Introduction

Context

• Structural defects may lead to a substantial degradation of the performances of the HTS tapes.

Objective

• NDT control of 2G HTS tapes by using eddy current thermography (ECT) at room temperature.

Scientific and technical issues

- Thin multilayered structure.
- Multiscale dimensions.
- Materials with different physical properties.

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Experimental setup

- Avoid the thermal disturbances of current supplied inductors.
- Rotating magnetic wheel.

Diffusion equation: ٠

$$\begin{cases} \gamma C_p \frac{\partial T}{\partial t} = \frac{\partial}{\partial x} \left(\lambda \frac{\partial T}{\partial x} \right) + \frac{\partial}{\partial y} \left(\lambda \frac{\partial T}{\partial y} \right) + \frac{\partial}{\partial z} \left(\lambda \frac{\partial T}{\partial z} \right) + \mathcal{P} \\ -\lambda \vec{\nabla} T. \vec{n} = h(T - T_e), \quad on \ \Gamma \end{cases}$$

Boundary conditions: ٠

$$\begin{cases} \left. \lambda_{W} \frac{\partial T}{\partial x} \right|_{W} = h_{x} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \\ \left. -\lambda_{E} \frac{\partial T}{\partial x} \right|_{E} = h_{x} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \\ \left. \lambda_{F} \frac{\partial T}{\partial y} \right|_{F} = h_{y} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \\ \left. -\lambda_{B} \frac{\partial T}{\partial y} \right|_{B} = h_{y} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \\ \left. \lambda_{S} \frac{\partial T}{\partial z} \right|_{S} = h_{z}^{S} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \\ \left. -\lambda_{N} \frac{\partial T}{\partial z} \right|_{N} = h_{z}^{S} (T_{p} - T_{e}) \end{cases}$$



Finite difference discretization strategy

Global index:

p = i + (j - 1)N + (k - 1)NMwhere $(1 \le i \le N, 1 \le j \le M, 1 \le k \le L)$



Evolution of the electromagnetic quantities as a function of the wheel position

• Unflawed HTS tape:





• Simulation of delamination defect in HTS tape: 3.4 mm x 3.6 mm x 30 μ m



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Conclusion

- Numerical and experimental investigations of structural control in 2G HTS tapes **at room temperature** using eddy current thermography.
- Highlighting the possibility of detection of several types of defects.
- Efficient and rapid numerical modeling.
- Future work: experimental testing of flaws in 2G HTS tapes.
