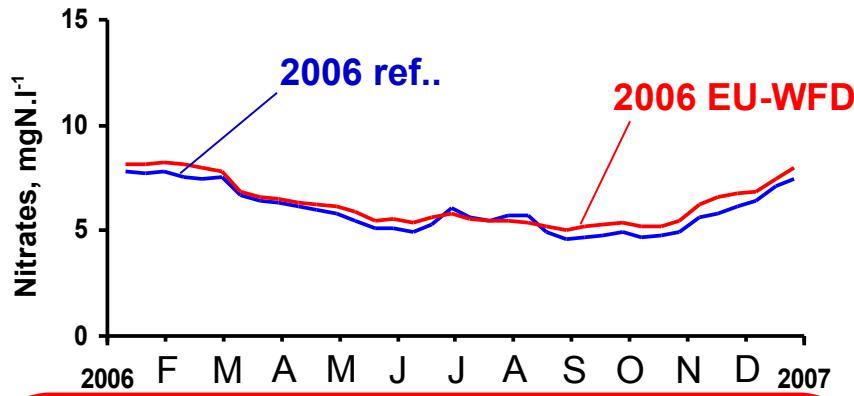

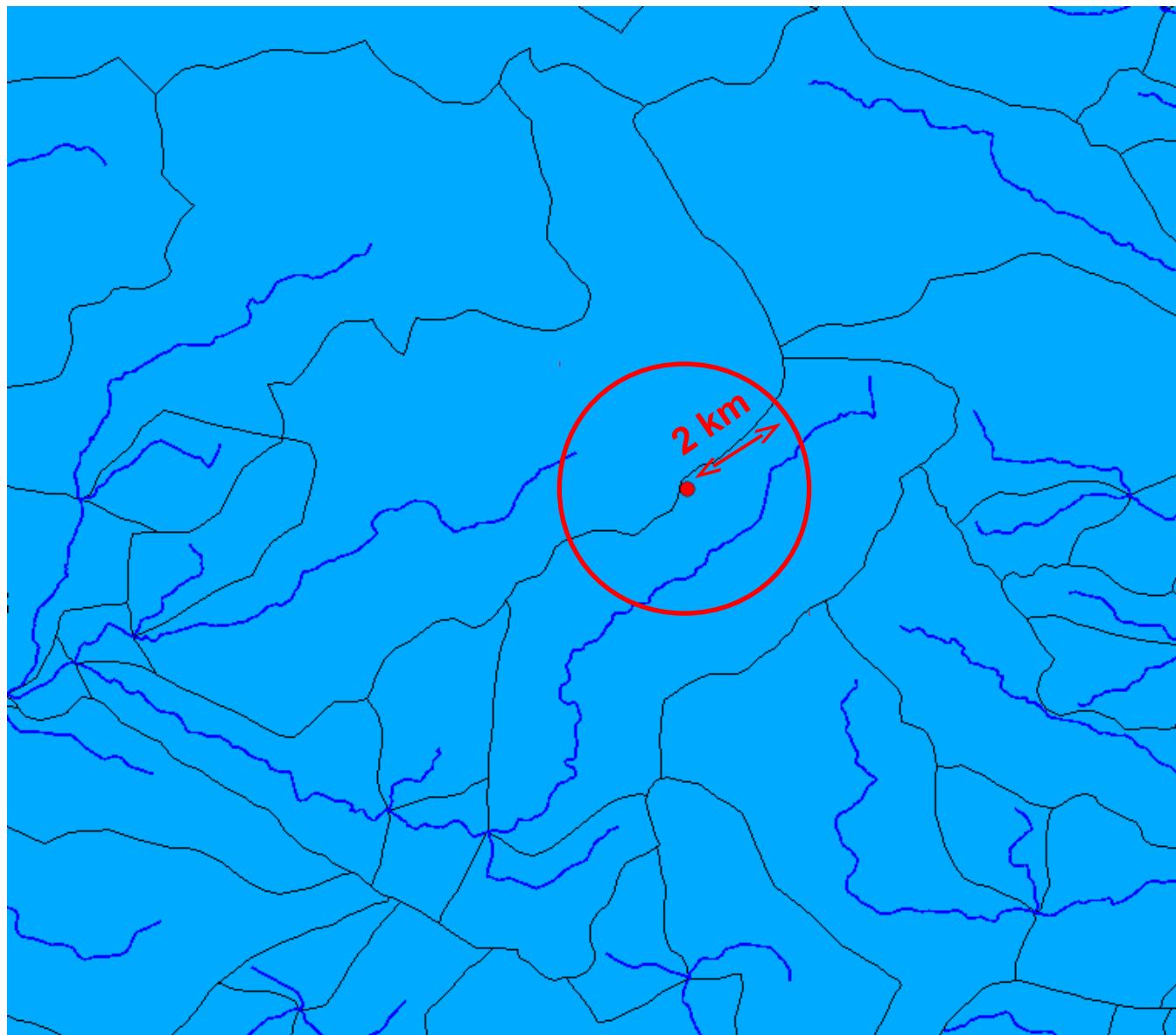
#### Effects of the EU-WFD implementation in terms of phosphate in the hydrological network



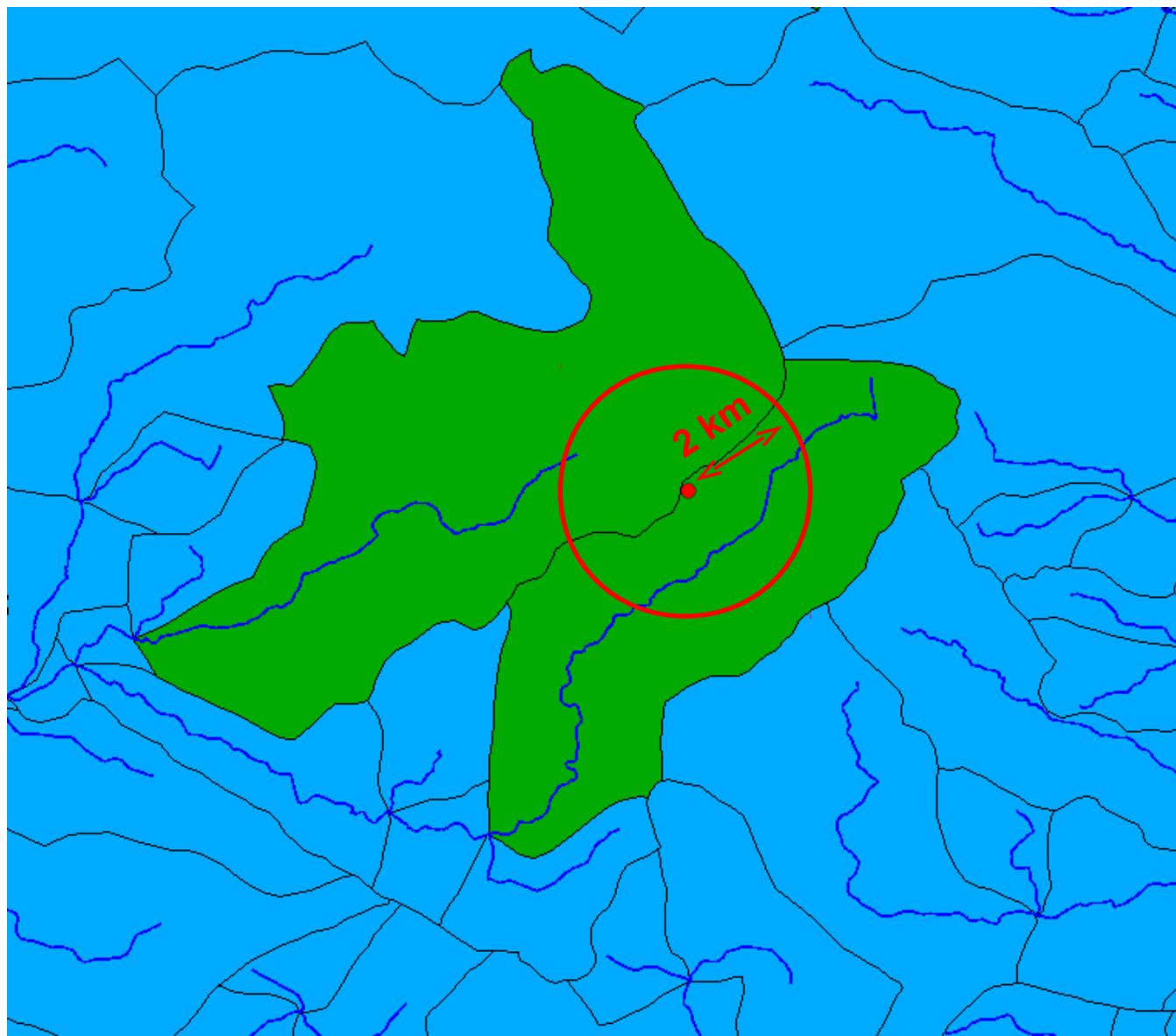

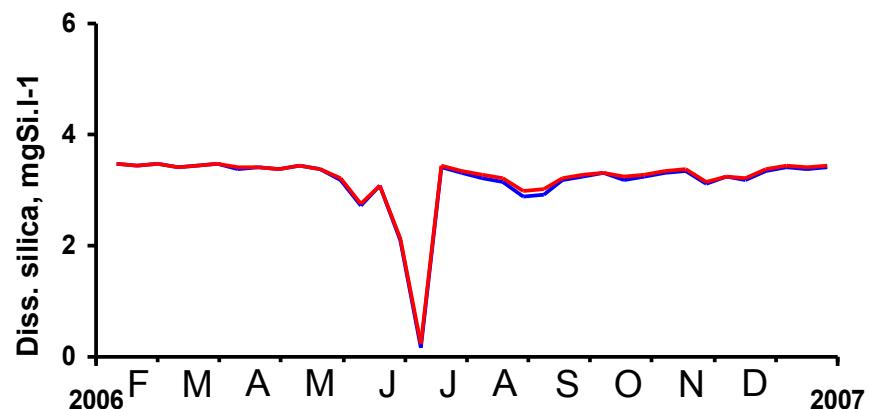
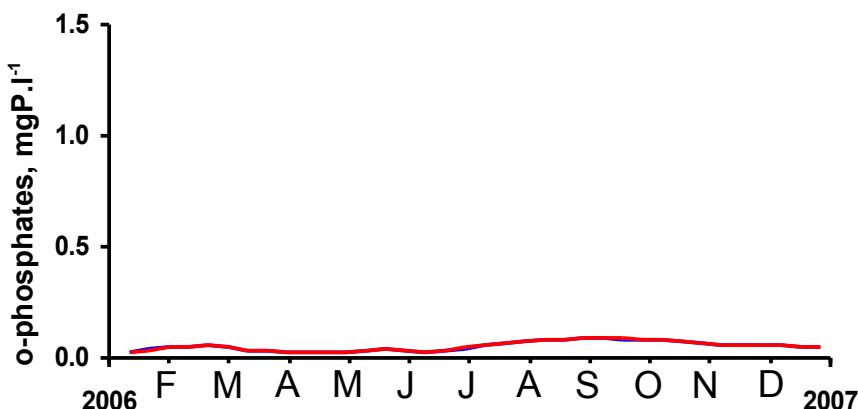
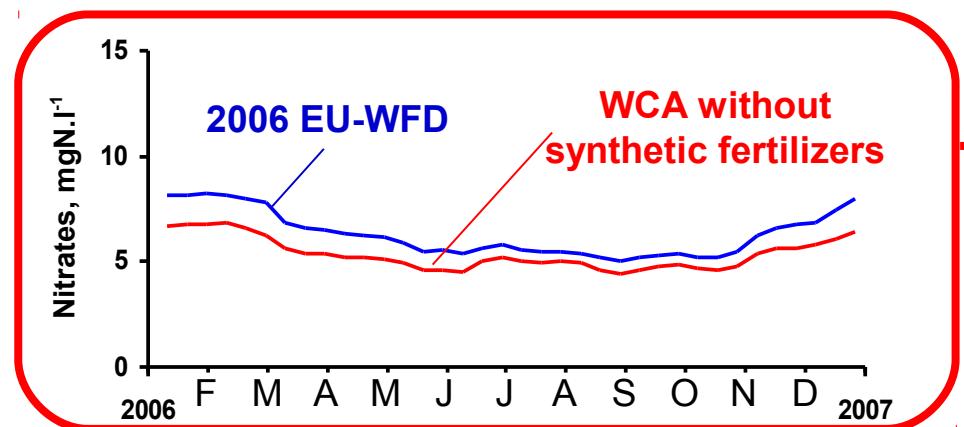
Well catchments areas:  $\approx 30\%$  of the watershed area

three basins at the Seine outlet**

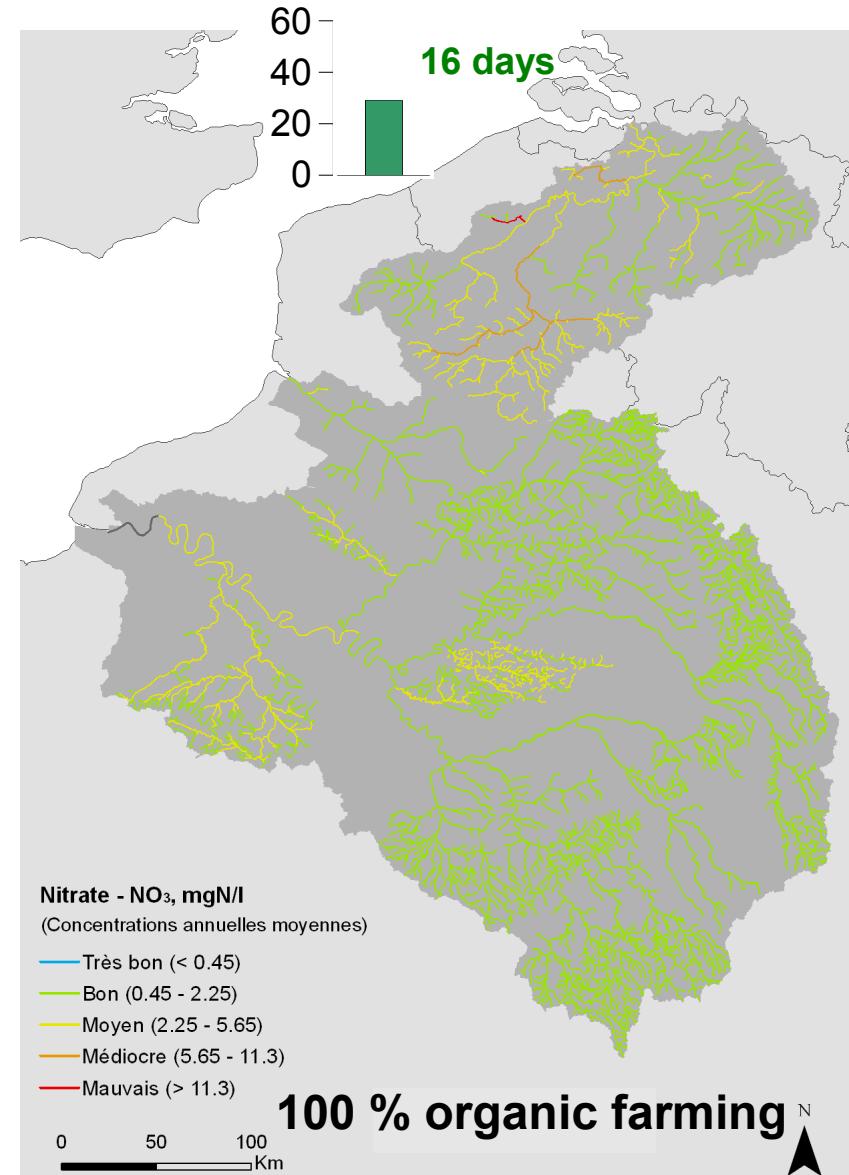
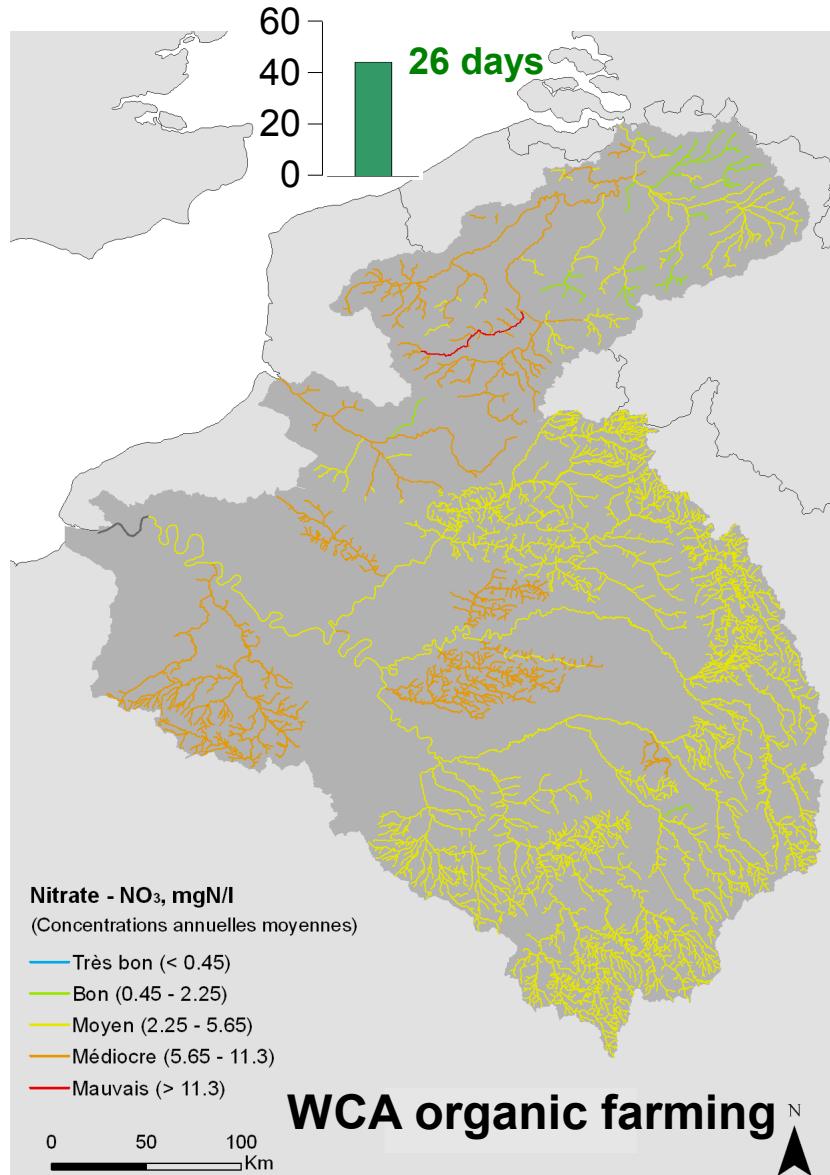

# Synthesis of the results of the various scenarios



Phaeocystis	→ nb days of bloom decreases
Nitrate	→ (hard) effort still needed
Phosphorus	→ problem (almost) solved
