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UA Specificities :

Biological agriculture permits to decrease sanitary risks and to re-use urban organic wastes

Generally **little available urban surfaces: Conflicts of use**

Crucial **to check, manage and improve environmental quality** with **sustainable practices**

The **information and collective construction** of the UA projects are crucial steps

UA projects are **multidisciplinary** and carry several different ecological services
