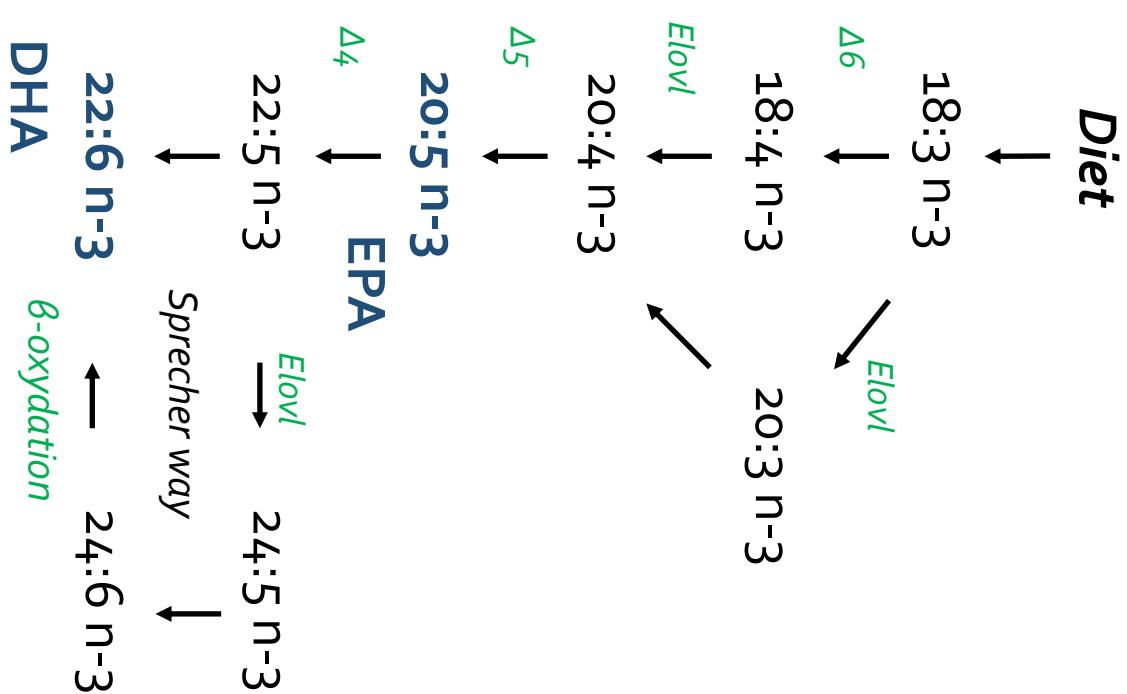


- Low / no ability to synthesize n-3 fatty acids for fish

-> No selective pressure on highly abundant n-3 systems

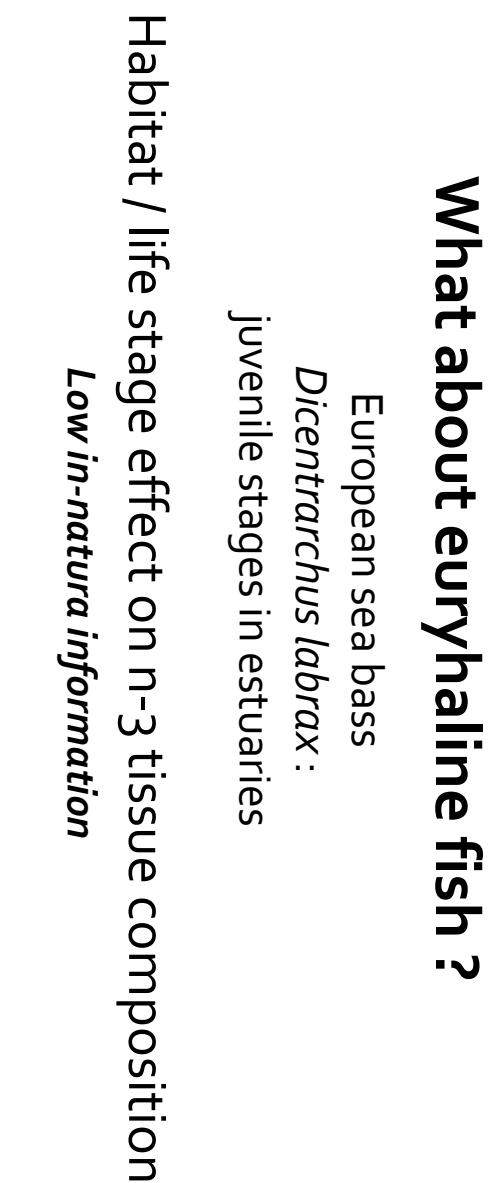

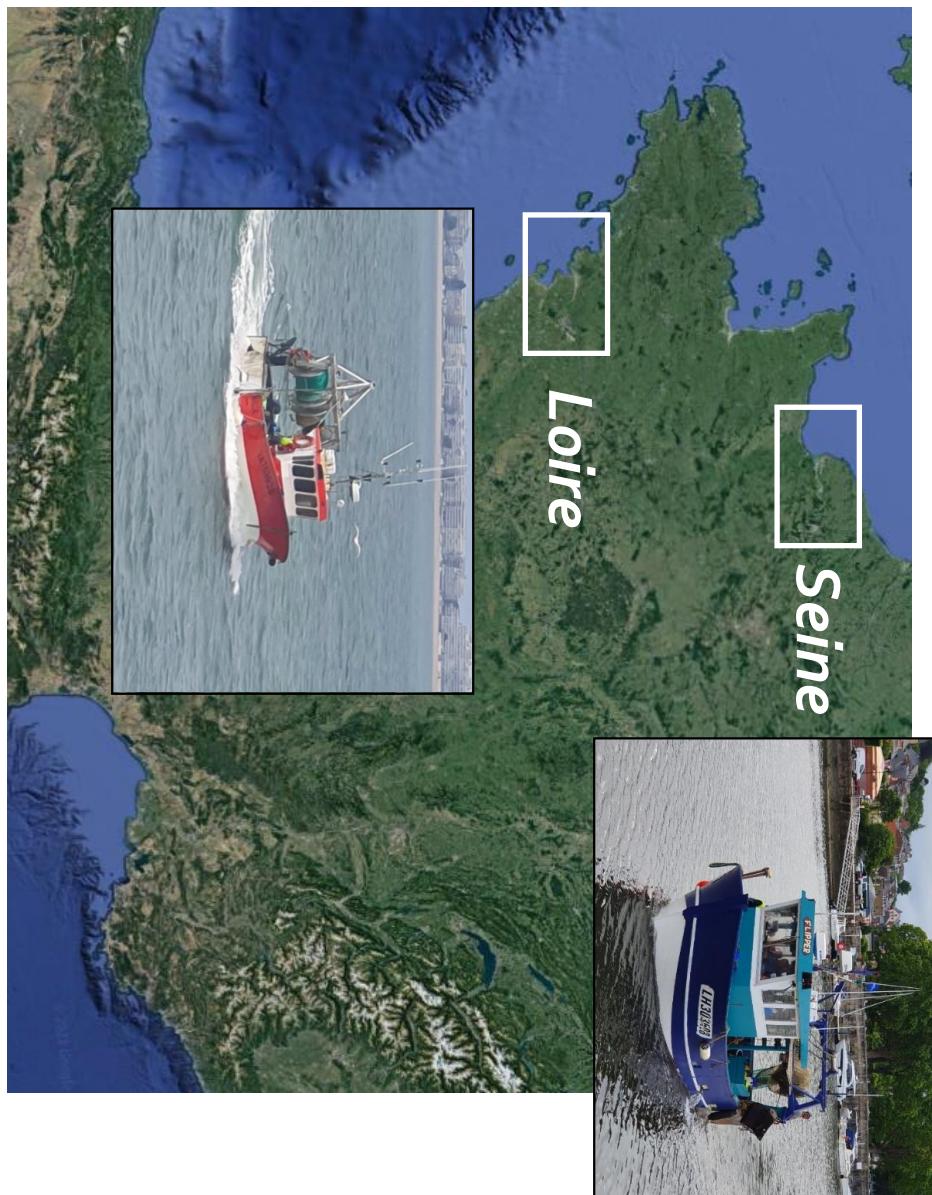

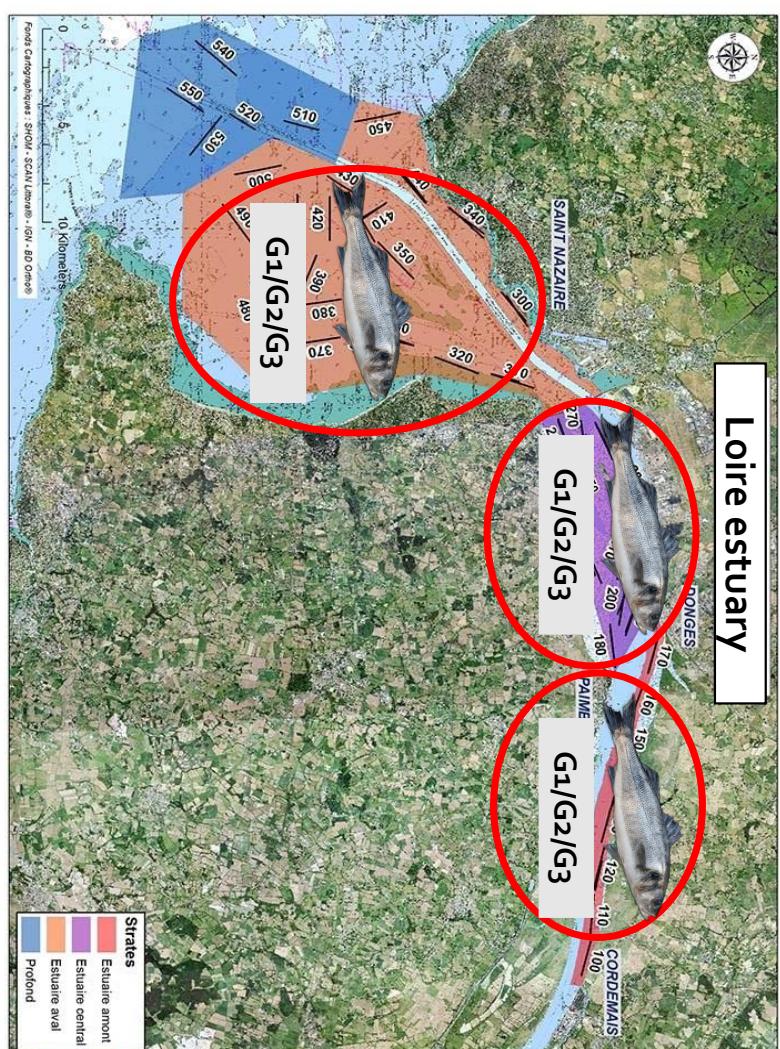


Percentage of main FA in membrane lipids (PL)
