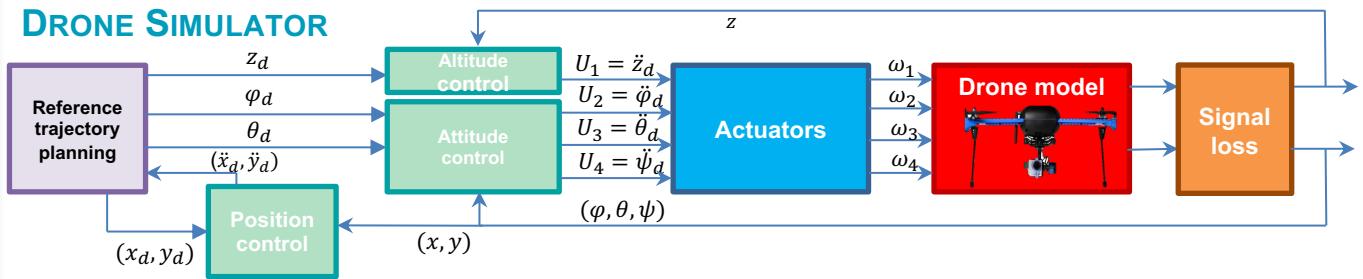

## OBJECTIVES

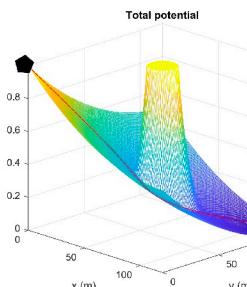
- **Drone simulator**

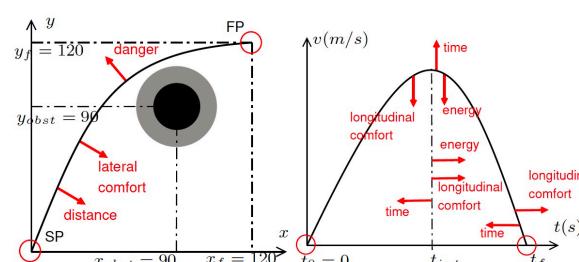

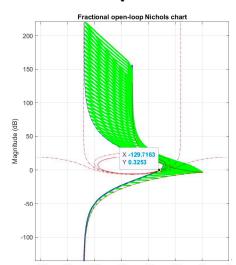

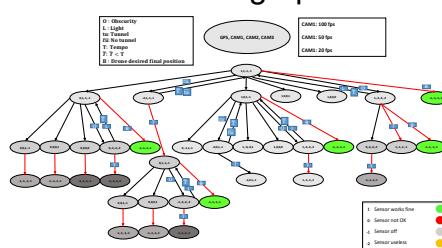

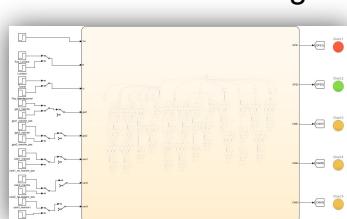


## SIGNAL LOSS MODELING
