


Montenegro 13 812 km²


37% is considered farming land which means mainly **pastures** and meadows very often (nearly half) governed commonly


42% is considered **forests** of which 67% owned by the state, while the rest is privately (a part communally owned)

0,684% arable land mainly not common

Possible communal management of **<u>river flows and fishing</u>** but minor
