Figure S1. Death rates by age and sex, Mexico, 1990

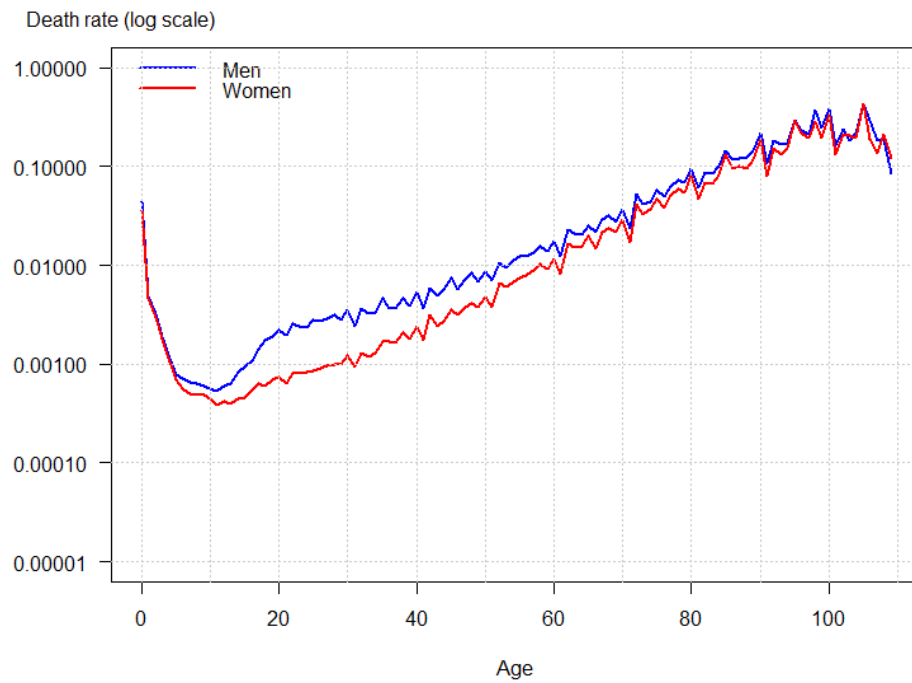


Figure S2. Death rates by age and sex, Mexico, 2010

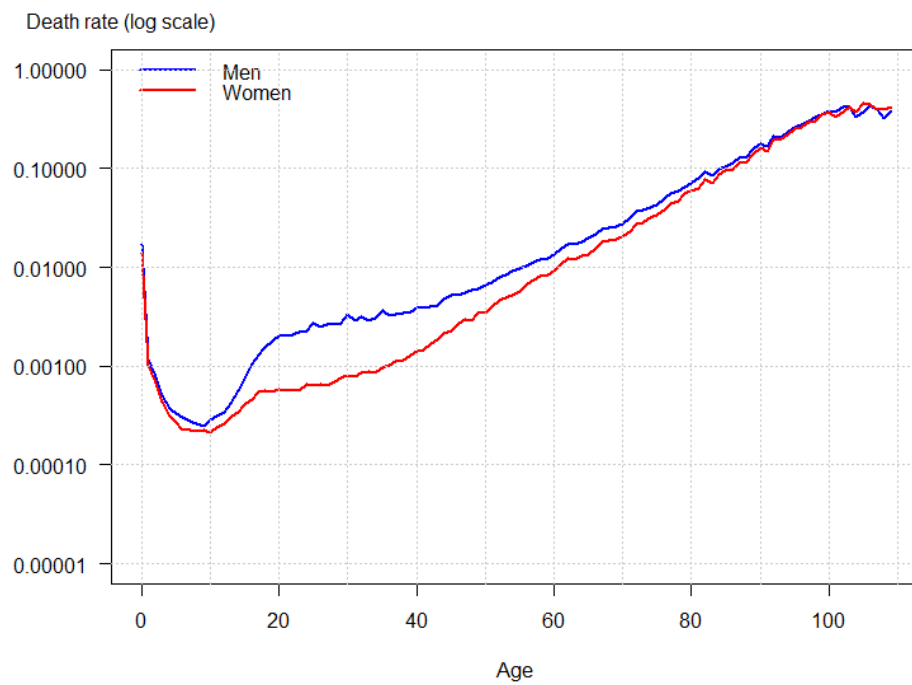
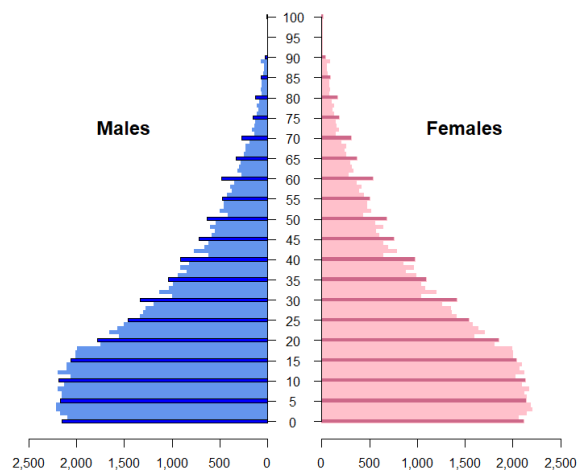
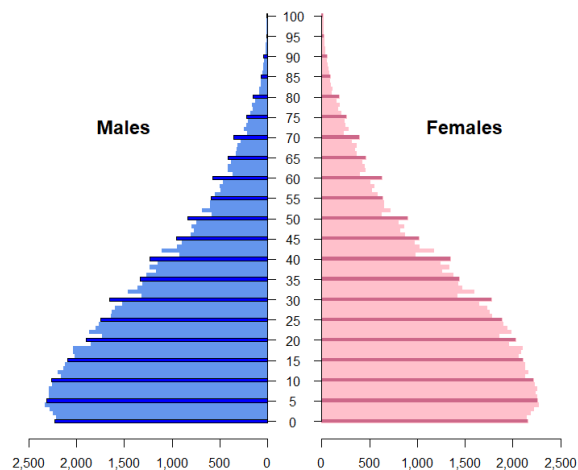


Figure S3. Age pyramids for census counts, Mexico, 1990, 2000 and 2010

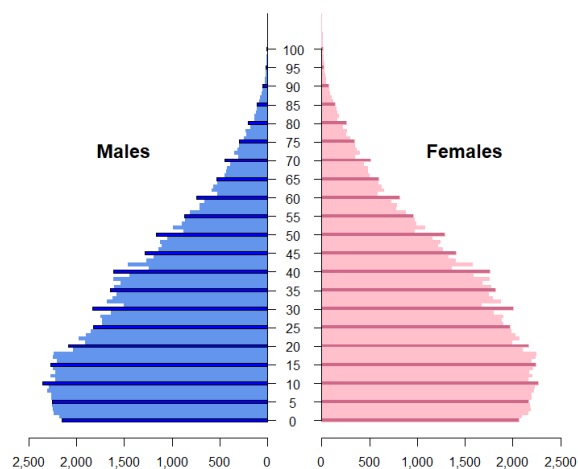
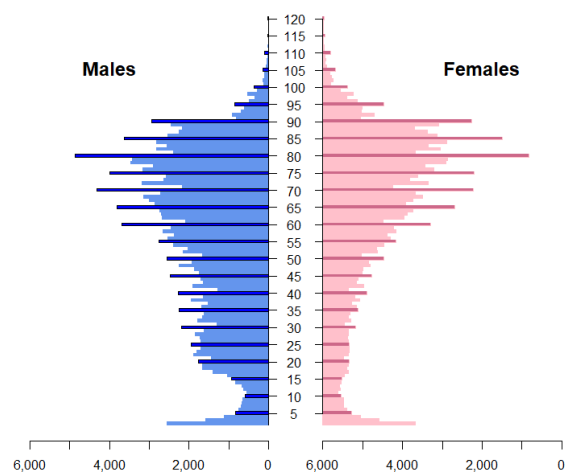
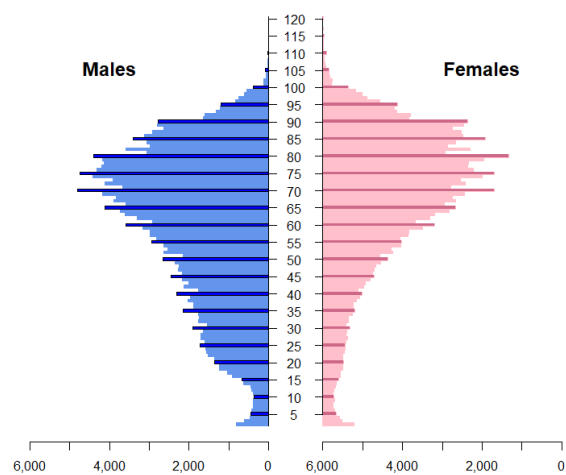


Figure S4. Age pyramid for death counts (ages 2+), Mexico, 1990, 2000 and 2010
