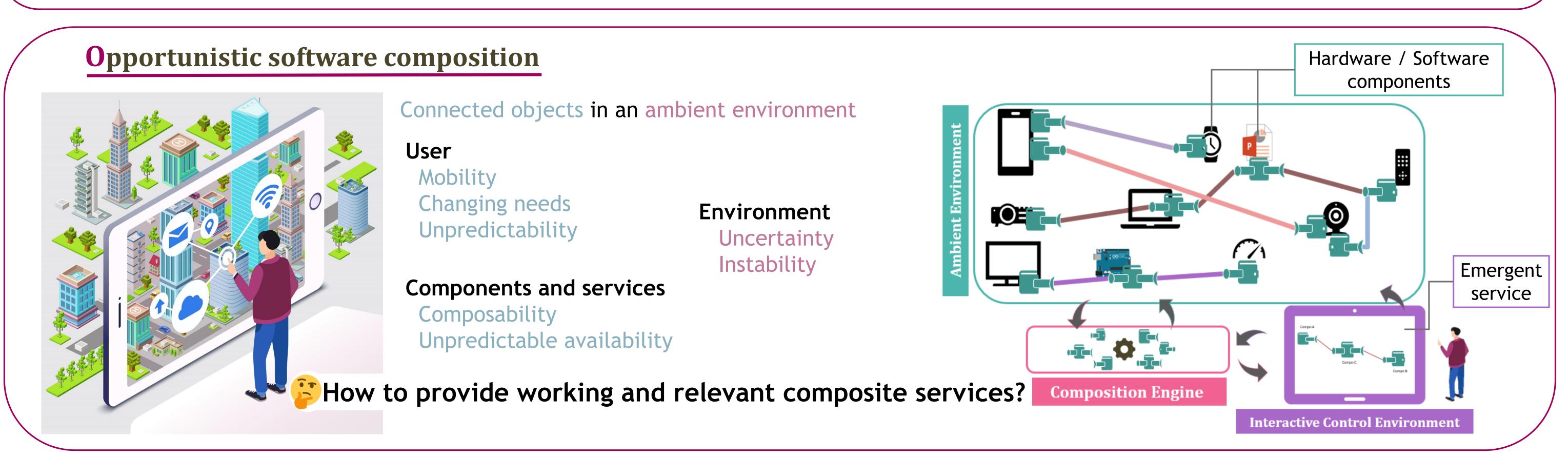

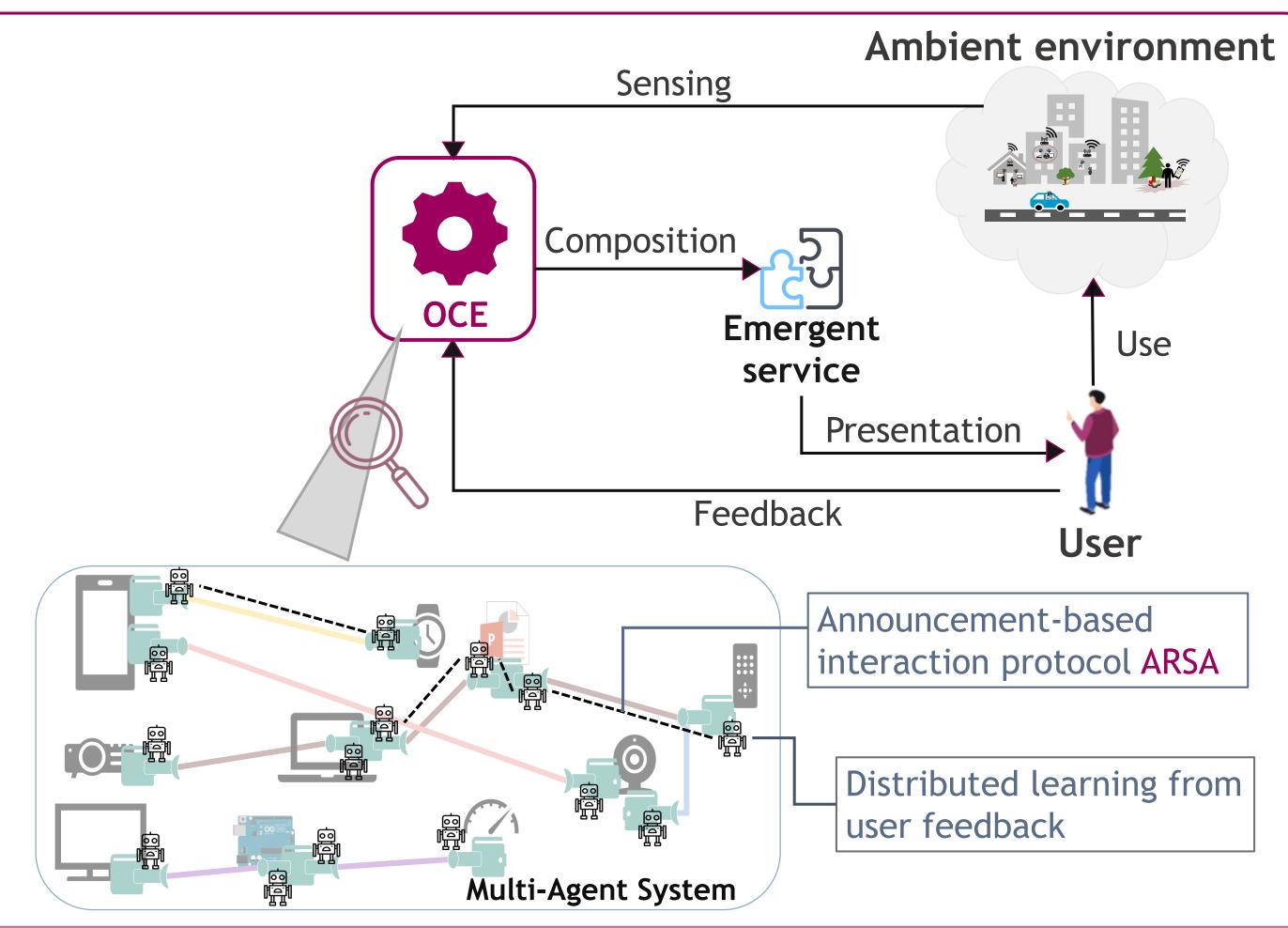

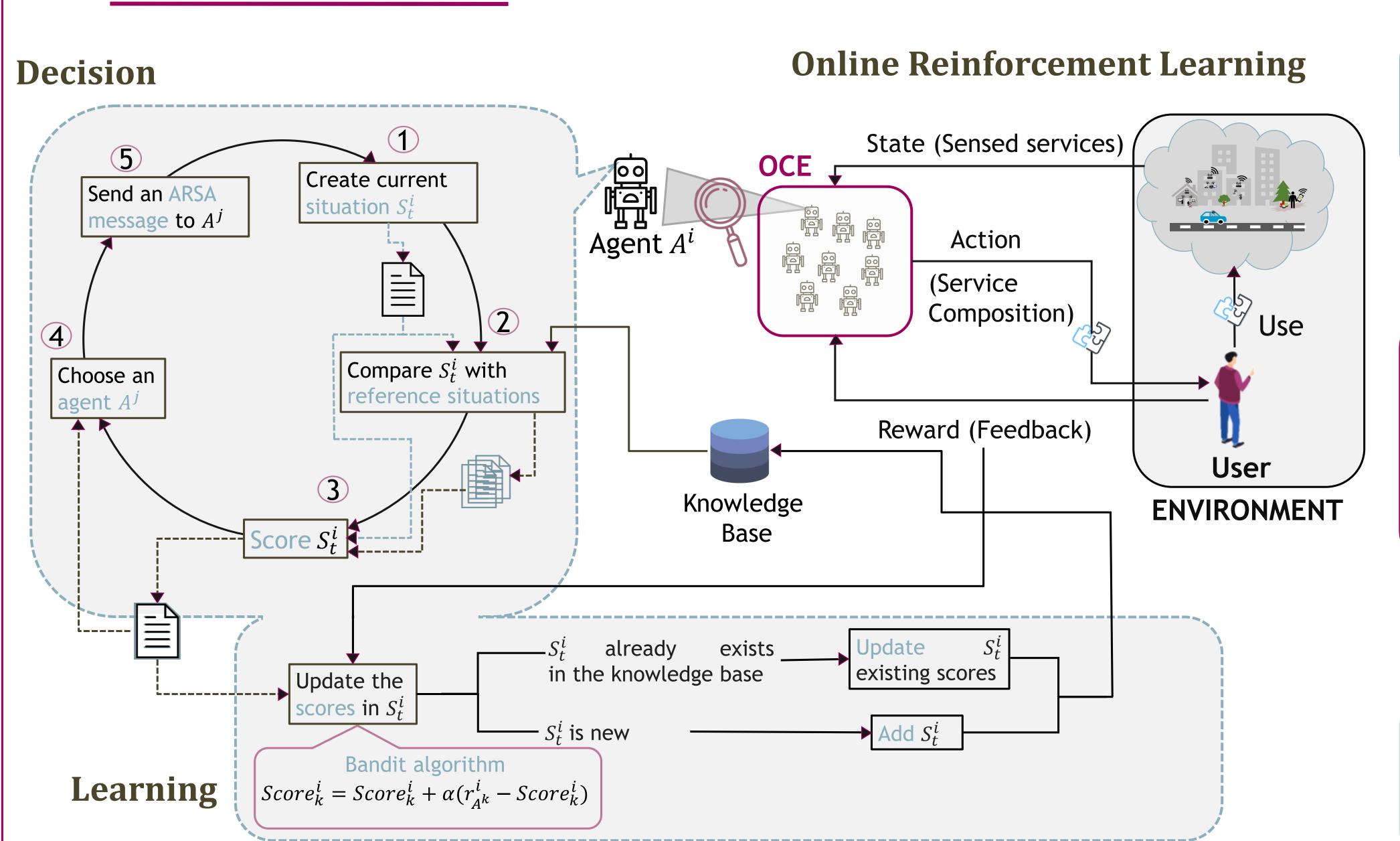


Opportunistic Composition engine OCE

- Online reinforcement distributed learning
