







The city's strategy is focusing on the «software», by negociating operations. An architectural heritage to be reinvested now from within: individual actors and promotors researching to reinvest the heritage by themselves...



Negociating with owners and artisan workers in order to reinvest vacuous groundfloor spaces in the historical market place. The theme is given by the city: art and history.



Negociating with a humanist promotor: a «child of Saint Flour» reinvests an old ecclesistic building in a social housing, association rooms.
