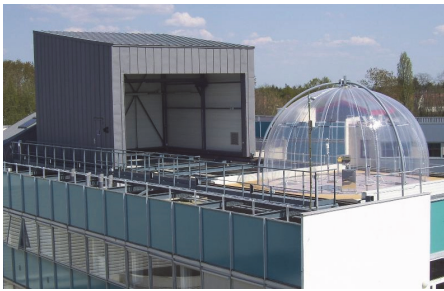

The Atmospheric Reactivity studies Platform of Orléans (PRAT) is composed of:

HELIOS: Atmospheric simulation chamber with natural irradiation of Orléans



Objectives

- Characterization and monitoring of the evolution of pollutants under the influence of sunlight or in the dark
- Kinetics measurements and mechanisms development

Description

- Hemisphere of 6 m diameter (90 m³) made of FEP film
- Ultrapure air (atmospheric P° & T°)
- Used under sunlight, artificial lights or in the dark
- Mobile protective structure
- Laboratory of 110 m² (under the chamber) equipped with advanced analytical instruments (in situ FTIR, PTR-TOF-MS, API-TOF-CIMS ; Gas (NO, NO₂, NO₃, O₃, HONO, HCHO, CO, SO₂) and particles analyzers ; Chromatographs, Spectrometers ...)

- Air quality monitoring and research
- Regular pollutants measurements (gases and particles)
- Education and Training

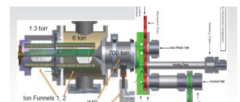
Description

- Located on the CNRS campus of Orléans
- Permanently measured: O₃ and NO_x monitors, PM10 (law-regulated pollutants); meteo station

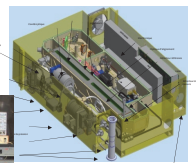


Instrumental development

- SPECIES : in situ spectrometer with four infrared lasers
Compounds which can be simultaneously measured with sub-ppb detection limits, among others:
CO, CH₄, NO, N₂O, HNO₃, H₂O₂, HCl, HOCl, COF₂, HCHO, HCOOH, O₃, NH₃, NO₂, H₂O, OCS



- Atmospheric Mass Spectrometry (AMS) with ORBITRAP
Dedicated to the detailed study of the chemical composition of organic aerosols



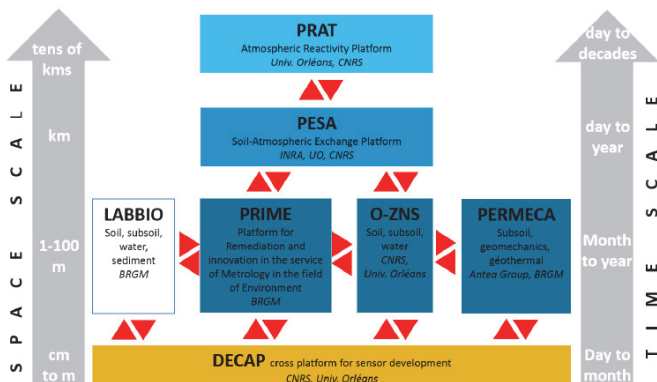
- SAMU: chemical ionization mass spectrometer: CIMS for HO₂, OH, RO₂, H₂SO₄ detection



- CRDS: Cavity Ring Down Spectroscopy to measure NO₃ radicals and particles

PRAT is part of large regional project (PIVOTS):

- Coordinated set of experimental and analytical platforms for environmental metrology and remediation.
- Designed for various scales (space and time), matrices e.g. soils, water, air) and contaminants, *in vitro* and *in situ*.
- Federating public bodies and private players
- Open to both academics and industry
