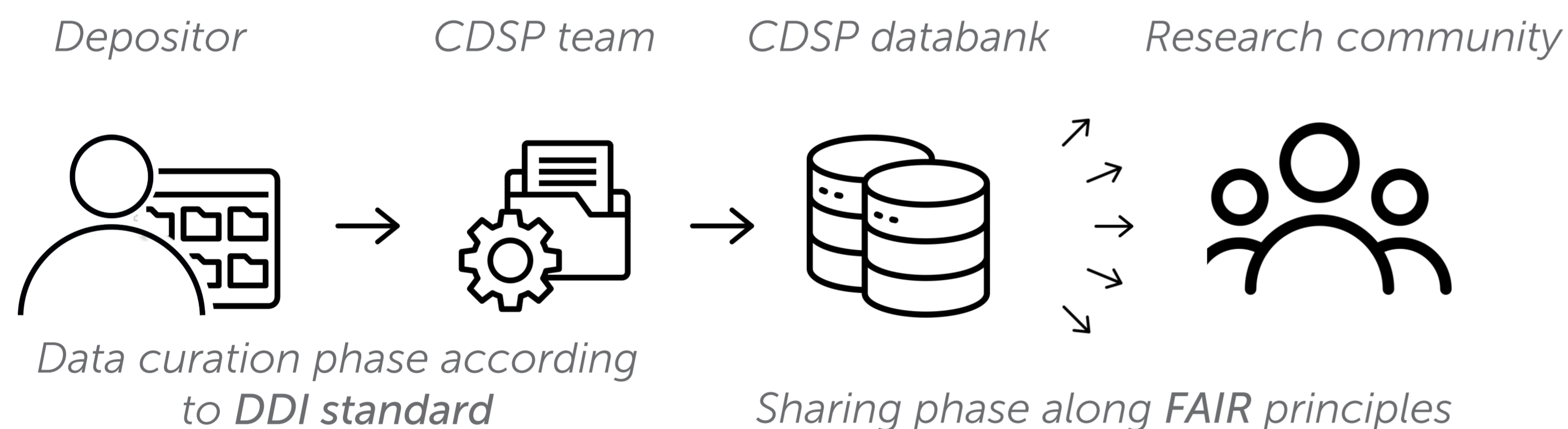

Since 2005, one of the CDSP's main missions has been **to facilitate the reuse of quantitative and qualitative sociology and political science surveys** and data on behalf of the French and international SSH community.

## From deposit to reuse

The CDSP respects the **Open Archival Information System (OAIS)** standard for the definition of the lifecycle of the data it manages.



The CDSP metadata are evaluated at **64/100** by **F-UJI** (FAIRsFAIR tool).
