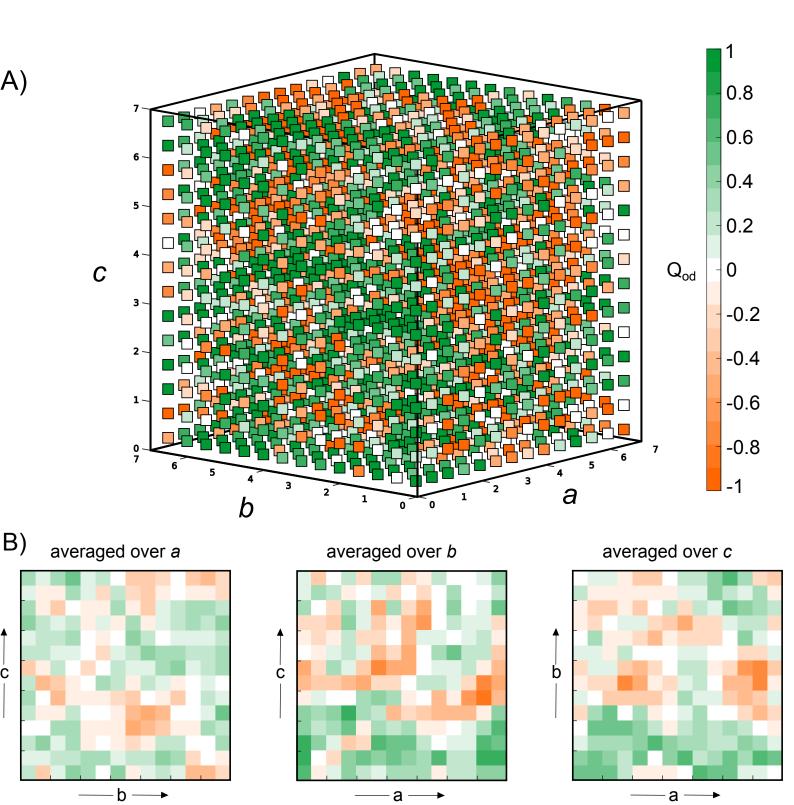

A) Local value of ordering (seen through the parameter Qod as defined in the main text) averaged over subdivisions of the conventional unit cell (Fig. 1B), over a length of half the unit cell parameter in each direction. This results in 8 subdivisions per conventional unit cell, for a total 2744 subdivisions in Fig. 5. Each subdivision contains 4 tetrahedra. B) Averages of A), summed over each axis direction. When Qod is positive (green), ordering prevails and Si and Al are in their own site. Negative values of Qod (orange) indicate anti-ordered regions (Si generally in Al site, Al generally in Si site).

Micro-domains appear as lenses elongated along b and c, showing much greater contrasts in B) than along a. All values on the same colour scale, distances have crystal cell units (a b c as axes on an orthonormal basis).
