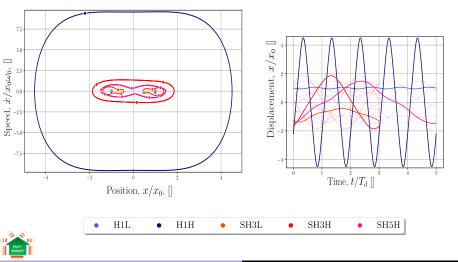


H1H: Harmonic 1 High H1L: Harmonic 1 Low



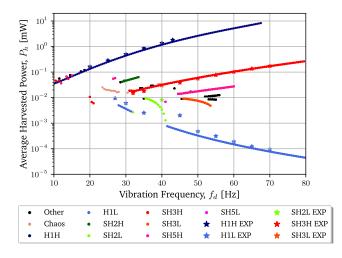

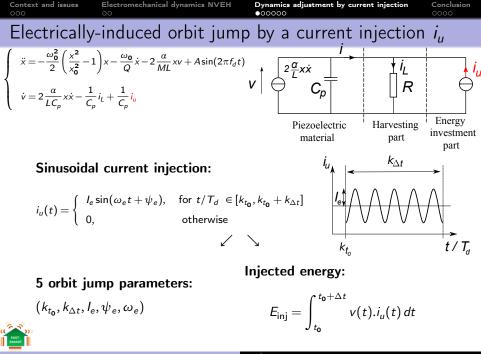


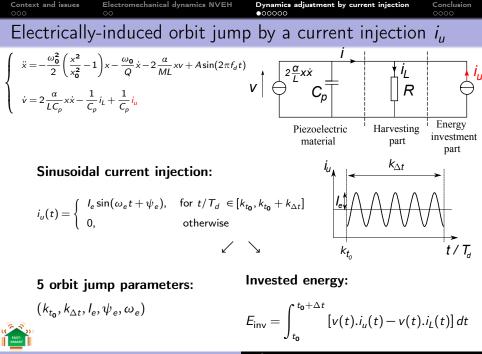


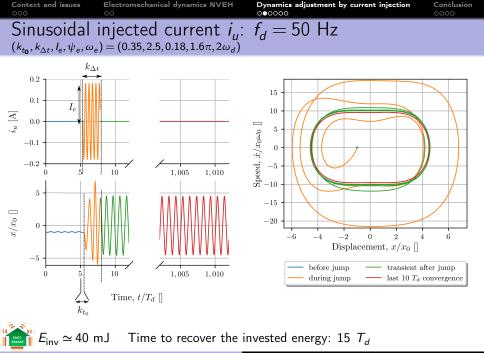


▶ the more  $f_d$   $\nearrow$ , the more it is interesting to implement orbit jump

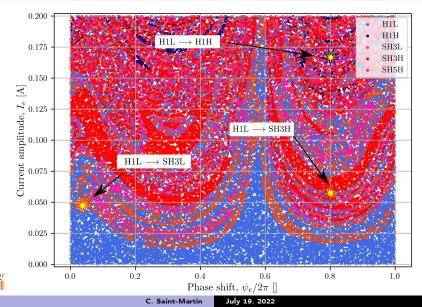
•  $f_d < 25$  Hz: it is not necessary to implement an orbit jump strategy



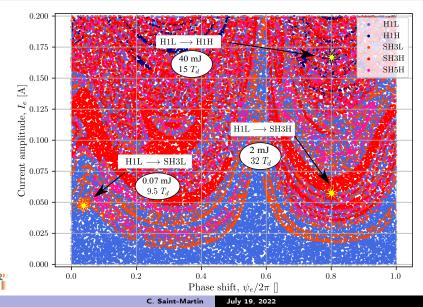








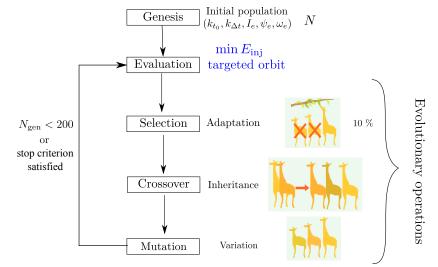

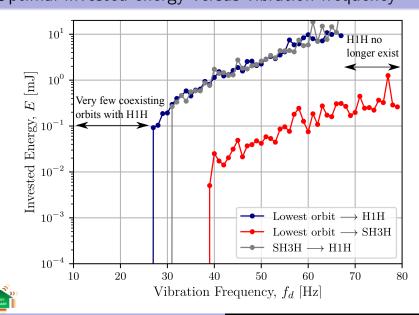






Time to recover the invested energy: 0.85  $T_d$ 



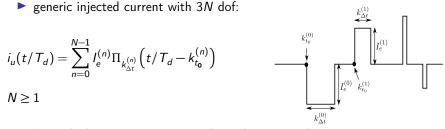




#### Analysis tool electrically-induced orbit jump strategies:

- Optimize orbit jump strategy using an evolutionary algorithm
- Simulate orbit jump strategy not specifically electrically-induced (e.g., buckling jump)

#### To follow: Consider more complex current injection waveform
