

Tn-seq → Transposon sequencing

Tn-seq is a genome-wide screening method that rapidly identifies, on a large panel of strains, genes related to a specific phenotype or growth condition in bacteria. It consists in random transposon mutagenesis in parallel coupled with high throughput sequencing.



Main steps

- creation of a pool of mutants by random insertion of a transposon
- growth (and selection)
- high-throughput sequencing of surviving cells

Essential genes


genes essential for growth under a given condition.

Conditionally essential genes

genes that are required for growth under one condition but not another

Example of applications: identification of virulence factors of pathogenic bacteria, identification of genes involved in antibioresistance, ...



TnSeek → our pipeline, any number of conditions + any number of strains
