Introduction






Smartphones, **exergames**, and virtual reality games seem to offer an interesting perspective **for promoting Physical Activity (PA)** (Kinnafick & al., 2016 ; Muellmann & al., 2016 ; Fu & al., 2019). Evidence of exergames' effects on PA and Situational Interest (SI) (Sun, 2013 ; Gao & al., 2015 ; Pasco & al., 2016 ; Roure & al., 2019) Multiplayer condition is identified as crucial for PA (Peng & Crousse, 2013 ; Faric & al., 2019 ; Roure & al., 2021)







Participants

14 students

9 women, 5 men

Mage = 21.2

Situation



Data collection

Retrospective verbalisations

Semi-structured interview with visual recall Average duration = 24 min 31 sec



Data analyses

Thematic analysis (Braun & Clark, 2006 ; 2016) Analysis using Nvivo software

PA level (IPAQ, Craig et al., 2003) = Low (n=5) Moderate (n=5) High (n=4) Cooperation Competition With support Alone






Results

Collective enjoyment		10 MUs	« We were really having fun together »
Intention of collective exploration		23 MUs	« We could elaborate strategies »
Collective challenge	Challenge with	7 MUs	« You have to be together to achieve the same goal, that's what was good »
	Challenge against	24 MUs	« There is a competition where you try to win against each other. It's more motivating »
Support	Co presence	63 MUs	« The fact that she is really present next door, it's still better »
	Doing together	30 MUs	« I think it's sharing it with Romane, it's cool to do it together »
	Communicating together	33 MUs	« It motivated me because I had someone to talk to »
