


Figure SI1. a) SEM micrograph and inset TEM micrograph and b) Adsorption-desorption isotherms of VOPO₄·2H₂O.






Figure SI3. a) Current densities in function of scan rate and b) the b parameter in different electrolytes for VOPO₄·2H₂O in three different electrolytes.




