Previous study:

- Qualitative methodology (June 2015 – March 2016)
- Case study of UniLaSalle (Beauvais campus)
- 27 semi structured interviews:
 - Management team
 - Curricula management teams



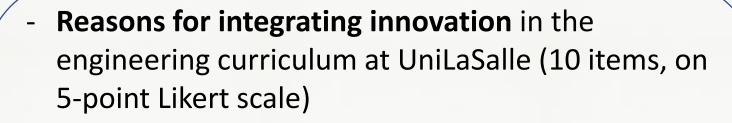


Current study:

- Quantitative study (November, 2017)
- Case study of UniLasalle (Beauvais campus)
- 291 engineering students (in master 1 level):
 - 144 from *Agriculture* speciality
 - 61 from Nutrition and Health sciences speciality
 - 86 from Geology speciality

Four theme-based survey

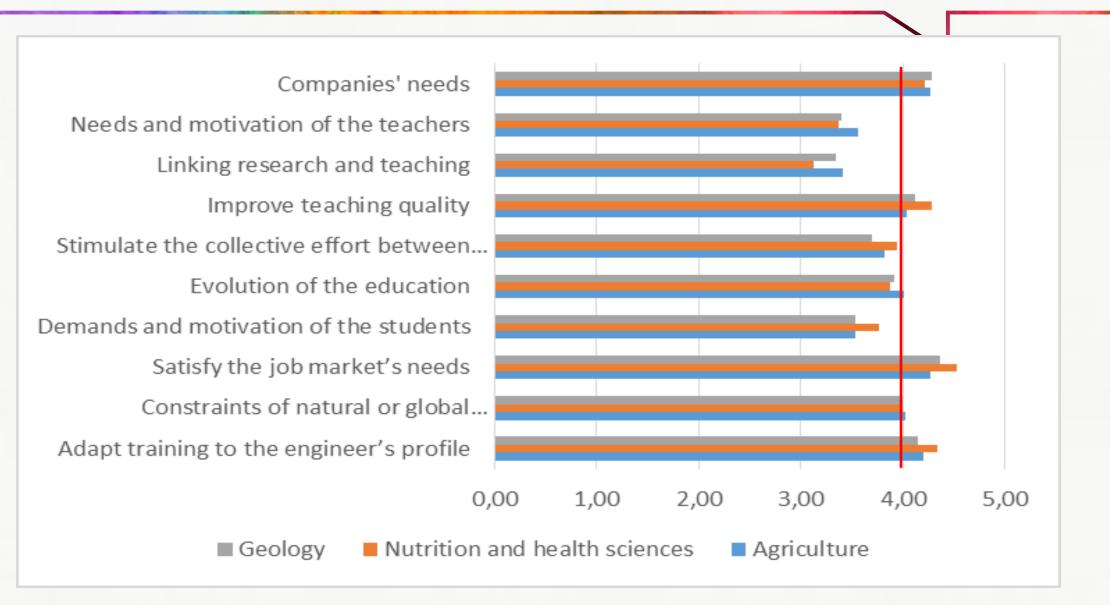
As a conclusion of the previous studies



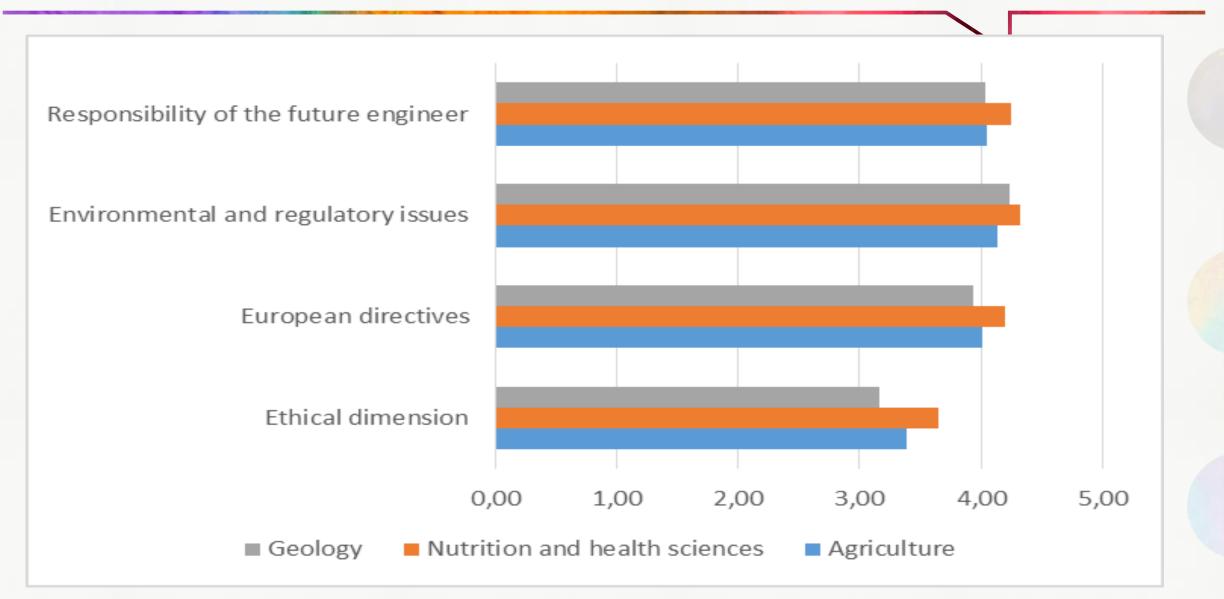
- **Reasons for integrating SD** in the engineering curriculum at UniLaSalle (4 items, on 5-point Likert scale)
- The perceived pillars of sustainable development (four pillars on 5-point Likert scale; indication of extent of integration in curriculum)
- The link between SD and innovation in engineering education (3 Items).



Students' opinion about the reasons for integrating innovation in the engineering curriculum at UniLaSalle.



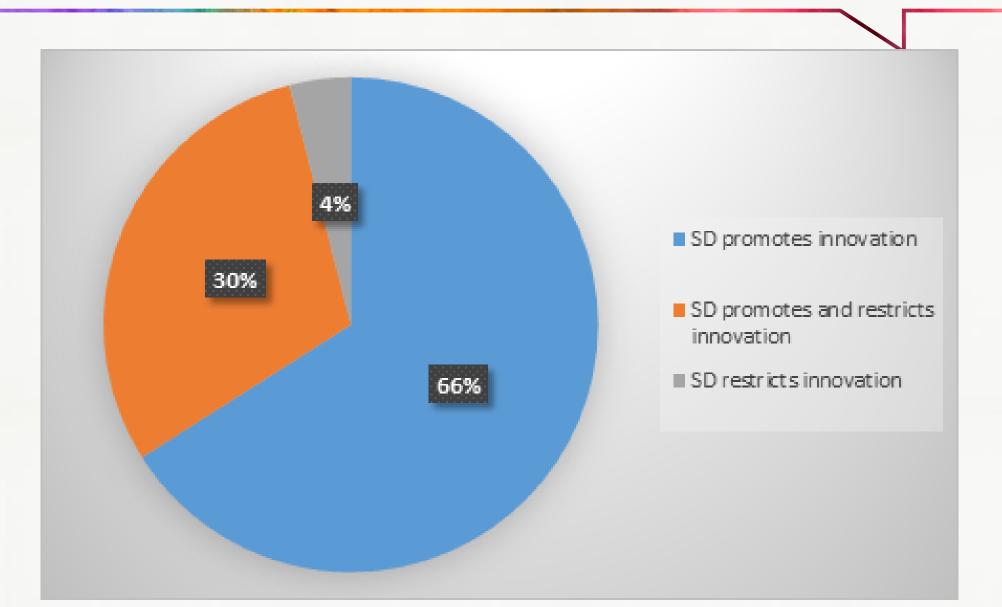
Students' opinion about the reasons for integrating SD in the engineering curriculum at UniLaSalle.

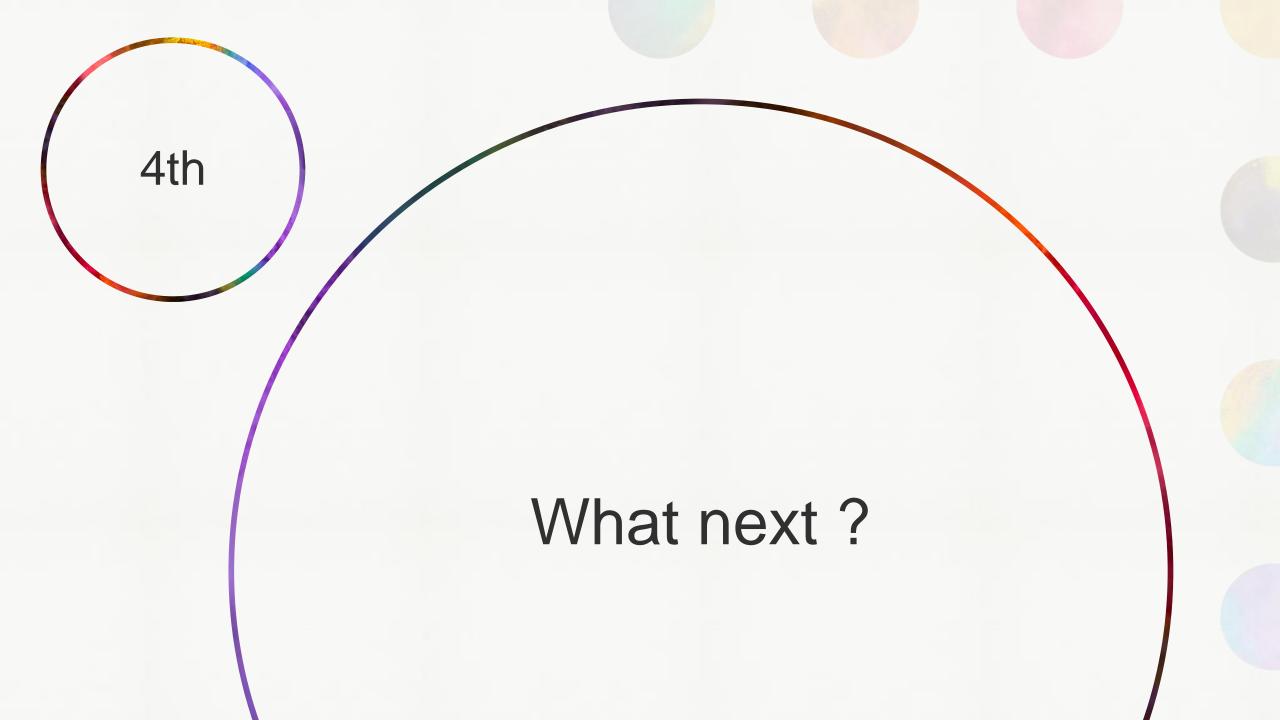
