• Example: Darcy equation

$$\varepsilon \frac{\partial S_{l}}{\partial t} + \nabla \cdot \langle \mathbf{u}_{l} \rangle = \mathbf{0}$$
$$\langle \mathbf{u}_{l} \rangle = -\frac{\mathbf{K}_{0}}{\mu_{l}} \cdot \left(\nabla \langle p_{l} \rangle^{l} - \rho_{l} \mathbf{g} \right)$$

Darcy's laws for gas/liquid flows in packings?

 Darcy-generalised equation (single phase approximation) Soulaine et al., Pasquier et. al.

$$\langle \mathbf{u}_{g} \rangle = -\frac{\mathbf{K}_{0}}{\mu_{g}} \cdot (\nabla \langle p_{g} \rangle^{g} - \rho_{g} \mathbf{g}) - \mathbf{F} \cdot \langle \mathbf{u}_{g} \rangle$$



Experimental data extracted from Brunazzi et al. (2002)



- Strong interaction between liquid and gas in the loading regime
 - pressure drop rise $\nabla \langle p_g \rangle^g$
 - liquid retention *h_I* increases
- Requires a coupled model at the macro-scale

Up-scaling - Coupled model

■ Viscous regime (Whitaker, Lasseux et al.)

$$\begin{pmatrix} \langle \mathbf{u}_{I} \rangle \\ \langle \mathbf{u}_{g} \rangle \end{pmatrix} = - \begin{pmatrix} \frac{\mathbf{K}_{II}^{\star}}{\mu_{I}} & \frac{\mathbf{K}_{Ig}^{\star}}{\mu_{g}} \\ \frac{\mathbf{K}_{gI}^{\star}}{\mu_{I}} & \frac{\mathbf{K}_{gg}^{\star}}{\mu_{g}} \end{pmatrix} \begin{pmatrix} \nabla \langle p_{I} \rangle^{I} \\ \nabla \langle p_{g} \rangle^{g} \end{pmatrix}$$

Application: Two-phase flow in particle beds

- Closures of K^{*}_{II}, K^{*}_{gg}, K^{*}_{lg}, K^{*}_{gl} from experimental results

Numerical resolution : IMPES Method

- IMplicit Pressure Explicit Saturation
- Sequential resolution of an equation on pressure and on saturation

$$\frac{\partial}{\partial t} \begin{pmatrix} S_{I} \\ S_{g} \end{pmatrix} + \nabla \cdot \begin{pmatrix} \langle \mathbf{u}_{I} \rangle \\ \langle \mathbf{u}_{g} \rangle \end{pmatrix} = 0$$
$$\begin{pmatrix} \langle \mathbf{u}_{I} \rangle \\ \langle \mathbf{u}_{g} \rangle \end{pmatrix} = - \begin{pmatrix} \frac{\mathbf{K}_{II}^{\star}}{\mu_{I}} & \frac{\mathbf{K}_{Ig}^{\star}}{\mu_{g}} \\ \frac{\mathbf{K}_{gI}^{\star}}{\mu_{I}} & \frac{\mathbf{K}_{gg}^{\star}}{\mu_{g}} \end{pmatrix} \begin{pmatrix} \nabla \langle p_{I} \rangle^{I} \\ \nabla \langle p_{g} \rangle^{g} \end{pmatrix}$$

- Finite volume method
- Scalar or tensorial effective parameters \mathbf{K}^{\star}

- Comparison of a Darcy model and coupled models (viscous and inertial)
- Closures:
 - Viscous: analogy to a liquid film in a cylinder tube
 - Inertial: based on the closures from the Calide experiment

Analysis of the pressure drop $\nabla \langle p_g \rangle^g$ and retention h_I

- The inertial coupled model reflects the increase in retention and pressure drop
- Comparison from Suess and Spiegel (1991) for illustration

Closure of the liquid transfer at contact points?

$$\mathring{m} = h_1 \left(\left\langle p_{I_2} \right\rangle^{I_2} - \left\langle p_{I_1} \right\rangle^{I_1} \right)$$

 Assuming capillary pressure effects at contact points

$$P_{c_i}(S_i) = \langle p_g \rangle^g - \langle p_{l_i} \rangle^{l_i}$$

$$\mathring{m} = h_1 \left(P_{c_2} \left(S_{l_2} \right) - P_{c_1} \left(S_{l_1} \right) \right)$$

 - Numerical modeling at the local-scale (VOF)
- Impact of the coupled system on the dispersion?
- Closure of the liquid exchange term *m*
 - Numerical modeling at the micro-scale (quantification of the liquid exchange)
