to the definition of encyclopedic
commentaries

Dating evidence: before 500 AD

又問：「《東宮舊事》『六色屬纒』，是何等物？當作何音？」答曰：「案：《說文》云：『蓐，牛藻也，讀若威。』《音隱》：『塢瑰反。』即陸機所謂『聚藻，葉如蓬』者也。」

The person asked again, “*The Matters of the Eastern Palace in Recent Times* mentions a six-colored *ji* 纒. What is it? How should the [last] character 纒 be pronounced?” I replied, “According to *Shuowen*, 蓐 (*Potamogeton crispus*) is cow’s-pondweed. It is pronounced as *wei*.’ *The Subtleties of Sounds* gives the pronunciation of the character as a combination of *wu* [MC ‘uX] and *gui* [MC kwoj]. This is the plant that Lu Ji has described as ‘a water plant growing in clusters whose leaves are like those of mugwort.’ ”

Entry « 于以采藻 » (on 詩經 15)

藻，水草也。生水底。有二種。其一種，葉如雞蘇，莖大如箸，長四五尺。其一種，莖大如釵股，葉如蓬蒿。謂之聚藻。扶風人謂之藻聚。為發聲也。此二藻皆可鬻熟，按去腥氣。米麵糝蒸為茹，嘉美。揚州人饑荒可以當穀食饑也。饑時蒸而食之。

Zǎo is an aquatic plant. It grows on the bottom of rivers. There are two types (of zǎo). One, with leaves that resemble those of *stachys baicalensis*, with stems as thick as chopsticks, it is four to five feet long. The other one, with stems as thin as hairpins and leaves that resemble those of *chrysanthemum coronarium*. It is called *ceratophyllum demersum* (assembled zǎo). The people of Fufeng call it grouped zǎo. It can be used to produce music. Both kinds of zǎo can be boiled to make zhou, but it exudes a stinky smell. It can be eaten by steaming it along with rice flour, and it is delicious. In case of food shortage, the people of Yangzhou would use it as cereal to ease hunger. When hungry, they would steam it and eat it.

詩經 15: first stanza

於以采蘋？南澗之濱。

於以采藻？於彼行潦。

Where do I pluck the marsilia?

At the southern brooklet's bank!

Where do I pluck the ceratophyllum?

At that puddle or that marsh.

藻，陸機云：「藻，水草也，生水底。有二種：其一種葉如雞蘇，莖大如箸，長四五尺。其一種莖大如釵股，葉如蓬蒿，謂之聚藻。」然則藻聚生，故謂之聚藻也。

As regards Zǎo, Lu Ji says: "Zǎo is an aquatic plant. It grows on the bottom of rivers. There are two types (of zǎo). One, with leaves that resemble those of *stachys baicalensis*, with stems as thick as chopsticks, it is four to five feet long. The other one, with stems as thin as hairpins, and leaves that resemble those of *chrysanthemum coronarium*. It is called *Ceratophyllum demersum* (assembled zao)". Thus, zǎo grow in groups, that is why they are called 'assembled zǎo'.


習習谷風，以陰以雨。

La préface de Mao :

《谷風》刺夫婦失道也。衛人化其上，淫於新昏而棄其舊室。夫婦離絕，國俗傷敗焉。

Les explications de Zheng Xuan :

新昏者，新所與為昏礼。

Les développements de Kong Yingda :

作《谷風》詩者，刺夫婦失其相與之道。以至於離絕言衛人由化效其上，故淫於新昏而棄其舊室。是夫婦離絕，致令國俗傷敗焉。此指刺夫接其婦不以礼。是夫婦失道，非謂夫婦並刺也。其婦既與夫絕，乃陳夫之棄已見遇，非道淫於新昏之事。六章皆是。

Argumentation de Kong Yingda s'appuyant largement sur Mao et Zheng Xuan :

行道遲遲中心有違遲遲舒行貌。『違』離也。《箋》云：徘徊也。行於道路之人，至將於別，尚舒行，其心徘徊。然喻君子於已，不能如也。不遠伊邇薄送我畿『畿』門內也。《箋》云：『邇』近也。言君子與已訣別。不能遠，維近耳。送我裁於門內，無恩之甚。誰謂荼苦其甘如薺『荼』苦菜也。《箋》云：荼誠苦矣，而君子於已之苦毒又甚於荼。比方之荼，則甘如薺。宴爾新昏如兄如弟『宴』安也。

[疏] ○《正義》曰：毛以為，婦人既已被棄，追怨見薄。言相與行於道路之人，至將離別，尚遲遲舒行，心中猶有乖離之志，不忍即別。況已與君子猶是夫婦。今棄已訣別之時，送我不遠維近耳。薄送我於門內而已。是恩意不如行路之人也。又說遇已之苦。言人誰謂荼苦乎？以君子遇我之苦毒比之，荼即其甘如薺。君子苦已，猶得新昏。故又言安愛汝之新昏？其恩如兄弟也。以夫婦坐圖，可否有兄弟之道？故以兄弟言之。○鄭唯有『違』為異，以《傳》訓為離，無眷戀之狀，於文不足。故以『違』為徘徊也。○《傳》：『畿』，門內。《正義》曰：以言畿者，期限之名，故《周禮》九畿及王畿，千里皆期限之義。故《楚茨》傳曰：畿，期也。《經》云『不遠』言至有限之處。故知是門內。

Commentaire de Lu Ji (entrée n°23 : 《采葍采菲》)

『葍』蔓菁。幽州人或謂之『芥菲』。似菘，莖粗葉厚而長有毛。三月中蒸鬻為茹，甘美。可作羹。幽州人謂之『芴』。《爾雅》又謂之『蔥菜』。今河內人謂之『宿菜』。

Complément de Mao Jin (extrait de l'entrée n°12)

葍：《爾雅》云：『須、葍菹。』郭云：未詳。鄭云：菹葍也。[...] 《坊記》註云：『葍』蔓菁也。陳、宋之間謂之葍。《方言》云：『藟』蕘、蕘菁也。陳、楚謂之藟。齊、魯謂之蕘。關西謂之蕘菁。趙、魏之郊謂之大芥。『藟』與『葍』字雖異，音實同，則葍也，須也，蕘菁也，蔓菁也，蕘蕘也，蕘也，芥也。七者一物也。《本草》云：蕘菁味苦。《圖經》云：蕘菁四時仍有，春食苗，夏食心，亦謂之臺子，秋食莖，冬食根。[...] 《埤雅》：『菘性陵，冬不彫，四時常見。有松之操，故其字會意而本草。以為交耐霜雪也。舊說以菘菜北種，初年半為蕘菁，二年菘種都絕蕘菁，南種亦然，蓋菘之不生北土，猶橘柚之變于淮北矣。蕘菁似菘而小有臺，一名葍，一名須，《爾雅》(…)：「須、蕘蕘〔也〕。」今俗謂之臺菜。(…)其紫華者謂之蘆菘，一名菜菘，所謂溫菘、是也。菜菘言來麩之所服也。』《爾雅翼》云：『蔓菁、南北通有之，北土種之尤多。(…)菜中之最有益者。塞北并、汾、河、朔間，燒食其根，呼為蕘根，猶是蕘菁之號。昔漢桓帝。永興中，令災傷郡國，皆種蔓菁以助民食。劉備歸曹公，公使覘之，閉門將人種蔓菁。[...] 《詩緝》云：江南有菘江，北有蔓菁，相似而異。《周禮》：醢人菁菹鹿齏註菁蔓菁也。[...]

Ce qu'en disent Mao et Zheng Xuan cités par Kong Yingda :

采葍采菲無以下體『葍』須也，『菲』芴也，『下體』根莖也。

《箋》云：此二菜者，蔓菁與菘之類也，皆上下可食。然而其根有美時，有惡時，采之者不可以根惡時并棄其葉。喻夫婦以禮義合，顏色相親亦不可以顏色衰棄其相與之禮

Citations complémentaires (Kong Yingda) :

《正義》曰：習習然和舒之谷風，以陰以雨而潤澤行，百物生矣。以興夫婦和而室家成。即繼嗣生矣。言己黽勉然，勉力思與君子同心。以為夫婦之道，不宜有譴怒，故也。言采葑菲之菜者，無以下體根莖之惡，并棄其葉。以興為室家之法，無以其妻顏色之衰，并棄其德，何者？夫婦之法，要道德之音，無相違，即可與爾，君子俱至於死。何必顏色斯須之有乎？我之君子，何故以顏色衰而棄我乎？ [...]

《正義》曰： [...] 《釋草》云：『須葑』菹。孫炎曰：『須』一名『葑菹』。《坊記注》云：『葑』蔓菁也。陳、宋之間，謂之『葑』。陸璣云：『葑』蕪菁。幽州人，或謂之『芥』。《方言》云：『藟蕘』蕪菁也。陳、楚謂之『藟』。齊、魯謂之『蕘』。關西謂之『蕪菁』。趙、魏之部（校）謂之『大芥』。『藟』與『葑』字雖異，音實同，即葑也，須也，蕪菁也，蔓菁也，葑菹也，蕘也，芥也。七者，一物也。《釋草》又云：『菲』芴也。郭璞曰：土瓜也。孫炎曰：菹類也。《釋草》又云：『菲』蔥菜。郭璞曰：『菲』草生下溼地，似蕪菁，華紫赤色，可食。陸璣云：『菲』似藟，莖麤，葉厚而長有毛。三月中烝鬻為茹。滑美可作羹。幽州人謂之『芴』。《爾雅》謂之『蔥菜』。今河內人謂之『宿菜』。《爾雅》：『菲』芴，與蔥菜異。《釋郭注》似是。《別草》如陸璣之言，又是一物。某氏注《爾雅》二處引此詩，即菲也，芴也，蔥菜也，土瓜也，宿菜也。五者一物也。其狀似菹而非菹。故云菹類也。《箋》云：此二菜者，蔓菁與菹之類者。『蔓菁』謂葑也，『菹類』謂菲也。
